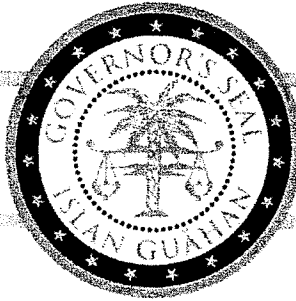

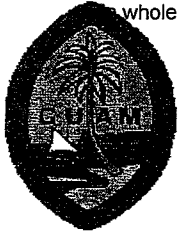

PUBLIC HEARING CONVENED AT 1:05 PM AND SEGUED TO VINCENT J. REYES' CONFIRMATION HEARING.

SENATOR KELLY MARSH (TAITANO), PH.D. CHAIR: *Hafa adai* and good afternoon. *Si Yu'os Ma'ase* everyone for coming out and providing it, excuse me participating in this confirmation hearing. We will now begin the confirmation hearing of *I Maga'haga's* nominee Vincent J. Reyes to serve as a member on the Board of Directors, Guam Council on the Arts and Humanities Agency. To restate the Committee's general housekeeping rules, the conduct of this public hearing shall be as follows. Those testifying will be recognized in the order of those signed in.

Written testimonies that are read should be summarized to about five (5) minutes and should be confined to the substance. Persons will be allowed to present oral testimony only once and are requested to remain seated so the Committee may request for additional comments. Please make sure that the microphone is on and that you speak directly into the microphone. Then after you've turned the microphone on please state your name for the record.

What we will do is have several people here providing support; and, we have two that have signed up to provide testimony. We will start with the Acting Director for CAHA Ms. Jackie Balbas, then we will hear from Mr. Joseph Certeza and then we will hear from Mr. Vincent Reyes himself. So, Ms. Balbas?

JACQUELINE BALBAS ACTIVE EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR, CAHA: *Håfa adai* madam chair my name is Jackie Balbas and I'm the Acting Executive Director of the Council on the Arts and Humanities Agency. I'm here today in support of Mr. Reyes' nomination to the CAHA Board.

I can recall when Mr. Reyes was a dancer under Dr. Benji Santiago many years ago, and I also do recall that from there he's grown and influenced so many people so much. He started the cultural dance program down at *Gef Pago*, and also the cultural program at Inarajan Middle School. Today he's brought that program to the high school level down at Southern High School. He's a proponent of cultural dance and the preservation of our culture. I also think that it's important to have him on our board because culture is ever-evolving. I do believe in preserving all our traditions. I also think it's good that he brings a new perspective, a fresh perspective to *CHamoru* dance. I'm hoping that the Legislature will confirm his appointment. I think that he would be an asset to the CAHA board. He also brought the program to as I mentioned, Southern High School. He has that education background too as well, and I think in my earlier testimony with Mr. Ronquillo, I mentioned that we have an 11 member board, should the two gentlemen be approved. We're gonna have a really diverse board. We have several CAHA Masters on board of which Mr. Reyes is also one recognized Master of CAHA. I'm hoping that he can help move all our programs at CAHA and maybe like I said bring a new perspective on how we can improve on a lot of the things that we're doing now.

We're such a very small staff of four and quite honestly we do have an active engaging board so I welcome Mr. Reyes to the board thank you.

SENATOR KELLY MARSH (TAITANO), PH.D. CHAIR: *Si Yu'os Ma'ase* for your testimony and now we'll hear from Mr. Certeza.

JOSEPH CERTEZA, BOARD VICE CHAIR, CAHA: *Hâfa adai* madam chair thank you for having me. My name is Joseph Certeza, I am currently the Vice Chair of the Council on the Arts and Humanities and I support the recommendation to confirm *Saina Vince Reyes* to our CAHA board; mainly, because I have worked with him in the past as aspiring artisan to and now a valued artist. Working with him, I was able to be pushed and mentored in a way in my art form, which is what it is today. I'm very valued for my relationship with Mr. Reyes.

Other things that we need to consider about *Saina Mr. Reyes*, is that he's a great innovator in the culture, he pushes the artform much further than I've seen, but it's really amazing to see how he's also using his mentoring skills to empower his students because what I've seen in his students is that they are being pushed to create new music and we need that in our island.

He's pushing his students to be creating new dances. We need to push the level of dance in our culture, and he provides all of those qualities that's needed in our cultural community. He's also a great professional. I've seen him organize so many trips off island. It's unique the way he organizes because he organizes with his dancers as well.

He's the guiding force, but he really wants to empower them to take initiative, take ownership of what they're doing. That's something very valuable and something that we also need in the Council on the Arts and Humanities and in our arts community.

I feel that with Mr. Reyes being present as a board member of CAHA, we can push the envelope forward, in what the culture is gonna be looking like into the future. Wat more can I say. He's going to be a very valuable asset and our artists community needs these unique assets. I really do support his confirmation and I hope that the Legislature can confirm him so we can really push the arts forward into the next coming years. We're ready for it. Thank you for allowing me to speak Madam Chair.

SENATOR KELLY MARSH (TAITANO), PH.D. CHAIR: *Si Yu'os Ma'ase* to both of you for providing that testimony. I wrote down quite a few notes that I will touch on after we hear from Mr. Reyes, but both of you brought forward really important points that I think, speak very well to his ability to really contribute to the community.

First we'll hear from Mr. Reyes himself, *si Yu'os Ma'ase*

VINCENT J. REYES, NOMINEE: *Hâfa adai*, my name is Vincent Reyes....Vince Reyes. I didn't know that I was actually supposed to have a testimony. So, I'm just gonna kind of speak from the heart. I've been in the arts for many years. This is my 19th year in the education system and in the creation of a part of *Inetnon Gef pago* as we know today. When I first started the program, or when I first started this journey, I really didn't know what I wanted to do. I just knew that there was something my heart that wanted to speak and be a mirror of our people.

Somehow, to be able to elevate the level of artistry; and, to be able to be some sort of example of inspiration and possibility. I didn't know how I was gonna do it when I first started. It was just it was just a class, it was actually a home-based class which is a 15 minute class at Inarajan Middle School. Then I was tasked to create the curriculum and finally that curriculum was approved by the Guam Education Policy Board in 2012. This as the curriculum for the region. Now, I'm tasked to be at Southern High, to create a three-year Pocket Academy program over there.

Aside from that, I run the of course. I am the director of *Inetnon Gef Pago*, but more so I feel like I'm a mentor and teacher to them. Meaning I do like what Mr. Joey had mentioned. I am always about the evolution and the upping.....the level of artistry of our culture. Through the arts is why its that important, is because art is peace, peace is art, and if we are, we are at peace in our hearts. Then we know how to move and become part of this world. This world, there's basically this humanitarian world, or, this humanity is...world of humanity. I don't know what I'm trying to say but and when I work with, when I work with people, I work with my students or, I work with collaborators. It's very important to kind of get to the big.....why; why do we do it, why is it important for my island, why it's important for me, why is it important for the people involved, why it's important to the audience. What I hear is because, why I'm here for me, why I'm here is because I feel like I can contribute. Now, I'm ready to contribute more island-wide; although, I do it already with what I do in internationally. I've been to 27 countries around the world. Performing and perpetuating our culture alongside our kids as well as the jury member to represent Oceania. At the end of the day, I'm just a son of the island and I just want to do the best I can to contribute in whatever way I can. Most especially a proud son of the south. I want to be able to continue and be able to ensure that our stories stand the test of time. Our culture stands the test of time! That's it!

SENATOR KELLY MARSH (TAITANO), PH.D. CHAIR: *Si Yu'os Ma'ase* everyone for your testimonies and certainly I've known Mr. Reyes over the years. I feel like I've gotten to know so much more about him in this short period of time through all of the really important testimony that we've gotten to hear. The fact that you've been in the industry for over 19 years, that's incredibly important to be bringing a wealth of experience. A wealth of that just real on-the-ground understanding of how our Arts work in Guam, and I'm a firm believer in being able to benefit by understanding ourselves but also understanding the possibilities of what's out there. The fact that you have visited 27 countries. I know when you go to those countries you really interact with the community, the leaders or the dancers that are there. It creates a real opportunity to see how they are working with their cultural programs. Then it becomes an opportunity to benefit our entire community because you can bring back what you see that operates really well elsewhere or something that could make sense for us here. I see that as a real benefit.

You're a Master so that speaks for itself. A Master is so much more than just being excellent at your craft. In order to be a true Master you study the history, you know the community, you know the people, like it's really its own sort of a Masters or PhD in that part of our culture or the *CHamoru* culture. It's important that people recognize it as such. Definitely, that is a wealth of knowledge that you bring in experience. Just hearing some of the things that were mentioned,

being a mentor, being innovative, certainly it's important the quality of empowering our community. Our community, sometimes large portions of it really struggle and having that sense of cultural identity. Those are some of the strongest tools of helping people find their way. Helping them feel rooted, helping them understand the world around them, and those things that CAHA offers and potential board member such as yourself. Certainly as a Master those are gifts that you can provide our youth and the rest of our community. They're just so very important. It's very good to hear that not only do you excel in your trade but those around you see you being innovative or empowering the people that you work with which are incredibly important and it fits in with the purposes of the council. If I go through the enabling, excuse me, legislation, they say things like stimulating and encouraging, developing, sustaining, and helping ensure the highest quality of the arts that are here. With the testimony that Ms. Balbas and Mr. Certeza and yourself provided, I can see elements of each of those aspects which is definitely important for us as, as we're looking at board members.

Also you have the experience of understanding some of these things from the ground up. Having developed programs, having developed dance groups again within your role as a board member, understanding those things becomes really something really valuable that you bring. As you might be thinking of ways to expand what CAHA offers or something that could really benefit the community. You understand all of the sorts of details that have to go into developing programs, and so forth, and making sure that they are successful.

With your many interests and some of the travel that you do, CAHA is a pretty active board, I would have to say. Do you see that you'd be able to make that commitment of time to balance out that commitment in your schedule?

VINCENT J. REYES, NOMINEE: I think as, as all artists or everyone that's successful in their own way, a balance of time is very important and for me I you know I've always invested in the arts. I've always felt the need to up the level of artistry in whatever way and as far as my commitment I can say yes is so far I'm good, and I think when it comes to the off-island and off island trips aligned with what we're trying to do as with CAHA. As a board, I'm sure it's because I don't necessarily go on a trip that doesn't relate to the arts. I usually go on the trip that somehow relates the Arts and most especially relates to our island, or inadvertently come. I come back with that knowledge and try to use it and return what I know back to the island.

SENATOR KELLY MARSH (TAITANO), PH.D. CHAIR: Very good to hear. Are there any particular focuses or interests ways forward that you see for CAHA that you'd like to share beyond what you've shared already?

VINCENT J. REYES, NOMINEE: Well first for me, I'd love to learn more about the intricacies of CAHA and be more involved in that level try to understand what are some of the new; what is the staff saying, what are people saying, what is the movement really trying to do, or where people trying to go. Once I think I learned that, I want to help guide that process and be a some sort of voice.

I've been blessed to be able to travel around the world. I'm seeing many arts organizations and not just dance, but dance festivals. Different people in the arts and I've seen how they've grown

their arts community, artists community, and align their efforts. I definitely want to be able to develop those kinds of relationships as well here.

First and foremost for me, is really kind of understanding what are the dynamics and where does CAHA fit in in the overall in trying to develop the community; and, how does the arts fit and not just culture and how does that relate to our island culture. I'm talking about not just the *CHamoru* culture but our island culture. The culture of the island. What sustains us here and so through programs through to the level of artistry or assisting; like, vice-chair had mentioned, that being able to work directly with many of these artists and try to assist them. Guide them and empower them because eventually you know we are. If we all do this together then I know that our mission is....CAHA ensuring that our culture evolves and continues to move forward, will be accomplished.

SENATOR KELLY MARSH (TAITANO), PH.D. CHAIR: *Saina Ma'ase* for that and as you were speaking certain things I thought about is that you had mentioned noting. This is something that CAHA does. Yes it's very important an incredibly important part of what they do, is to help promote and maintain the *CHamoru* culture. Also in their guidance in the enabling legislation, their mission is also to promote the local culture of our greater community. It's good to hear that you're thinking and understanding both of those aspects. Also in some of what you were saying, that it is the artists themselves, but then it's so the community at large, how they enjoy the arts and how it enriches their lives. There are just so many benefits to having an organization such as CAHA and very active board members. I again thank you all for your time and coming out here. Did anybody have any additional testimony that they wanted to provide? Are we all good? I want to give everybody a chance. Yes, they do!

Saina Ma'ase and then if you could just state your name for the record and then go ahead and provide your testimony.

PIM LIMTIACO, INETNON GEF PAGO, MEMBER: *Hâfa adai* my name is Pim Limtiaco and I'm one of the members of *Inetnon Gef Pago*. I've known Mr. Reyes for more than three years now. I do support his nomination or his confirmation and I just want to share a little bit about him. He's really taught me to go closer to much more roots in the arts. He's really encouraged me to be more creative and have pushed me to my limits as a musician in general. He's taken me around the world. If it wasn't for him, I wouldn't have been exposed to this level of artistry that existed. He really teaches us to. He kind of reminds us to stay grounded and to never forget where we come from. He also allows us to pursue even our personal careers. Even though if we're involved in perpetuating our culture, he still allows us to....like be teachers or be nurses, or pursue you know, our own personal interest. That's the best I can say for Mr. Reyes. I do believe that he is qualified for this position, *Si Yu'os Ma'ase*

SENATOR KELLY MARSH (TAITANO), PH.D. CHAIR: *Saina Ma'ase* for providing that testimony. It's very important to hear from people who know you in different roles. They've known you since they....what you were, young. As Jackie Balbas has mentioned, she's seen you grow as an artist and into a Master. Then as Mr. Certeza has mentioned, he's seen you be innovative with the arts and empowering those that you work with, and then from somebody

who's a part of the *Inetnon Gef Pago*, and is speaking essentially about being empowered in many ways by participating in your program. I think that's a very well-rounded set of testimonies.

If that is all the testimony this Committee will conclude the confirmation hearing of Vincent J. Reyes to serve as a member on the Board of Directors, Guam Council on the Arts and Humanities Agency. The Committee will continue to receive testimony for the next few days.
