Relative to commending and congratulating the world-wide members of Soka Gakkai International (SGI) on their tireless efforts and dedication in promoting world peace and congratulates SGI-USA, Guam on the 31st anniversary of the founding of SGI, and the grand opening of SGI-USA, Guam Activity Center

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE EXECUTIVE COMMITTEE OF I

- 3 **WHEREAS**, thirty one (31) years ago, on January 26, 1975, one hundred
- 4 fifty eight (158) delegates from fifty one (51) countries met in *Islan Guåhan* for
- 5 the first World Peace Conference; and
- 6 WHEREAS, Islan Guåhan was selected as the venue to conduct the first
- 7 World Peace Conference, given that the Chamorro people suffered so terribly
- 8 from the ravages of war; and
- 9 WHEREAS, from this auspicious occasion, the delegates founded Soka
- 10 Gakkai International (SGI), thus began the worldwide grassroots activities of

- peace, education and culture, based on the humanistic outlook of Nichiren
- 2 Buddhism; and
- 3 **WHEREAS**, today SGI is a worldwide network with eighty two (82)
- 4 constituent organizations and more than one million two hundred thousand
- 5 (1,200,000) members in one hundred ninety (190) countries and territories,
- 6 sharing a common vision of global peace and prosperity; and
- WHEREAS, for twenty six (26) years, SGI has been accredited as a Non-
- 8 governmental Organization (NGO) by the United Nations (UN); and
- 9 WHEREAS, as a NGO of the UN, SGI has worked tirelessly with other
- 10 UN entities in promoting harmony and coexistence between nations,
- disarmament, human rights and humanitarian relief; and
- 12 WHEREAS, Mr. Daisaku Ikeda, a recipient of the UN Peace Award and
- over two hundred honorary doctorates from universities around the world,
- 14 has been the president of SGI since 1975; and
- 15 **WHEREAS**, Mr. Ikeda has encouraged the members of SGI to devote
- their lives to planting seeds of peace throughout the world, rather than
- seeking to bring the flowers of their own lives to bloom; and
- 18 WHEREAS, the members of the SGI resolve to contribute to the
- 19 prosperity of their respective societies and countries, while respecting
- 20 individual cultures, customs and laws; and
- 21 WHEREAS, the members of SGI-USA, Guam have pursued activities to
- 22 advance the cause of peace; and
- WHEREAS, on January 2000, SGI-USA, Guam commemorated the 25th
- 24 anniversary of the founding of SGI, by co-sponsoring with the University of

- 1 Guam, Soka University of America and SGI-USA the first Pacific Islands New
- 2 Millennium Peace Conference
- 3 WHEREAS, the conference brought together executive government
- 4 leaders and high chiefs from many of the Pacific Islands to share their
- 5 memories of the Pacific War and resolve to never again allow such violence;
- 6 and
- WHEREAS, on January 2005, SGI-USA, Guam commemorated the 30th
- 8 anniversary of the founding of SGI, by hosting numerous commemorative
- 9 events in the name of peace,
- 10 WHEREAS, these commemorative events included the opening of two
- 11 (2) traveling exhibitions, "Building a Culture of Peace for the Children of the
- 12 World" and Morehouse College's "Gandhi, King, Ikeda: A Legacy of Building
- Peace, these traveling exhibits were displayed at the office of the Governor of
- 14 Guam, the University of Guam, the Guam Community College, FBLG Middle
- 15 School, UPI Elementary School, Simon Sanchez High School and Anderson
- 16 Elementary School; and
- 17 WHEREAS, SGI-USA, Guam hosted the Second Pacific Islands New
- 18 Millennium Peace Conference for educators focusing on "Humanistic
- 19 Education: Fostering a Culture of Peace" and sponsored a cultural festival
- 20 celebrating the diverse culture of mankind; and
- WHEREAS, on January 13, 2007, SGI-USA, Guam will observe the 31st
- 22 anniversary of the founding of SGI, with the grand opening of it's new
- 23 Activity Center, to continue its efforts towards world peace, promoting

- education and the appreciation of cultural diversity; and
- 2 WHEREAS, SGI-USA Guam will be exhibiting at the Activity Center,
- 3 the Morehouse College's "Gandhi, King, Ikeda": A Legacy of Building Peace
- 4 exhibit; and
- 5 WHEREAS, the youth members of SGI-USA, Guam will showcase the
- 6 "Victory over Violence" exhibit, to help young people identify and
- 7 counteract the root causes of violence in their lives; now, therefore, be it
- 8 RESOLVED, that I Mina'Bente Nuebi Na Liheslaturan Guåhan does hereby,
- 9 on behalf of the people of Guam, recognize and commend the world-wide
- members of SGI on it's tireless efforts and dedication in promoting world
- 11 peace, and congratulates SGI-USA, Guam on the 31st anniversary of the
- 12 founding of SGI, and the grand opening of SGI-USA, Guam Activity Center;
- 13 and be it further
- 14 RESOLVED, that the Speaker and the Chairman of the Executive
- 15 Committee certify, and the Secretary of the Legislature attest to, the adoption
- 16 hereof and that copies of the same be thereafter transmitted to President
- 17 Daisaku Ikeda of Soka Gakkai International (SGI); to Kaneko Ikeda; to SGI-
- 18 USA; to SGI-USA, Guam, and to the Honorable Felix P. Camacho, I
- 19 Maga'lahen Guåhan.
