AN ACT TO ADD A SECTION 229 TO THE GOVERNMENT CODE OF GUAM TO DESIGNATE THE FIRST WEEK IN JUNE AS ATBOT DE FUEGO (FLAME TREE) AND ARBOR DAY WEEK.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAM:

Section 1. Section 229 is hereby added to the Government Code of Guam to read as follows:

"Section 229. Atbot de Fuego (Flame Tree) and Arbor Day Week. The first week of June in each year shall be known as Atbot de Fuego (Flame Tree) and Arbor Day Week in commemoration of the natural beauty of the flame trees of Guam. The Governor of Guam shall issue a proclamation calling upon the people of Guam to observe such event and shall arrange for appropriate ceremonies for the observance of such week."

Section 2. Section 4 is hereby added to Public Law 12-46 to read as follows:

"Section 4. The provisions of this Act shall not apply to causes of action which arise on or before the effective date of this Act."
