

CERTIFICATION OF PASSAGE OF AN ACT TO THE GOVERNOR



AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE \$148,445 TO THE
DEPARTMENT OF EDUCATION FOR THE 1988
SUMMER PROGRAM AND TO AUTHORIZE
REQUIRED TRANSFERS OF FUNDS, AND TO
APPROPRIATE \$41,900 TO FUND PAYMENT IN
FULL OF THE COST OF LIVING ALLOWANCE
EXTENDED TO RETIRED GOVERNMENT
EMPLOYEES AND THEIR SURVIVORS.

1 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAM:
2 Section 1. The sum of One Hundred Forty-Eight Thousand Four
3 Hundred Ffty-Five Dollars (\$148,445) is appropriated from the Summer
4 School Fund established pursuant to §6618 of Title 17 of the Guam Code
5 Annotated to the Department of Education to fund the 1988 Summer School
6 Program and to reimburse other funds from which monies were previously
7 transferred for the 1988 Summer School Program.

1 Section 2. The sum of Forty-One Thousand Nine Hundred Dollars
2 (\$41,900) is hereby appropriated from the General Fund to supplement the
3 appropriation made in Section 14, Chapter X, Public Law 19-10,
4 to fund the Four Hundred Nineteen Dollars (\$419) lump sum cost of living
5 allowance given government of Guam retirees or their survivors for Fiscal
6 Year 1989.

AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE \$200,000 TO THE
DEPARTMENT OF EDUCATION FOR THE 1988
SUMMER SCHOOL PROGRAM.

1 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAM:
2 Section 1. The sum of Two Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$200,000)
3 is appropriated from the Summer School Fund established pursuant to
4 §6118 of 17 GCA to the Department of Education for the purpose of
5 funding the 1988 Summer School Program.
