1 WHEREAS, numerous requests have been made for the
2 installation of streetlights in Piti to Route 2, the Agat-Umatac
3 Road; and

4 WHEREAS, the residents of southern Guam deserve equal
5 priority regarding the basic necessities; that is, the allocation

1 of adequate streetlights; and

2 WHEREAS, with the cooperative working relationship between
3 the Department of Public Works and the Guam Power Authority, these
4 municipalities can be installed with new streetlights at a cost
5 comparable to the cost of relocating streetlights from North and
6 South Marine Drive to Piti and Route 2;

7 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAM:

8 Section 1. The sum of Three Hundred and Fifty Thousand
9 Dollars (\$350,000) is hereby appropriated to the Guam Power
10 Authority for the purpose of installing new streetlights in the
11 municipalities of Piti to Agat and Umatac. Approximately One
12 Hundred Fifty Thousand Dollars (\$150,000) of the Three Hundred
13 Fifty Thousand Dollars (\$350,000) shall be authorized for the
14 installation of approximately Three Hundred Fifty (350)
15 streetlights to meet minimum illumination standards from Piti to
16 the Nimitz Beach Area. The remaining Two Hundred Thousand Dollars
17 (\$200,000) shall be authorized for the installation of
18 approximately Four Hundred (400) streetlights between the Agat and
19 Umatac area. The new streetlights shall be installed upon the
20 installation of power poles and lines in conjunction with the
21 Agat-Umatac Road Reconstruction project. The Department of Public
22 Works shall work jointly with the Guam Power Authority in the
23 installation of the streetlights.

24 Section 2. The site surrounding and including Fort Apugan
25 in the village of Agana Heights is reserved for the construction
26 of a Veterans' Memorial Wall to honor the brave who died defending

1 our country. The Department of Land Management is directed, in
2 coordination with representatives from veterans associations on
3 Guam, to prepare a map and land description of the proposed
4 site.

5 Section 3. The sum of Eighty Thousand Dollars (\$80,000) is
6 appropriated from the General Fund to Sanctuary, Inc. for the
7 purpose of providing emergency shelter for "Status Offenders" for
8 Fiscal Year 1989.

9 Section 4. The sum of Six Hundred Fifty Thousand Dollars
10 (\$650,000) is appropriated from the General Fund to the Guam
11 Legislature Operation Fund for salary adjustments.

12 Section 5. The sum of One Hundred Thousand Dollars
13 (\$100,000) is appropriated from the General Fund to the Guam Fire
14 Department for overtime pay covering Fiscal Years 1988 and 1989.

REPORT OF THE COMMITTEE ON ENERGY,
UTILITIES AND CONSUMER PROTECTION
ON BILL NO. 881.

PREFACE

The Committee on Energy, Utilities and Consumer Protection and the Committee on Ways and Means conducted a joint public hearing on August 26, 1988 on Bill No. 881: "An act to appropriate the sum of \$350,000 from the general fund to the Guam Power Authority for the purpose of installing new streetlights in Piti and Route 2 (Agat-Umatac Road)", in the Legislative Session Hall. Committee on Energy, Utilities and Consumer Protection members present at the public hearing were: Senator Don Parkinson, Chairman; Senator Sonny Shelton, Vice-Chairman; Speaker Franklin J.A. Quitugua, member; Senator George Bamba, member; Senator Marcia Hartsock, member and Senator Madaleine Bordallo, member. Committee on Ways and Means member present was: Senator Ted Nelson, Vice-Chairman. Also present was Senator Ernesto Espaldon, sponsor of Bill 879.

TESTIMONY

Mr. John Benavente, GPA General Manager and V. Taitague Customer Service Supervisor appeared to testify orally on Bill 881. Estimated costs of installation of 138 lights would be \$135,000 for installation, \$15,000 contingency and \$50,000 per year service and energy costs.

Senator Ted Nelson, Acting Chairman of Ways and Means, expressed his support.

Senator then questioned about salary levels at GPA. Senator Nelson expressed a desire for an increase in salary for GPA General Manager and Deputy General Manager.

Speaker Quitugua then expressed dismay that the GPA Comptroller earned more than the General Manager. A general discussion of salaries for high officials, department heads and elected officials ensued.

No administrative personnel from Public Works appeared.

Commissioner Cecilia A.Q. Morrison, Umatac Commissioner provided written testimony labeled exhibit "A". Commissioner testified in favor of the bill, but questioned the following:

1. "Would the appropriation, as an example, be of any value after September 30, 1988, the end of the fiscal year period for Government of Guam?
2. Would the project be done internally...by Guam Power Authority or by outside contractor?"

Commissioner Isabel S. Haggard, Piti Commissioner also provided written testimony labeled exhibit "B". Commissioner also testified in favor of the bill.

COMMITTEE RECOMMENDATIONS

The Committee on Energy, Utilities and Consumer Protection, together with Senator Nelson, Acting Chairman of the Committee on Ways and Means support the installation of new streetlights in Piti and Route 2 (Agat-Umatac Road), therefore recommending the passage of Bill No. 881.

I am in favor of Bill 881: An act to appropriate the sum of \$350,000 from the General Fund from the Guam Power Authority for the purpose of installing new streetlights in Piti and Route 2 (Agat-Umatac Road).

Absent a copy of Bill 881, I would like to suggest that a date for implementation be specified and included in the bill. Would the appropriation, as an example, be of any value after September 30, 1988, the end of the fiscal year period for Government of Guam? Would the project be done internally...by Guam Power Authority or by outside contractor?

I would suggest that these questions be addressed in the bill; additionally, whether or not it would be an internal GPA project, it is also suggested that a "non-transferability clause" insofar as the funds earmarked for the project be included so as to prevent the use of the funds for other projects and not as Bill 881 would stipulate.

Thank you for the opportunity to testify on this important bill.

COMMENTS ON BILL NO. 881(COR)

Bill 881, if enacted, would appropriate \$350,000 from the General Fund to the Guam Power Authority (GPA) for the purpose of installing new streetlights from Piti to Umatac.

Per information received from GPA, the total funding required to provide streetlights from Piti to Umatac is \$135,000. This amount is based on the construction of 138 streetlights, as per design plans from the Department of Public Works submitted to GPA. Since the total estimated funding requirements for construction of the streetlights is \$135,000, the appropriation of \$350,000 as proposed by Bill 881 is more than sufficient to accommodate such costs.

The new streetlights shall be installed upon the installation of power poles and lines in conjunction with the Agat-Umatac Road Reconstruction project. The Department of Public Works shall work jointly with the Guam Power Authority in the installation of the streetlights.
