







**AN ACT TO *AMEND* § 3103 (b) OF CHAPTER 3 OF
TITLE 17 GUAM CODE ANNOTATED, RELATIVE TO
THE SUPERINTENDENT AND DEPUTY
SUPERINTENDENT OF EDUCATION.**

1 **BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF GUAM:**

2 **Section 1. Subitem (b) of §3103 of Chapter 3 of Title 17 Guam Code**

3 **Annotated is *amended* to read:**

4 "(b) Only the following constitute cause for the discharge of the
5 Superintendent or Deputy Superintendent:

6 (1) holding financial interests that conflict with the
7 conscientious performance of his or her duties;

1 (2) engaging in financial transactions using confidential or
2 non-public GPSS information or allowing the improper use of such
3 information to further any private interests;

4 (3) *except* as permitted by statute or regulation, the
5 solicitation *or* acceptance of any item of value from any person *or*
6 entity seeking official action from, doing business with, *or* conducting
7 activities regulated by GPSS, *or* from persons whose interest may be
8 substantially affected by the performance or nonperformance of the
9 Superintendent's duties, *or* the duties of GPSS;

10 (4) knowingly making commitments *or* promises of any kind
11 purporting to bind GPSS *except* as permitted by law;

12 (5) use of his *or* her official position for private gain *or* that
13 of others;

14 (6) failure to disclose waste, abuse and corruption to the
15 appropriate authorities;

16 (7) failure to respect the rights and privacy of others and the
17 use of his *or* her official position, authority *or* other means to injure
18 another person for personal reasons *or* malicious purposes;

19 (8) fraud *or* misrepresentation in securing his *or* her
20 appointment;

21 (9) refusal *or* failure to perform duties and responsibilities as
22 defined by law;

23 (10) unlawful use, possession *or* sale of illicit drugs and
24 alcohol;

25 (11) criminal acts involving moral turpitude;

26 (12) political activity prohibited by law;

1 (13) misuse, misappropriation *or* theft of government property
2 *or* funds;

3 (14) prohibited acts of discrimination, including sexual
4 harassment; *or*

5 (15) abandonment of his *or* her position.”
