



**AN ACT TO *REPEAL* AND *REENACT* §8101 OF  
CHAPTER 8 OF TITLE 2 OF THE GUAM CODE  
ANNOTATED, RELATIVE TO THE REGISTRATION  
AND REGULATION OF LEGISLATIVE LOBBYISTS.**

1        **BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF GUAM:**

2        **Section 1.** §8101 of Chapter 8 of Title 2 of the Guam Code Annotated is  
3        *repealed* and *reenacted* to read:

4                **“§8101.    Lobbying.**

5                **(a)    Definitions.**

1                   (1) *Lobbyist* means any person who engages for pay in any  
2 amount, *or* engages for any in-kind consideration, which may include  
3 expenses, for the purpose of attempting to influence the passage,  
4 defeat, or content of any legislation by *I Liheslaturan Guåhan*.

5                   (2) *Lobbying* means any activity by a lobbyist which is  
6 reasonably designed to influence the passage, defeat, or content of any  
7 legislation, including:

8                   (A) meeting with legislators *or* employees of  
9 legislators;

10                  (B) providing information and draft legislation to  
11 legislators *or* employees of legislators;

12                  (C) publishing any articles *or* editorials in favor of the  
13 passage *or* defeat of any legislation;

14                  (D) organizing groups of members of the public to  
15 engage in activities described in this Subsection (2);

16                  (E) paying for any amenities *or* expenses of legislators  
17 *or* staff; *or*

18                  (F) procuring goods and services from vendors in  
19 exchange for the passage, defeat or content of any legislation.

20                  (3) *Lobbyist* and *lobbying* does *not* apply to:

21                  (A) a member of the public appearing before a  
22 committee of *I Liheslatura* in support of *or* opposition to  
23 legislation;

24                  (B) a member of the public who contacts their elected  
25 officials;

26                  (C) government officials or designee acting in their  
27 official capacity;

1 (D) government employees providing information on  
2 legislation *or* responding to requests for information;

3 (E) reporters, employees *or* owners of publications  
4 engaged in regularly reporting on news items, editorials *or*  
5 other commentaries concerning legislation; provided, that the  
6 reporter, employee, *or* owner does *not* engage in further *or*  
7 other activities in connection with the passage or defeat of  
8 legislation other than appearing before a committee and  
9 submitting testimony;

10 (F) paid advertisements which contain a disclosure of  
11 the entity paying for the advertisement and entity interested in  
12 the issue lobbied;

13 (G) campaign contributions within the limits allowed  
14 by law, made to a senator *or* senator's campaign committee;  
15 and

16 (H) volunteers.

17 (b) **Registration.** Any person engaged as a lobbyist, before  
18 engaging in activities that constitute lobbying, *shall* register with the  
19 Legislative Secretary by providing the following information:

- 20 (1) name;
- 21 (2) business address;
- 22 (3) name and address of person by whom they are employed;
- 23 (4) interest in which the person appears;
- 24 (5) duration of employment;
- 25 (6) amount of pay or in-kind compensation including expenses and

1 (7) names of any papers, periodicals, magazines or other  
2 publications wherein lobbyist caused to be published articles or  
3 editorials in favor or opposition of pending legislation.

4 The information provided to the Legislative Secretary *shall* be  
5 updated quarterly on or before the tenth (10<sup>th</sup>) day of the first month of each  
6 quarter. All information provided by a lobbyist to the Legislative Secretary  
7 *shall* be either sworn to under oath or submitted as an unsworn declaration  
8 under penalty of perjury under the provisions of §4308 of Title 6 of the  
9 Guam Code Annotated, the Evidence Code of Guam. All information  
10 submitted to the Legislative Secretary *shall* be placed on *I Liheslaturan*  
11 *Guåhan's* website and *shall* be made available for public review.

12 (c) **Commissions Prohibited.** No person engaged as a lobbyist  
13 shall receive pay or in-kind compensation as a commission for lobbying  
14 based upon a favorable outcome of a lobbying effort.

15 (d) **False Statements Prohibited.** No person engaged as a lobbyist  
16 shall circulate false statements concerning the issue or legislation being  
17 lobbied for or against, either to officials, employees of officials, or to the  
18 public.

19 (e) **Public Funds Prohibited.** No public funds of any government  
20 entity can be expended to engage in lobbying.

21 (f) **Former Legislators as Lobbyists.** No person who is a former  
22 legislator shall engage as a lobbyist for two (2) years after the end of the last  
23 term held by the former legislator as a legislator.

24 (g) **Penalty.** (1) Any person who violates the provisions of this  
25 Section by failing to register, update their registry, accepts a commission for  
26 lobbying, issues false statements in lobbying, uses public funds for lobbying,  
27 or as a former legislator lobbies within the prohibited time period for former

1 legislators, *shall*, upon conviction, be guilty of a misdemeanor, and be  
2 prohibited from engaging as a lobbyist for a period of three (3) years from  
3 the date of conviction.

4 (2) Fine. Fines imposed *shall* be equal to five (5) times the fee *or*  
5 value of any in-kind compensation received by the lobbyist. Financial  
6 records *shall* be provided by the lobbyist to determine the fine to appropriate  
7 government enforcement official.”

**BILL NO. 383-30 (LS) - R.J. Respicio / J.P. Guthertz, DPA**

**An act to repeal and reenact § 8101 of Chapter 8 of Title 2 of the Guam Code Annotated, relative to registration and regulation of legislative lobbyists.**

A public hearing was conducted by the Committee on Rules, Natural Resources and Federal, Foreign & Micronesia Affairs on the above titled subject on Thursday, June 10, 2010 at 9:00 a.m. at the public hearing room of *I Liheslaturan Guåhan*, 155 Hesler Place, Hagåtña, Guam. Present at the hearing were the following: Chairperson Rory J. Respicio, Vice Speaker B.J. Cruz, Senator Tom Ada and Senator Tony Ada.

**PUBLIC NOTICE ANNOUNCEMENTS:** Notices of this hearing were sent via fax and e-mail to all media and all Senators on June 2<sup>nd</sup> and June 7<sup>th</sup>, thereby meeting the requirements of the Open Government Law. Notices were also sent to various government agencies and private entities affected by the various bills being addressed.

**BILL NO. 383-30 (LS) DIGEST:** Bill No. 383-30 (LS) was introduced on April 29, 2010. Bill No. 383-30 (LS) repeals and reenacts § 8101 of Chapter 8 of Title 2 of the Guam Code Annotated, relative to registration and regulation of legislative lobbyists, in order to properly define and identify what type of behavior constitutes lobbying, who are lobbyists (as opposed to those who are members of the public stating their opinions), and who are paying for lobbying activities.

**TESTIMONY DIGEST:** No one signed in to testify and no testimony was presented at the hearing.

The author of Bill No. 383-30 (LS), Senator R.J. Respicio, made brief remarks, stating that Bill 383 would clarify the original code section that had originally been enacted in the Thirteenth Legislature.



He noted that the original code section has rarely been used, and that Bill No. 383 was introduced to clarify just who is a lobbyist, and what behavior is considered lobbying. It was also introduced to make the identity of those paying for the passage or defeat of legislation completely transparent.

The Senator noted that as economic activity increases with the military buildup, it should be transparent to the public just who is paying to influence legislation, and how much money they are spending for that activity.

Senator Respicio said that Bill No. 383-30 (LS) exempts from the definition of lobbying certain common activities by members of the public, who can still meet with Senators, draft bills for Senators to use on issues, testify before the Legislature, and so on. But, if someone is being paid to perform those activities, that individual must disclose who is paying and how much, and provide contact information. He found the current code to be insufficient, in that it merely suggests that an individual must register with the Legislative Secretary if the individual going to lobby the Legislature.

Senator Respicio said that among his responsibilities as Chairman on Rules, whether in advancing Bills or Resolutions, or bringing ideas before the members of the Legislature, pursuant to our standing rules and the law, must always be ethical.

Senator Respicio added that although former senators have privilege of the floor, and can be on the floor during a session and communicate with working senators, they will be considered lobbyists under Bill No. 383-30 (LS) if they accept money for influencing legislation.

There being no testimony presented, Chairperson Respicio declared that Bill No. 383-30 (LS) was publicly heard and that written and electronic testimony would be accepted for ten working days following the hearing.

**RECOMMENDATION:** There being no objections or amendments to Bill No. 383-30 (LS), the Committee on Rules, Natural Resources and Federal, Foreign & Micronesian Affairs hereby reports out Bill No. 383-30 (LS), with the recommendation to do pass.

7 attempting to influence the passage or defeat of any legislation by i Liheslaturan Guahan.

8 (2) "Lobbying" means any activity by a lobbyist which is reasonably designed to  
9 influence the passage or defeat of any legislation, including:

10 (A) meeting with legislators or employees of legislators.

11 (B) providing information and draft legislation to legislators or employees of  
12 legislators.



- 1 (C) publishing any articles or editorials in favor of the passage or defeat of any  
2 legislation.
- 3 (D) organizing groups of members of the public to engage in activities described  
4 in this Subsection (2) of § 8101.
- 5 (E) paying for any amenities or expenses for legislators in an amount above  
6 \$1,000 per year in toto.
- 7 (F) procuring goods and services from vendors in exchange for the passage or  
8 defeat of any legislation.
- 9 (3) "Lobbyist" and "lobbying" does **not** apply to:
- 10 (A) a member of the public appearing before a committee of the Legislature in  
11 support of or opposition to legislation.

5 statements concerning the issue or legislation being lobbied for or against, either to officials,  
6 employees of officials, or to the public.

7           **(e) Public funds prohibited.** No public funds of any government entity can be  
8 expended to engage in lobbying

9           **(f) Former legislators as lobbyists.** No person who is a former legislator shall  
10 engage as a lobbyist for Two (2) years after the end of the last term held by the former legislator as a  
11 legislator.

12           **(g) Penalty.** Any person who violates the provisions of this Section by failing to  
13 register, update their registry, accepts a commission for lobbying, issues false statements in  
14 lobbying, uses public funds for lobbying, or as a former legislator lobbies within the prohibited time  
15 period for former legislators, shall, upon conviction, be guilty of a misdemeanor, and be prohibited  
16 from engaging as a lobbyist for a period of Three (3) years from the date of conviction.”







AN ACT TO REPEAL AND REENACT § 8101 OF

1 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF GUAM:

2 Section 1. § 8101 of Chapter 8 of Title 2 of the Guam Code Annotated, is repealed and  
3 reenacted to read:

4 “§ 8101. Lobbying. (a) Definitions. (1) “Lobbyist” means any person who engages for  
5 pay in an amount above One Thousand Dollars (\$1,000), or engages for any in-kind consideration,  
6 which may include expenses, in a value above One Thousand Dollars (\$1,000), for the purpose of  
7 attempting to influence the passage or defeat of any legislation by i Liheslaturan Guahan.

8 (2) “Lobbying” means any activity by a lobbyist which is reasonably designed to  
9 influence the passage or defeat of any legislation, including:

10 (A) meeting with legislators or employees of legislators.

11 (B) providing information and draft legislation to legislators or employees of  
12 legislators.

- 1 (C) publishing any articles or editorials in favor of the passage or defeat of any  
2 legislation.
- 3 (D) organizing groups of members of the public to engage in activities described  
4 in this Subsection (2) of § 8101.
- 5 (E) paying for any amenities or expenses for legislators in an amount above  
6 \$1,000 per year in toto.
- 7 (F) procuring goods and services from vendors in exchange for the passage or  
8 defeat of any legislation.
- 9 (3) “Lobbyist” and “lobbying” does **not** apply to:
- 10 (A) a member of the public appearing before a committee of the Legislature in  
11 support of or opposition to legislation.
- 12 (B) a member of the public who contacts their elected officials.
- 13 (C) government officials acting in their official capacity.
- 14 (D) government employees providing information on legislation or responding to  
15 requests for information.
- 16 (E) reporters, employees or owners of publications engaged in regularly reporting  
17 on news items, editorials or other commentaries concerning legislation;  
18 provided, that the reporter, employee, or owner does not engage in further or  
19 other activities in connection with the passage or defeat of legislation other  
20 than appearing before a committee and submitting testimony.
- 21 (F) paid advertisements which contain a disclosure of the entity paying for the  
22 advertisement and entity interested in the issue lobbied.

1 (G) campaign contributions within the limits allowed by law, made to a senator or  
2 senator's campaign committee.

3 (H) volunteers.

4 (b) **Registration.** Any person engaged as a lobbyist, before engaging in activities that  
5 constitute lobbying, shall register with the Legislative Secretary by providing the following  
6 information:

7 (1) name,

8 (2) business address,

9 (3) name and address of person by whom they are employed,

10 (4) interest in which the person appears,

11 (5) duration of employment,

12 (6) amount of pay or in-kind compensation including expenses,

13 (7) names of any papers, periodicals, magazines or other publications wherein lobbyist  
14 caused to be published articles or editorials in favor or opposition of pending  
15 legislation.

16 The information provided to the Legislative Secretary shall be updated quarterly on or before  
17 the tenth day of the first month of each quarter. All information provided by a lobbyist to the  
18 Legislative Secretary shall be either sworn to under oath or submitted as an unsworn declaration  
19 under penalty of perjury under the provisions of § 4308 of Title VI of the Guam Code Annotated,  
20 the Evidence Code of Guam. All information submitted to the Legislative Secretary shall be placed  
21 on i Liheslaturan Guahan's website.



1           **(c) Commissions prohibited.** No person engaged as a lobbyist shall receive pay or in-  
2 kind compensation as a commission for lobbying based upon a favorable outcome of a lobbying  
3 effort.

4           **(d) False statements prohibited.** No person engaged as a lobbyist shall circulate false  
5 statements concerning the issue or legislation being lobbied for or against, either to officials,  
6 employees of officials, or to the public.

7           **(e) Public funds prohibited.** No public funds of any government entity can be  
8 expended to engage in lobbying

9           **(f) Former legislators as lobbyists.** No person who is a former legislator shall  
10 engage as a lobbyist for Two (2) years after the end of the last term held by the former legislator as a  
11 legislator.

12           **(g) Penalty.** Any person who violates the provisions of this Section by failing to  
13 register, update their registry, accepts a commission for lobbying, issues false statements in  
14 lobbying, uses public funds for lobbying, or as a former legislator lobbies within the prohibited time  
15 period for former legislators, shall, upon conviction, be guilty of a misdemeanor, and be prohibited  
16 from engaging as a lobbyist for a period of Three (3) years from the date of conviction.”
