

AN ACT TO AMEND §15105 AND TO REPEAL AND REENACT §15107(a)(2) OF CHAPTER 15 OF TITLE 18 OF THE GUAM CODE ANNOTATED RELATIVE TO LIMITED LIABILITY COMPANIES.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF GUAM:

2 §15105 of Chapter 15 of Title 18 of the Guam Code Annotated is Section 1. hereby amended to read as follows: 3

"§15105. Formation. Two One or more persons may form a limited 4 liability company by executing, acknowledging, and delivering to the 5 Department of Revenue and Taxation articles of organization for such limited 6 liability company."

- §15107(a)(2) of Chapter 15 of Title 18 of the Guam Code Section 2. Annotated is hereby repealed and reenacted to read as follows:
- "(2) Unless its articles of organization provide otherwise, the limited 10 liability company shall have perpetual duration and succession in its name for 11 the period of its duration." 12

Section 3. Severability. If any provision of this law or its application to any person or circumstance is found to be invalid or contrary to law, such invalidity shall not affect other provisions or applications of this law which can be given effect without the invalid provisions or applications, and to this end the provisions of this law are severable."
