Therefore, *I Liheslatura* intends to transfer such land parcels and properties to the Guam Ancestral Lands Commission so that the Guam Ancestral Lands Commission *can and shall* proceed with the return of such land parcels and properties to the original landowners or their estates, pursuant to the Commission's enabling legislation and mandates.

Section 2. A new §80105(e) is hereby *added* to §80105 of Chapter 80, Title 21, Guam Code Annotated, to read as follows:

"(e) Portions of Parcel 1 South of Route 18 and contiguous to the North of Apra Harbor Parcel 6, also abutting Marine Corps Drive on the east, specifically original lot: No. 136-A PI, originally owned by the Estate of Juan San Nicolas Manibusan, in the municipality of *Piti*. The property *shall* be transferred and *shall* be deeded to the Guam Ancestral Lands Commission within thirty (30) days of the effective date of this Act. The Guam Ancestral Lands Commission *shall* within one hundred eighty (180) days dispose of the land parcel and lot transferred by this Act in a manner consistent with and pursuant to its enabling legislation and its mandates. All pre-condemnation roads, easements and bull cart trails *shall* remain as easements for public access and utilities. The transferred property *shall* be zoned "A" – Agricultural zone."

Section 3. The Department of Land Management *shall* plot, plan, design, and provide within sixty (60) days of enactment an aerial overlay map delineating all roads, easements, bull-cart trails, and public access as to determine such access or easements' location in relation to the return subject Lot so that *no* Lot is landlocked. The overlay *shall* show all original Lot lines generally.

Severability. *If* any of the provisions of this Act or the application thereof to any person or circumstance is held invalid, such invalidity *shall* not affect any other provision or application of this Act which can be given effect without the invalid provision or application, and to this end the provisions of this Act are severable.



Senator vicente pangelinan: Good evening ladies and gentlemen. Welcome to this public hearing August 27, 2010 by the Committee on Appropriations, Taxation, Banking, Insurance, Retirement, and Land. I would like to beg your indulgence by allowing the prerogative of the Chairman to rearrange the agenda and start from the bottom up this evening.

The next bill we have on the agenda is Bill No. 401. We have Mr. Enrique Agustin, Ms. Annie Diego, and Joe Garrido. Please come forward and we will have you present your testimony. For the record, before you start ladies and gentlemen, I do want to state the committee did receive written testimony from Attorney General John Weisenberger, who testified for Bill No. 401, Bill No. 402, and Bill No. 403. The letter indicates the Attorney General has no objection to these bills.

1. Enrique J. S. Agustin - Port Authority of Guam, General Manager

Enrique Agustin: For the record my name is Enrique J. S. Agustin, General Manger for the Jose D. Leon Guerrero Commercial Port. I want to thank you for the opportunity to provide testimony on No. 401, Bill No. 402, and Bill No. 403. This legislation is very similar to the previous one, identifying different lots. Like we noted in the past, the Port Authority of Guam supports the intent of this legislation but we do have some concerns. We believe the lots identified in these bills may be wetland and they were set aside as mitigation for the transfer of land to Southern High. We are also concerned with the transfer of lands might conflict with the condition placed upon them when they were returned to the government of Guam. Specifically there is a reversionary clause in the quit claim deed which was execute December 6, 1984 when the lands where conveyed to the government of Guam. As a result of the language on the reversionary clause and the pending transfer of the property back to the Ancestral Land Commission, we recommend the Governor and the Legislature solicited the assistance of the Guam delegate to the United States Congress, to introduce a bill to amend section 818 of public law 96418 as amended relative to removing the restrictive provision of the said property and reversionary clause in the quit claim deed. We believe without the language being amended by Congress, the use of the property by Ancestral Land Commission or the original landowners could be in jeopardy. In closing I want to thank you for allowing the Port Authority of Guam to present its testimony on Bill No. 401, Bill No. 402, and Bill No. 403. We are in support of the bill.

3. Joe Garrido

Joe Garrido: Thank you Senator ben pangelinan for having this public hearing on such an important issue. I see you're the only Senator here tonight. I have been a commission member for the Ancestral Lands Commission and I support this bill. I support the intent and ultimately the transfer of properties to the original landowners and or heirs. I know we have to do all we can to see this all happens. Yes there are reversionary clauses but I do not support those clauses and as a member of the Ancestral Lands Commission I did state on record, I do not support those reversionary clauses because these lands belong to the original landowners. The taking of these properties were done illegally by the United States. I'm sure that hopefully in the near future that whatever obstacles this transfer might encounter, hopefully we can find a solution for this and end the injustice that many of our people are suffering. I will say, the PAG action is the step in the right direction. My experience, is there is very few government agencies like PAG when in comes to original landowners. There are numerous lands being held by other agencies in the government of Guam. As for tonight, I support all three bills. Thank you.

Panel Comment and Questions

Senator vicente pangelinan: Thank you very much Mr. Garrido. I too want to recognize and commend the Port Authority of Guam, most especially under Mr. Agustin. I think their perspective on community, people, and land issues are very sensitive to the history and the ownership before they were taken by the federal government. They are very cognizant of the policy of this legislative body that whenever possible that when these lands are returned that they be returned to the original landowners. I think the Port Authority certainly recognize that policy and has been cooperative with the legislature in stating its position. I thank them for pointing out those issues that we all need to be aware of but they are not saying let that stop you. They are saying we all should be aware of some of these issues but the policy is we want to return these lands to the original landowners and they support that. I want to thank you especially Mr. Agustin. I have no further questions to the panel. Thank you very much.

4. Debbie Quinata

Debbie Quinata: I'm in support of lands being returned to the original landowners that belongs to them. I'm very concerned when the lands were returned under these same circumstances to the original landowners in Tiyan. There continue to be times when these families are very unsure of their footing. There were so many obstacles that continue to be put in their way. My niece in fact, Kathy Flores McCollum, was exercising her right on her property and was tackled to the ground and pinned by police officers because she was trying to exercise her right of claiming right to her family property. We have once again the same situation and I believe we can't just hand these lands over to these families and have them go through what

other families gone through. Up in Tiyan families are not sure it's their property or if they can build a house, or if they can move in and start collecting rent from someone that is already leasing. Can we please try to get these reversionary clauses removed once and for all, so people can take ownership of their land. I watched so many people lose money, get sick because of the changes they have been put through. They have the deed but someone else is saying we don't care and we are going to put a runway through your house. We are going to do this for the betterment for everyone but you. Since these clauses are still in place, these families again will be held at the mercy of whoever is in charge. As much as I support the return of land, let's take it a step further and make it no longer their puppets. Thank you very much.

Panel Comment and Questions

Senator vicente pangelinan: Thank you very much. I think we are fully are aware, one big difference I see between the situation here and the situation in Tiyan is that we have the Port Authority of Guam that is not challenging.

Debbie Quinata: I understand that but it is not up to the port.

Senator vicente pangelinan: It is the airport lack of cooperation that has caused the Tiyan issue to be in such turmoil.

Debbie Quinata: I beg to differ sir. I think it's the federal highway administrative guy in Hawaii.

Senator vicente pangelinan: I understand that but I think its all related to the airport.

Debbie Quinata: With the port being designated a strategic port, makes me paranoid. There is a possibility the feds will state they need these lands and put the landowners in a situation.

Senator vicente pangelinan: We have continued to press the issue with our congressional delegate and we will continue to do so. The choice is, do we wait and clear everything up or do we give the lands back now and continue to fight to remove it.

Debbie Quinata: I just want to let the families know the federal government can say, while it may be your land, the clauses we placed, at anytime we can say we changed our minds and you violated our rules and we are going to need this back.

Senator vicente pangelinan: So what do we do? Not give it back?

Debbie Quinata: I think we make sure that it's clarified. Why do with sign these contracts?

Senator vicente pangelinan: So what do we do again?

Debbie Quinata: Maybe we should start paying rent to the original landowners until these lands are free and clear. Maybe Ancestral Lands should be doing what it was intended to do, make monies available to assist the families. Maybe there needs to be plan put together to allow Ancestral Lands Commission to make monies available for families to have stability, to educate their children, to help them if they have medical difficulties or need necessities. Maybe instead of one at a time, we need to be proactive.

Senator vicente pangelinan: So we shouldn't return the lands? We should give it to the Ancestral Lands and they should make the money off it first?

Debbie Quinata: I think we need to make concise and logical decisions. I think we all know who the lands belong to. If there is a way it can be commercially developed and rental be given to the families, then yes. I say yes until you clarify the titles because what is the use of a clouded title? Let's not put the cart before the horse and create false hope or worst, disenfranchise families.

Senator vicente pangelinan: Well then you can't return the land. If you're saying we need to clear all this, don't return the land until it is all clear.

Debbie Quinata: If that is necessary to say, then that is what I am saying.

5. Vivian Leon – Deputy General Manager

Vivian Leon: Senator, may name is Vivian Leon, the intern deputy general manager for the port. At our last public hearing when we appeared to testify before you in 2009, one of the thing we had advised you was that we were seeking the approval of the Department of Navy for the Master Plan. In our Master Plan we had indicated that the area designated for the return of these properties was open space and that the board of directors would be passing a resolution to request the lands be returned back to the original landowners. That has been approved. The Navy has provided us with a letter approving our Master Plan, so that provision is there. What we are seeking from the legislature is to make sure the land is clear and that we request our Congresswoman to seek assistance from the U.S Congress to remove that reversionary clause so that there will be no problems with the landowners.

Senator vicente pangelinan: We are continually working with our Congresswoman to have that and these are not the only lands that are affected. There is probably only one federal transfer of property back, in the recent years under the excess lands in the BRAC return that is not subject to a reversionary clause and that is the property that gave the Guam Community College its property. All the other lands have a reversionary clause.

This land is in a little better position because once the Master Plan is approved we can move forward. So, I'm going to ask for the record if I could get a copy of that letter and enter that into the committee report.

Vivian Leon: Yes sir, we will provide one to you.

Senator vicente pangelinan: Thank you, if there is no other testimonies this public hearing is adjourned.

I want to thank you for this opportunity to provide testimony on behalf of the Jose D. Leon Guerrero Commercial Port regarding Bill No. 401-30 (COR) - An act to add a new §80105 (e) to Chapter 80 of Title 21, Guam Code Annotated, relative to the transfer of property under the jurisdiction of the Port Authority of Guam to the jurisdiction of the Guam Ancestral Lands Commission; Bill No. 402-30 (COR) - An act to add a new §80105 (f) to Chapter 80 of Title 21, Guam Code Annotated, relative to the transfer of property under the jurisdiction of the Port Authority of Guam to the jurisdiction of the Guam Ancestral Lands Commission and Bill No. 403-30 (COR) - An act to add a new §80105 (g) to Chapter 80 of Title 21, Guam Code Annotated, relative to the transfer of property under the jurisdiction of the Port Authority of Guam to the jurisdiction of the Guam Ancestral Lands Commission. This legislation is very similar to previous ones identifying different lots. And, like we have noted in the past, the Port Authority of Guam supports the intent of this legislation, but we do have some concerns that we feel need to be addressed before moving forward. Specifically, we believe that these lots identified in Bill Nos. 401-30, 402-30 and 403-30 may be wetlands that were set aside as mitigation for the transfer of land to Southern High. More research would need to be conducted by the Department of Land Management to clarify the status of these lands. Also, there may be easement issues contained within these lots that were established by the U.S. Navy so that matter would also need to be further investigated by Land Management.

We also are concerned that the transfer of these lands might conflict with the deed conditions placed upon them when they were returned to the Government of Guam. Specifically, there is a reversionary clause in the Quitclaim Deed which was executed on December 6, 1984 when the lands were conveyed to the Government of Guam. A section of the Quitclaim Deed states, "The lands hereby conveyed shall be used and developed by the Grantee only in accordance with that certain 'Commercial Port of Guam Master Plan, As Revised' dated February 1981 and prepared for the Port Authority of Guam by Maruyama and Associates, Ltd., Guam/Dravo Van Houten, Inc., New York, a copy of which is made part hereof by reference, or as said Master Plan may hereafter be amended with the approval of the Secretary of the Navy, or his designee (hereinafter referenced to as "Secretary"). The Quitclaim Deed further states that "In the event of any breach of the terms and conditions set forth hereinabove, as determined by the Secretary, regardless of the cause of such breach, all right, title and interest in and to the lands hereby conveyed, in their then existing conditions, including all improvements thereon, shall be at the option of the Secretary revert to and become the property of the United States immediately upon demand made in writing by the Secretary."

As a result of our concerns over this language and the pending transfer of the property back to the Ancestral Lands Commission, we recommend that the Governor and the Legislature solicit the assistance of Guam's Delegate to the United States Congress to introduce a bill to amend Section 818 of the U.S. Public Law 96-418, as amended, relative to removing the restrictive provisions on the use of said property and reversionary clause in said Quitclaim Deed. We believe that without this language being amended by Congress, the use of the property by the Ancestral Lands Commission or the original land owners could be in jeopardy.

In closing, I want to thank you for allowing the Port Authority of Guam this opportunity to present testimony on Bill Nos. 401-30, 402-30 and 403-30.




