



5 “(o) Limited term, part-time substitute teachers of the Guam Public
6 School System .”

7 **Section 2. Training for Substitute Teachers.** Beginning with the 2010-
8 2011 School Year and subsequent years, all substitute teachers hired by GPSS shall

1 undergo annual training prior to being placed in any classroom. The training *shall*,
2 at a minimum, consist of classroom management and student discipline and topics
3 to include, but *not* limited to: Health and Safety Issues, Child Abuse, Harassment /
4 Sexual Harassment, Relationships with Students, Confidentiality / Tort Liability,
5 Substance Abuse, Non-discrimination, and any other topics identified by the

I. OVERVIEW

The Committee on Education held a public hearing on Wednesday, June 24, 2009 at 9:00 a.m. on Bill No. 156 (COR) J. Won Pat / T.R. Muna-Barnes – which would allow for the hiring of substitute teachers and for subsequent training of those teachers.

Notices for the public hearings were disseminated to all local media via facsimile in accordance with the requirements of the Open Government Law and are attached herein.

II. SUMMARY OF TESTIMONY

- **Ms. Nerissa Bretania-Shafer, Ph.D.**, the Superintendent of the Guam Public School System provided oral testimony in support of Bill 156 (COR). She mentioned the need to be exempted from the freeze in hiring of temporary part-time positions, specifically substitute teachers to ensure that they have coverage for the coming school year when teachers are absent from the classroom.

Superintendent Shafer also stated that the most important part of the legislation is the mandatory training component for substitute teachers. She believes that it would be very beneficial for our students and teachers if there are properly trained substitute teachers ready to take over should the primary teacher become unavailable.

DISCUSSION

- **Senator Palacios** stated his support of the legislation. He suggested that there be put in place required number of hours of training which is currently not in the bill. But otherwise, he stated that the minimum topics for training set by the legislation are very appropriate.

- **Senator Muña-Barnes** asked whether additional resources would be needed to implement such training for substitute teachers.

- **Superintendent Shafer** replied that they would need additional resources but can be integrated with programs that are currently in existence. The first step, since the training will not be required until the following school year, is to develop, in conjunction with other educational leaders, a training system for the substitute teachers.

- There being no more comments and questions for the appointee, Chairwoman Won Pat concluded the hearing on Bill 156 (COR)

III. FINDINGS AND RECOMMENDATION

The Committee on Education to which Bill 156(COR) was referred, finds strong support for the passage of the bill and hereby submit its findings and recommendations to *I Mina' Trenta Na Liheslaturan Guahan* **TO DO PASS** Bill 156(COR).
