

1 **BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF GUAM:**

2 **Section 1.** A new §4127 is *added* to Chapter 4 of Title 4, Guam Code
3 Annotated, to read as follows:

4 **“§4127. Blood Donors’ Leave.** (a) Any employee of the
5 Government of Guam *shall* be granted administrative leave for the purpose
6 of donating blood. The amount of administrative leave *shall* be as follows:

- 1 (1) Two (2) hours of administrative leave for the donation of whole
2 blood;
- 3 (2) Three (3) hours of administrative leave for the donation of
4 platelets;
- 5 (3) Two (2) hours of administrative leave for blood donor
6 screening; and
- 7 (4) Additional leave may be granted in the event that the clinic
8 receiving the donation of blood determines that more time is
9 necessary for the donor to recover.

10 (b) The approving authority *may* require from the donor *up to* five
11 (5) days notice of the date of the blood donation. Nothing herein *shall* limit
12 the ability of the approving authority and the donor from coordinating
13 schedules of donation dates and times to accommodate the operations of the
14 agency.

15 (c) The clinics *shall* provide certification of the dates and times of
16 the employee's donation."



COMMITTEE REPORT DIGEST

I. OVERVIEW

The Committee on Labor, the Public Structure, Public Libraries, and Technology convened the public hearing on February 3, 2010 at 9:00 am in *I Liheslatura's* Public Hearing Room. Among the items on the agenda was the consideration of **Bill 277-30 (LS)** - An act to add a new §4127 to Chapter 4 of 4GCA relative to authorizing the granting of administrative leave for donations of blood. - By: **Ray Tenorio, E.B. Calvo, and T.R. Muna-Barnes**

Public Hearing Requirements

Notices of the hearing were disseminated via facsimile and email to all senators and all main media broadcasting outlets on January 27, 2010 (5-day Notice) and on February 1, 2010 (48-Hour notice) pursuant to meeting the requirements of the Open Government Law. Notice of the hearing was also posted on the Guam Legislature's website.

II. SUMMARY OF TESTIMONIES

Interim Chairman Adolpho B. Palacios, Sr. called the Committee on Labor, the Public Structure, Libraries, and Technology to order at 9:12am, welcomed and introduced Senators present.

Chairman Palacios then allowed the author of the bill, Senator Ray Tenorio to give a brief presentation of the bill.

Senator Ray Tenorio

This bill allows government employees to be given two (2) and three (3) hours of leave and administrative leave from their work for the purpose of donating blood, blood screening, as well as three (3) hours for the donation of platelets. Guam is very low in the nation in so far as blood donors. The bill would require authority the ability to giving five (5) notice in advance before the donor provides their employers the blood donation. It also may require that any clinics provide dates, times, and certifications of the donations. The difference between life and death is the ability to have blood available. Saving lives have been done by many governmental employees across the nation and as well as private employees who have giving time off from their work. In the case of Guam, government employees have to do this on Saturdays or wait in long periods of time because there are large crowds of people who are in line waiting to donate blood. The frequency of a government employee or any individual to donate blood is between two (2) and four (4) months apart. I don't think this is going to present a huge issue in regards to a number of people who are going to be away from work and providing blood which could save a life. Thank you very much for allowing me to present those facts Mr. Chairman.

Chairman Palacios called those who are present to testify.

Chairman Adolpho B. Palacios, Sr.

Mr. Garrido, please proceed.

Joe Garrido

I want to be on the record that I fully support this bill. I think it's a good bill. I really don't have more to say. This is something that is needed especially for Government of Guam employees. I have actually given blood and I remember being given two hours of administrative leave but what's good about this is that there is a lot more than the current law. I agree with this.

Chairman Adolpho B. Palacios, Sr.

I want to ask a question to the author: What happens if you both screen and donate? I would understand if it were only screening then they will determine you can/cannot donate blood. Please clarify.

Senator Ray Tenorio

This information is based on the research done that basically means a period of time acquired for reasonable in determining if you are eligible to provide the blood. Again, this is something that is scheduled and the government employee is given five (5) days notice to the employer. So if you need screening and at the end of it, you are able to provide the blood, I suppose you can have up to four hours. It also makes accommodations for individuals because the question has been: Has anyone ever been denied? I think that this sends a strong message to the community that the government has a role like everyone else does, in being the largest employer, to be able to provide us the means in which an employee can save a life by providing his or her blood plate. I do hope that we get the support of our colleagues. Thank you.

Chairman Adolpho B. Palacios, Sr. concludes bill being heard.

Chairman Palacios concluded the hearing and requested that written testimony be submitted within the next ten (10) days. He adjourned the hearing at **12:15pm**.

III. WRITTEN TESTIMONIES

Dr. Samuel Friedman, M.D.

I wish to strongly support Bil1277-30 (LS) introduced by Senators Ray Tenorio, E.B. Calvo and T.R. Muna-Barnes mandating administrative leave for donors of blood and blood products.

This is not only a selfless humanitarian act, but often a life saving one as well. As a hematologist and medical oncologist treating most of the cancer and leukemia cases on Guam and CNMI, my patients are often in need of the products of these donations, frequently on an urgent or emergency basis.

As you might know, I am one of the fiercest critics of the dysfunctional GMH and most of its staff. In regards to the blood bank however, and largely due to the professionalism and compassion of Glenda Pangelinan, the chief technologist of the blood bank, I have rarely had anything but praise for the performance of this entity.

There has often been delays in life saving platelet transfusions because of lack of available donors at times that are critical. I am sure this proposed bill would largely alleviate this problem and allow a much more fluid recruitment and donation policy to the benefit of all Guamanians, especially those in critical medical need.

IV. FINDINGS AND RECOMMENDATION

The Committee on Labor, the Public Structure, Public Libraries, and Technology to which **Bill No. 277-30 (LS)** was referred does hereby submit its findings and recommendations to *I Mina'Trenta na Liheslaturan Guåhan* **TO PASS** Bill No. 277-30 (LS) – “An act to add a new §4127 to Chapter 4 of 4GCA relative to authorizing the granting of administrative leave for donations of blood.”

The approving authority may require up to five (5) days notice from the donor of the date of the blood donation. All clinics shall provide certification of the dates and time of the employees donation.



**AN ACT TO ADD A NEW §4127 TO CHAPTER 4 OF 4GCA
RELATIVE TO AUTHORIZING THE GRANTING OF
ADMINISTRATIVE LEAVE FOR DONATIONS OF BLOOD.**

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF GUAM:

Section 1. A new section 4127 is *added* to Chapter 4 of 4GCA to read as follows:

§4127. Blood Donors' Leave. (a) Any employee of the Government of Guam shall be granted administrative leave for the purpose of donating blood. The amount of administrative leave shall be as follows:

(1) Two (2) hours of administrative leave for the donation of whole blood,

(2) Three (3) hours of administrative leave for the donation of platelets,

(3) Two (2) hours of administrative leave for blood donor screening, and

(4) Additional leave may be granted in the event that the clinic receiving the donation of blood determines that more time is necessary for the donor to recover.

(b) The approving authority *may* require up to five (5) days notice from the donor of the date of the blood donation. Nothing herein shall limit the ability of the approving authority and the donor from coordinating schedules of donation dates and times to accommodate the operations of the agency.

(c) Any clinics shall provide certification of the dates and times of the employees donation.
