**COMMITTEE REPORT DIGEST**

**I. OVERVIEW**

The Committee on Labor, the Public Structure, Public Libraries, and Technology convened the public hearing on February 18, 2010 at 1:30 pm in *I Liheslatura's* Public Hearing Room. Among the items on the agenda was the consideration of **Bill 284-30 (LS)** - An act to repeal §43119, Chapter 43, Title 5 Guam Code Annotated relative to abolishing a board and commission if they have not met with in a year of establishment.

Notices of the hearing were disseminated via facsimile and email to all senators and all main media broadcasting outlets on February 11, 2010 (5-day Notice) and on February 15, 2010 (48-Hour Notice) pursuant to meeting the requirements of the Open Government Law. Notice of the hearing was also posted on the Guam Legislature's website.

## **II. SUMMARY OF TESTIMONIES**

**Interim Chairman Adolpho B. Palacios, Sr. called the Committee on Labor, the Public Structure, Libraries, and Technology to order at 1:50pm, welcomed and introduced Senators present.**

### **Chairman Adolpho B. Palacios, Sr.**

Chairman Adolpho B. Palacios, Sr. reads the introduction of Bill No. 284, and then allows the author of the bill, Senator vicente c. pangelinan, to give a brief presentation of the bill.

### **Senator vicente c. pangelinan**

I just want to briefly say that the intent of this bill was to of course, insure legislative policy and territorial policy when laws are passed creating boards and commissions, being not frustrated from one entity by inaction rather than action. As you know, the legislature finds times need to create legislative bodies, executive branch commissions, by statute to meet a demand or a need, and the Governor has an opportunity to make a decision, weather or not he feels it will be appropriate to approve or disapprove the establishment of such board or commission. So, he gets the opportunity to either sign the bill into law or veto the bill. In effect, what the bill does in its present form, the government gets two times to veto the bill and the legislature gets zero time to override it. The Governor can first veto the bill by the stroke of his pen, and the legislature overrides it, the Governor can refuse to appoint any member to that board and commission, and then it get vetoed again, and then the board gets abolished because it doesn't meet. I think the legislative powers need to be preserved and the balance of power needs to be preserved, that when the legislature by virtue of passing a law the Governor by virtue of signing it into law or override by the legislature it gets put into place and the territorial policy continues to exists. So the proper action would be then to move forward with that peace of legislation or the establishment of the board. To me, the need that the legislature sees exists in terms of putting executive branch functions and even legislative branch functions accountable through the established boards and commissions. This in my opinion restores the balance of power between the legislative branch and the executive branch.

### **Chairman Adolpho B. Palacios, Sr.**

I would like to acknowledge Senator Taitague. Would you like to comment on the bill?

**Chairman Adolpho B. Palacios, Sr.**

I personally support this. I don't think we cannot just continue to create and establish these commissions voted by this body then only to not exists, because the appointing authority just refuse just to make appointments. If the appointing authority wishes to for ten (10) years, the commission will still wait for him to make an appointment. But I think we must restore that and I agree with the author of this bill, it is a very good reasoning behind this. Having said that no one has signed up to testify, I will consider Bill No. 284-30 duly heard.

**Chairman Palacios concluded the hearing and requested that written testimony be submitted within the next ten (10) days. He adjourned the hearing at 2:55pm.**

4           ~~§ 43119. Certain Boards & Commissions Abolished if Not Meeting.~~

5 Any board, commission, council or oversight body that has not met in the last twelve (12)  
6 months, with the exception of bodies relating to the Department of Education (*DOE*), the  
7 Guam Community College (*GCC*), the University of Guam (*UOG*) and the Guam

10 empowered with handling the respective mandate. In the event a body was created within

AN ACT TO REPEAL §43119, CHAPTER 43, TITLE 5  
GUAM CODE ANNOTATED RELATIVE TO  
ABOLISHING A BOARD AND COMMISSION IF THEY

ESTABLISHMENT.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF GUAM:

1           **Section 1. Legislative Findings and Intent.** *I Liheslaturan Guåhan* finds it  
2 necessary to repeal §43119, Chapter 43, Title 5 Guam Code Annotated in its entirety.  
3 Therefore it shall no longer read as follows:

4           **§ 43119. Certain Boards & Commissions Abolished if Not Meeting.**

5 ~~Any board, commission, council or oversight body that has not met in the last twelve (12)~~  
6 ~~months, with the exception of bodies relating to the Department of Education (DOE), the~~  
7 ~~Guam Community College (GCC), the University of Guam (UOG) and the Guam~~  
8 ~~Memorial Hospital Authority (AGMHA@), shall hereby be abolished. Any powers~~  
9 ~~vested in said boards, commissions or councils shall revert to the previous authority~~  
10 ~~empowered with handling the respective mandate. In the event a body was created within~~  
11 ~~a governmental entity to generally manage the affairs of matters relating to said entity,~~  
12 ~~that government entity shall assume the powers given to anybody abolished by this~~  
13 ~~Section. Should *I Maga'lahaen Guåhan* [Governor of Guam] identify the continued need~~  
14 ~~for such a board, commission, council or oversight body, *I Maga'lahaen Guåhan* [the~~

1 Governor] shall provide *Liheslaturan Guåhan* [the Legislature], within thirty (30) days  
2 of the enactment of this Act, justification for the reformulation of such body and a list of  
3 appropriate mandates.

4 **Section 2. Severability.** If any of the provisions of this Act or the application  
5 thereof to any person or circumstance is held invalid, such invalidity shall not affect any  
6 other provision or application of this Act which can be given effect without the invalid  
7 provision or application, and to this end the provisions of this Act are severable.
