

**AN ACT TO ADD A NEW §849.5 TO ARTICLE 1,
CHAPTER 8 OF TITLE 1, GUAM CODE ANNOTATED,
RELATIVE TO RENAMING THE *MERIZO*
COMMUNITY CENTER AS THE "SENATOR JOSE
MANALISAY ACFALLE COMMUNITY CENTER."**

1 **BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF GUAM:**

2 **Section 1. Legislative Findings and Intent.** *I Liheslaturan Guahan* finds
3 that former Senator Jose Manalisay Acfalle, a son of *Merizo* and a statesman in the
4 Seventh, Ninth and Tenth Guam Legislatures, was a champion on issues relating to
5 public safety, military and veterans affairs, as well as civic affairs. From providing
6 benefits for Vietnam Veterans, to being one of the founding fathers of the First

1 *Merizo* Water Festival, which now has become an annual village celebration,
2 Senator Jose Manalisay Acfalle was pro-active in community affairs and his
3 leadership was put to the benefit of the entire island.

4 It is, therefore, the intent of *I Liheslaturan Guåhan* to commemorate the
5 memory and contributions of the late Senator Jose Manalisay Acfalle by renaming
6 the present *Merizo* Community Center in his honor.

7 **Section 2.** A new §849.5 is hereby *added* to Article 1, Chapter 8 of Title 1,
8 Guam Code Annotated, to read as follows:

9 **“§849.5. Senator Jose Manalisay Acfalle Community Center.**

10 The *Merizo* Community Center, situated on Lot 505-9R3, in the
11 municipality of *Merizo*, *shall* hereafter be known as the “Senator Jose
12 Manalisay Acfalle Community Center.” Any provisions in the laws of
13 Guam referring to the *Merizo* Community Center are hereby deemed to read
14 the “Senator Jose Manalisay Acfalle Community Center.” The Mayor of
15 *Merizo* and members of the *Merizo* Municipal Planning Council, *shall* cause
16 to be erected appropriate nameplates bearing the name of the honoree and
17 other appropriate citations *shall* be placed at a conspicuous place on the
18 main building.”

19 **Section 3. Severability.** *If* any provision of this Law or its application to
20 any person or circumstance is found to be invalid or contrary to law, such
21 invalidity shall *not* affect other provisions or applications of this Law which can be
22 given effect without the invalid provisions or application, and to this end the
23 provisions of this Law are severable.

COMMITTEE REPROT DIGEST

I. OVERVIEW

The Committee on Municipal Affairs, Aviation, Housing and Recreation convened a public hearing on March 08, 2010 at 9:00 a.m. in *I Liheslatura's* Public Hearing Room. Among the items on the agenda was consideration of Bill No. 318-30 (COR) – “AN ACT TO ADD §849.3 TO TITLE 1 GUAM CODE ANNOTATED, RELATIVE TO RENAMING THE MERIZO COMMUNITY CENTER AS THE “JOSE MANALISAY ACFALLE BUILDING.”, sponsored by Adolpho B. Palacios, Sr..

The Public Hearing was Called-to-Order at 9:00 a.m.

II. SUMMARY OF TESTIMONY & DISCUSSION

Senator Barnes: Hafa Adai and good morning ladies and gentleman. Today is Monday March 8th. We are here for a public hearing from the committee on Municipal Affairs, Aviation, Housing and Recreation. I want to wish everybody here good morning to all of you. Today the items for public consideration is Bill 318-30 which is **AN ACT TO ADD §849.3 TO TITLE 1 GUAM CODE ANNOTATED, RELATIVE TO RENAMING THE MERIZO COMMUNITY CENTER AS THE “JOSE” MANALISAY ACFALLE BUILDING**. For our listening audience out there also joining me this morning is my colleague, Senator Adolpho Palacios. Si Yu'os Ma'ase for joining us and he's also the author of the legislation. So as we start this public hearing we are going to go ahead and ask Senator Palacios to talk about it. But Senator before we do that let me go ahead and see who we have, we have several people here who, people who will present oral testimony will be Mayor from Merizo, I said it right Mayor Chargulaf, please join us up here. I keep trying to recruit him

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because we worked twenty years together. Also wanting and wishing to speak is Francisco Tainatango who wishes to speak. Please join us on the podium. And also joining us ladies and gentleman is our other colleague Senator Frank Aguon Jr. Welcome Senator Aguon.

Ok we'll go ahead and do this. We do have a lot of members who wish to say they support the bill. We have Susan Reyes who says she just wants to support the bill, we have Victoria Tainatango, and we have Doris Lujan, Mary Tainatango who wishes to support it and Tina Tainatango, who wishes to support it. With that being said, we will yield to the author to speak a little bit about the bill. Senator Palacios?

Senator Palacios: Si Yu'os Ma'ase Madam Chair. Madam Chair the family about 4 or 5 weeks ago, we were talking about other issues and then it was brought to my attention that perhaps we can consider honoring the former senator Jose Manalisay Acfalle of Maleso by renaming the Merizo Community Center in his name. So I did some research and found out for the first time that the late senator served in the 7th, 9th and 10th Guam Legislature. And during his time Madam Chair he championed issues relating to public safety the military and veteran's affairs as well. And he was very involved in civic affairs in the village of Maleso. Also he was the founding father of the first Merizo Water Festival. Which now has come to be an annual village celebration. And so there are other areas of accomplishments which I'm sure there are too many to mention here. But I'm sure Madam Chair that he was at one time a colleague of this legislature and had served the people of Guam. And so the bill is now before us that proposes to name the Merizo Community Center as the Jose Manalisay Acfalle. And that is the background and we are here now and the families are here now to testify and we will hear what they have to say. Thank you Senator Palacios

Senator Barnes: *Buen Prubecho*, Senator Palacios. Mayor Chargulaf. Please state your name for the record.

Mayor Chargulaf: Good morning Senator Barnes, Senator Palacios, and Senator Aguon. For the record my name is Ernie Chargulaf, I'm the mayor of Merizo. Point of clarification Senator for the record, my father was one of the founders as well. Senator Acfalle who was the brother in law was my father's brother in law through his first wife. So he's one of the founding fathers. But for the record, these people had the community center improvement club, and they are the founders of what is now called the Maleso Fiestan Tasi. But it was names Merizo Water Festival back then. This is just for clarification. Anyways I'm in support of this bill. My late uncle I'm not only related to him by marriage but by blood as well. The late senator was my grandmother's first cousin. And then on my father's side he became my uncle through



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marriage to my mom. Anyways he left a legacy and I'm in support of that bill because anything that has to do with people serving the community they have every right to be acknowledged and honored and its due time. If this is the intent of the body, I fully support that because he left a legacy of service, not only to Merizo but to the entire island. Ane I'm proud that I'm related to the family because they are my first cousins, the kids of the senator. And like you said he left a legacy of service that shouldn't be forgotten and now it's going to be acknowledged and he's going to be honored. It will be an honor for me to go ahead and put his name on the community center because that's where I work out of and I fully support this. And I'm glad he is being given the accolade so the kids can take pride that their grandfather, their father and great grandfather was a statesman and he served the community of Guam but most especially make proud that he is from our own village. And I fully support this and I want to thank the body for taking this into consideration. And to my cousins I congratulate you guys for your dad being honored.

Senator Barnes: *Si Yu'os Ma'ase* Mayor Chargulaf. Mr. Tainatongo.

Francisco Tainatongo: Good morning Senator Barnes, Senator Palacios and Senator Aguon. My name is Francisco Tainatongo and one of the son in laws of Senator Acfalle. Myself and the family are very excited and with humility for this memorable occasion today. Giving us the opportunity to hear this accomplishment to put his name on the Merizo community center. I am not going to give a narrative report of the senator but really just too high light some information about him.

The late Senator joined the military in the late 40's in the United States Navy. After retiring became a fisherman. And then in the 60's he decided to run for a senate seat. He won three times and with this well accomplished gentleman both serving in the national service and the local here on Guam, I found it necessary to give this honor to this gentleman, the late Senator Acfalle. With that in mind, I ask each and every one of you to give a favorable vote if it comes to hearing this case. I would like to thank each and every one of you for giving us the opportunity to present in support of this cause. With that in mind I give thanks to each and everyone of you and we will be remembering you and in our prayers also. Thank you very much.

Senator Barnes: *Si Yu'os Ma'ase* Mr. Tainatongo. I'm going to go ahead and yield to my colleagues if they have any questions for the panel. Senator Aguon your recognized.

Senator Aguon: *Si Yu'os Ma'ase* Madam Chair. When I look at this bill I have a small problem. Senator Palcios name is on the bill but Senator Frank Aguon, a man from the south isn't. That's a small problem. Despite that I certainly recognize Mayor



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and Mr. T., thank you for coming out and presenting your support and perspective in this. I think that anytime we come out and recognize individuals in the community who have given up themselves. And when I say given up themselves, regardless if its Mayor or Vice Mayor in non profit and civic organizations or a senator in an elected capacity, I think there ultimately there has to be that recognition that these are homegrown individuals regardless to what their nationality are who gave back to the community and that's where in this particular case Senator Acfalle really had representatives out, came into the legislative body, served for three terms and rendered himself to the entire island and community. And I'm certainly honored to support this legislation and I fully support it and you have my support on this bill and the only suggestion I would have Madam Chair and Senator Palacios is not only Frank Aguon Jr add ional as a co-sponsor but I know the chairperson always supersedes any other names so but I will yield to that. But rather calling it the building, I would recommend we name it the "Jose Manalisay Acfalle Center". Because down the road there may be a possibility with the development and what not where the community center may be relocated. The idea here is to honor a person who has contributed back to the community and was one of the pioneers in Maleso in terms of serving the island. So I would recommend that infact it be called the community center so that is the center was to be relocated elsewhere, then obviously that name and that honor would follow that particular building. Because it's not the building we are trying to honor in terms of naming it after this senator, but it is honoring that individual who should really be recognized by the entire island community. A good example, what happens if this community breaks down and if it transfers they may not take the name to the new building? It won't be the same as the original. That would be my suggestion in addition to including my name as a co-sponsor. *Si Yu'os Ma'ase* gentlemen for your contribution and your statements this morning. Thank you madam chair.

Senator Barnes: Thank you Senator Aguon. Mayor Chargulaf would like to say a few words.

Mayor Chargulaf: Just to bring back an added request for funding to renovate that building because right now the building is in a deplorable state. And it's only right if we are going to name it after a senator that this body renovates that place so it becomes what it is a community center where people can take pride. Right now the rest rooms and everything in there is in need of renovation. So I would like to see if the body here can follow up on the funding source. Thank you. Senator Pangelinan good morning, Senator Ada, just to ask this body to look into the funding since we are renaming in his honor and as a senator, senators you should consider to make sure the funding comes through so the building you know so we take pride in the building. Thank you!



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Senator Barnes: Thank you Mayor Chargulaf. Also joining me this morning Senator Tom Ada, also joining us and also Speaker Pangelinan thank you for joining us. Senator Ada, do you have any comments? Nothing. Speaker Ben, before I have the author speak. Speaker Ben.

Senator Pangelinan: Yes, I'm going to ask the good mayor right after this meeting to please go up to adelup and ask the good governor to sign bill 317 because funding for that renovation is provided in that bill. So if you could do us that favor and if you could use your influence there. Then we can get going. We did hear you when you said you need that and this body responded to that request.

Mayor Chargulaf: Thank you!

Senator Barnes: Senator Palacios

Senator Palacio: Thank you Madam Chair. Madam Chair that's a good point that was raised by Senator Aguon, instead of using the term building, center. So that no matter where the center is, that is the center. No matter what building it's in it's the center so that's a good point. I would like to make at this point the adjustment on page one line six. I fixed up the testimony of the mayor with respect, after the word veteran and insert between the "To" and the "The" veterans and to being "**one of the founding fathers**" of the Merizo because I understand that he was not alone and if that was not adjusted then, it would appear that he was alone. And I think that we should give credit to those not necessarily mention but to the fact to being one of the founding fathers of the first Merizo Water Festival. I think that would be a more appropriate notation there. You see I didn't know to that extent and when I was reading this those are historical information that should be mention and that's my comment. Thank you Madam Chair.

Senator Barnes: Thank you Senator Palacios. Senator, I mean Mayor Chargulaf as I was looking through this bill I asked, I still want to try and recruit him and hoping he will come on board on the democrat side. I want to thank the author of the legislation because as we were speaking on the bill I automatically yielded to him and asked if I could be second co-sponsor to this and as I was reading through it and I wanted to ask you Mayor, what relation is this to the former Mayor Acfalle. The father of Ben and those guys.

Mayor Chargulaf: They are related. I think he is the nephew to the late senator.



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Senator Barnes: The uncle. Ok. You know you are so right mayor and Mr. Tainatongo when you acknowledge the civic duties and the volunteerism that our own residence on the island to give back to their community what they've been blessed to be given. It makes me even more proud as a Chamorro to say that I stand before you guys to acknowledge and support the effort and to give recognition for generations to come. And renaming this with the support of the mayor and the family and friends. What way to offer a small token to a man who has served in this body and also to give back to his community as you said was one of the founding members of what we call today the Maleso Fiestan Tasi that continues to grow and grow and bring the awareness out of the beautiful village of Maleso. And I want to thank the author for letting me be part of the sponsorship. Is there anyone else who wishes.

Francisco Tainatongo: Senator my wife wants to testify.

Senator Barnes: Yes, *maila, put fabot.*

Francisco Tainatongo: She gets emotional so just excuse her

Senator Barnes: *Put fabot*, just state your name for the record and if you support the bill.

Victoria Tainatongo: Hi good morning. My name is Victoria Acfalle Tainatongo. And good morning senators. I didn't really want to talk. Because I'm just an emotional person whatever it is. Especially you know thinking back of my dad. For so many years after my dad died, my husband and I kept talking about naming a building in Merizo and we just kept putting it off. Especially me, I tend to forget. But this year he finally asked me, when we are going to name a building in Merizo. So we finally decided to see Senator Palacios and I want to thank him for that, thank you senator Tina and all the other senators. I know it's a big honor for us daughters knowing there's a building being named after my dad. Even my two daughters who are attending school this morning. They really wanted to come because they kept asking us how you can name a building under my dad's name. I guess they wanted to experience and come and see how they do it. But my husband doesn't want them to miss school, so I'm glad it's on TV. and maybe they can see it later on today. But like I said, I thank you all for naming the building under my father the late Senator Jose Manalisay Acfalle. Yes my dad was in the navy, retired, fisherman and senator. But he didn't have boys, he had girls. His girls were also fisherwomen. If you don't know how to swim they will throw down in the water and you will flap your arms. So I'm very proud and I thank you all. Like I said, I wasn't trying to come up here and talk because I know I'm going to end up crying. So I want to thank you all and have a nice day and we will remember you in our prayers.

ANNOTATED, RELATIVE TO RENAMING THE MERIZO
COMMUNITY CENTER AS THE "JOSE MANALISAY
ACFALLE BUILDING."

1 **BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF GUAM:**

2 **Section 1. Legislative Findings and Intent.** *I Liheslaturan Guåhan* finds that
3 former Senator Jose Manalisay Acfalle, a son of Merizo and a statesman in the Seventh,
4 Ninth and Tenth Guam Legislature, was a champion on issues relating to public safety,
5 military and veteran affairs as well as civic affairs. From providing benefits for Vietnam
6 Veterans, to the founding of the First Merizo Water Festival, which now has become an
7 annual village celebration, Senator Jose Manalisay Acfalle was pro-active in community
8 affairs and his leadership was put to the benefit of the entire island.

9 It is therefore the intent of *I Liheslaturan Guåhan* to commemorate the memory
10 and contributions of the late Senator Jose Manalisay Acfalle by renaming the present
11 Merizo Community Center in his honor.

12 **Section 2.** §849.3 is hereby added to Chapter 8, Article 1 of Title 1 Guam Code
13 Annotated to read as follows:

14 "§849.3. **Jose Manalisay Acfalle Building.** The Merizo Community Center,
15 situated on LOT 505-9-R3, in the municipality of Merizo, shall hereafter be known as the

1 “Senator Jose Manalisay Acfalle Building.” Any provisions in the laws of Guam
2 referring to the Merizo Community Center are hereby deemed to read the “Senator Jose
3 Manalisay Acfalle Building.” The Mayor of Merizo and members of the Merizo
4 Municipal Planning Council , shall cause to be erected appropriate nameplates bearing
5 the name of the honoree and other appropriate citations shall be placed at a conspicuous
6 place on the main building.”

7 **Section 3. Severability.** If any provision of this Law or its application to any
8 person or circumstance is found to be invalid or contrary to law, such invalidity shall not
9 affect other provisions or applications of this Law which can be given effect without the
10 invalid provisions or application, and to this end the provisions of this Law are severable.
