

**AN ACT TO AMEND §40110 (a) AND (b) OF CHAPTER

1 **BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF GUAM:**

2 **Section 1.** §40110 (a) and (b) of Chapter 40 of Title 5 of the Guam Code
3 Annotated are hereby *amended* to read as follows:

4 **“§40110. Vacancies.**

5 (a) Vice-Mayors. A vacancy in the office of the Vice-Mayor
6 *shall* be filled for the unexpired term. The vacancy *shall* be filled by *I*

1 *Maga'lahi* (the Governor) by appointment after soliciting the non-
2 binding recommendations of the Municipal Planning Council of the
3 municipality in which the vacancy occurs, subject to the advice and
4 consent of *I Liheslatura* (the Legislature).

5 (b) Mayors. *If* by reason of death, resignation, removal from
6 office, inability or failure to perform, there *shall* be a vacancy in the
7 office of the Mayor, it *shall* be filled for the unexpired term. The
8 vacancy *shall* be filled by *I Maga'lahi* (the Governor) by appointment
9 after soliciting the non-binding recommendations of the Municipal
10 Planning Council of the municipality in which the vacancy occurred,
11 subject to the advice and consent of *I Liheslatura* (the Legislature);
12 *provided, however,* that in a municipality where there is a Vice-
13 Mayor, the Vice-Mayor *shall* automatically assume the position of
14 Mayor and there *shall* be a vacancy in the position of Vice-Mayor.”

15 **Section 2. Severability.** *If* any provision of this law or its application to
16 any person or circumstance is found to be invalid or contrary to law, such
17 invalidity shall *not* affect other provisions or applications of this law which can be
18 given effect without the invalid provisions or applications, and to this end the
19 provisions of this law are severable.



COMMITTEE REPORT DIGEST

I. OVERVIEW

The Committee on Municipal Affairs, Aviation, Housing and Recreation convened a public hearing on May 21, 2010 at 9:04 AM in *I Liheslatura's* Public Hearing Room. Among the items on the agenda was the consideration of Bill No. 374-30 (COR) – “An act to amend §40110 (a) and (b) of Chapter 40, Title 5 of the Guam Code Annotated relative to the filling of vacancies for Mayors and Vice Mayors.,” sponsored by Senator Frank Blas Jr.

Public Notice Requirements

Notices were disseminated via e-mail to all senators and all main media broadcasting outlets on May 12, 2010 (5-Day Notice), and again on May 19, 2010 (48-Hour Notice).

The public hearing was Called-to-Order at 9:04 AM.

II. SUMMARY OF TESTIMONY & DISCUSSION

Dededo Mayor Melissa Savares—Current law reads that should the vacancy for Mayor or Vice Mayor during the current term, we have had two deaths during terms, the municipal planning council will make a recommendation to the Gov and the Gov will make the appt and the appt will be final by the confirmation hearing by the legislature. The vacancy will be filled at the next General Election. So should it be a gubernatorial race, which this is the second time this is happening, within the last 6 years, we are faced with a general election, which is a gubernatorial race and not a mayoral race. It doesn't give the appointee enough time to work with the community and produce, work well and fulfill the mission of the previous mayor or vice mayor. So what I am doing, I am asking, I am in support of this being amended to say that the election will be at the next mayoral election rather than the next general election. That way, the individual who is appointed and confirmed to serve in the community, will serve until the end of that mayoral term rather than disrupting the community activities and programs once it's started for that individual. It gives them time, unlike the senators, the mayors and vice mayors like the governor and Lt. governor have four year terms, which is a lot, we have more time, we're not just sitting and campaigning. We have time to fulfill programs and

see that these programs and activities or beautification projects are actually started and seen to the end of the project rather than being disrupted by a general election.

TRMB—Did the mayor's council as a group talk about this issue and was there a resolution introduced?

MS—there was a resolution of support for this bill to this effect to assure that it will be in the next mayoral election rather than the next general election.

TRMB—there were no major concerns?

MS—no, no

TRMB—so it's supported by the whole body?

MS—yes, yes

TRMB—I appreciate that and we would appreciate if we could have that resolution submitted.

MS—we will do that, Angel will be preparing that and bringing it by your office.

Sen. Palacios—I think the concerns of the mayors to support that idea is already noted under (b) that the unexpired term be filled in the next general election of the mayor and vice mayor, so that's all we need to do and I thought that that has always been the case but when this last appointment was made that I found out that it's not the case but I had assumed that the vacancy, that the term of the mayor who passed away does not expire until the next mayoral election.

MS—it happened in the case where Mayor Tainatango and Vice Mayor Chaco had passed away and in the following year was a gubernatorial race. We work as colleagues and we all try to help each other work with programs and give each other ideas to make your community successful and when we start working with someone who was appointed and confirmed and then they have to hurry up and campaign because there's opponents running against them, it sets them back from the mission of the deceased mayor or vice mayor.

TRMB—thank you Mayor Savares, Mr. Sablan, Director Sablan

Angel Sablan—Buenas, good morning. We do support the intent of the bill, we have a case right now, we have an appointed vice mayor who finds himself now, because he wants to run for that office, spend some time campaigning instead of fulfilling his duties as vice mayor. And I think the intent of the law is for mayors and vice mayors elections, if you read it, but then again there's already been precedent set, as Mayor Savares said,

with the untimely death of Mayor Tainatango, we had an appointment and then we had an election of the mayor to fill that position in a non-mayoral year. Why it was not question then, I don't know. It just makes sense. It certainly, if anything else, it only makes sense that if we're going to fill a position, we fill it until the next unexpired term and not until the next general election. We almost had that position put on the special election because there's also a law that says special elections are general elections. And so someone could have actually brought that up and had the GEC make that determination to have a vice mayor's election in the passed special election for the legislature. So to correct all that, we thank Senator Blas for introducing this legislation. I don't know if it can help right now but it certainly in the future will so we support the legislation.

III. FINDINGS & RECOMMENDATIONS

Based on testimony provided by the Executive Director of the Mayor's Council of Guam, Angel Sablan and the President of the Mayor's Council of Guam, Melissa Savares, the Mayor's Council is in support of this legislation. Additionally, the Mayors have passed a resolution attesting to the support of all mayors and vice mayors for Bill 374-30.

The Committee on Municipal Affairs, Aviation, Housing and Recreation hereby reports out Bill No. 374-30 (COR), as introduced by the Committee, with the recommendation TO PASS.




