**AN ACT TO REFER TO KGTF *OR* KGTF TV-12 AS PBS
GUAM IN ANY LAWS OF GUAM.**

1 **BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF GUAM:**

2 **Section 1. Legislative Findings and Intent.** *I Liheslaturan Guåhan*
3 finds that Guam's public television station, KGTF *or* KGTF TV-12, has changed
4 its name to PBS Guam, to align with the national Public Broadcasting Service
5 (PBS) brand. Therefore, it is the intent of *I Liheslaturan Guåhan* to ensure that
6 any reference in Guam law to "KGTF" *or* "KGTF TV-12" *shall* be hereinafter
7 referred to read and mean "PBS Guam".

1 **Section 2. References to KGTF or KGTF TV-12.** The Compiler of
2 Laws *shall* make the necessary changes in Public Law that all future references in
3 any law referring to “KGTF” or “KGTF-TV 12” *shall* mean and be read as “PBS
4 Guam” *except* as it refers to the FCC Call Sign and License and the Guam
5 Educational Telecommunications Corporation Charter.







I. OVERVIEW

The Committee on Tourism, Cultural Affairs, Youth and Public Broadcasting scheduled a **Public Hearing on Monday, March 16, 2009 at 9 AM** in the Legislature’s Public Hearing Room. Among the items on day’s Agenda for public consideration was Bill No. 75 (LS) – “An act to refer KGTF or KGTF TV-12 as PBS Guam in any laws of Guam.”

Public Notice Requirements

Notices were sent via e-mail and/or fax to all Senators and main media broadcasting outlets on:

- March 5, 2009, giving five-days notice; and again on
- March 11, 2009, giving two-days notice.

The Public Hearing on Bill No. 75 (LS) was **called to order** at 9:55 AM.

II. SUMMARY OF TESTIMONY

VICE SPEAKER CRUZ opened the hearing making all proper announcements.

DR. SAM MABINI, General Manager PBS-Guam, appeared before the Committee in SUPPORT of Bill No. 75 (LS), expressing appreciation for the legislation because it aligns PBS-Guam with the national PBS. Additionally it aligns PBS-Guam with a new digital era, new programs, improved educational outreach, grant funding, and partnerships with Guam’s educational institutions.

BEN FLORES, Founder KGTF TV-12, appeared before the Committee in full SUPPORT of Bill No. 75 expressing the name change as being appropriate for recognizing Guam under the banner of public broadcast.

DAN HO, Creative Director PBS-Guam, appeared before the Committee in SUPPORT of Bill No. 75 (LS), expressing appreciation because it allows PBS-Guam to redefine a product in era when TV is

becoming an anachronism. The name change allows PBS-Guam to align with a global model with local programming defined in way the world can recognize.

SENATOR PANGELINAN asked if the name switch to PBS means KGTF TV-12 means the station is becoming PBS and not Guam and what are the responsibilities and requirements of KGTF TV-12 to become PBS-Guam.

DR. SAM MABINI, General Manager PBS-Guam, stated that the mission for PBS-Guam remains the same regardless of the name change. PBS-Guam is responsible for bringing free quality educational programming and news broadcasts to the public regardless of the type of TV they use. Additionally, being PBS-Guam allows people worldwide to view programming they would not have seen were the station still KGTF TV-12.

DAN HO, Creative Director PBS-Guam, stated KGTF is a harder product to sell, but PBS-Guam gives the station more accessibility. Furthermore, having the PBS title allows the station to reach a broader audience they may not have attained as KGTF. From a numerical standpoint, shows on PBS-Guam have an increased opportunity to make money based on the PBS platform.

SENATOR PANGELINAN asked how much money PBS-Guam has made since the name change.

DR. SAM MABINI, General Manager PBS-Guam, stated the name change happened in December 2008, therefore, they have not accrued funds. However, new programs under the PBS moniker stand to bring in revenue in the future.

SENATOR PANGELINAN stated his main concern is losing the Guam identity because they have signed into the PBS philosophy.

SENATOR ESPALDON asked if there are negatives to fitting into the criteria that PBS mandates.

DR. SAM MABINI, General Manager PBS-Guam, stated that the mission of PBS-Guam remains the same as it was when they were called KGTF.

SENATOR AGUON asked for the official name of the entity.

DR. SAM MABINI, General Manager PBS-Guam, stated Guam Educational Telecommunications Corporation.

SENATOR RECTOR stated the Guam Federation of Teachers wanted to keep their Guam identity, which is why they avoided changing their name to the American Federation of Teachers Guam. Senator Rector then asked if PBS-Guam employees signed leave to testify at the public hearing.

SENATOR BLAS asked what that question had to do with the legislation.

The Public Hearing on Bill No. 75 was **adjourned** at **10:25 A.M.**





AN ACT TO REFER KGTF OR KGTF TV-12 AS
PBS GUAM IN ANY LAWS OF GUAM.

1 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF GUAM:

2 Section 1. Legislative Intent. *I Liheslaturan Guahan* finds that Guam's
3 public television station, KGTF or KGTF TV-12, has changed its name to align
4 with the national Public Broadcasting Service (PBS) brand to PBS Guam.
5 Therefore it is the intent of *I Liheslaturan Guahan* to ensure that any reference
6 in Guam law to "KGTF" or "KGTF TV-12" shall be hereinafter referred to
7 read and mean "PBS Guam".

8 Section 2. References to KGTF or KGTF TV-12. The Compiler of Laws
9 shall make the necessary changes in the Guam Code Annotated to ensure that
10 any reference in any law to "KGTF" or "KGTF-TV 12" shall hereafter mean
11 and be read as "PBS Guam".
