



**AN ACT TO AMEND §10306 OF ARTICLE 3, CHAPTER

1 **BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF GUAM:**

2 **Section 1.** §10306 of Article 3, Chapter 10 of Title 5, Guam Code Annotated, is
3 *amended* to read as follows:

4 **“§10306. Information Required.**

1 The following information must be posted, at a minimum, on each
2 official website or homepage required pursuant to Section 10305 above.

3 1. Notice of all meetings, hearings and public events as required
4 by public law and for such duration as required by public law and
5 containing such information as is required by public law.

6 2. The official name of the department, agency, autonomous
7 agency or public corporation in both English and Chamorro, the email
8 address, public phone numbers, mailing address and physical location of the
9 department, agency, autonomous agency or public corporation.

10 3. The names and titles of the Director, Deputy Director or official
11 in charge of the department, agency, autonomous agency or public
12 corporation, as appropriate, as well as the names and titles of the
13 administrators of each and all offices, programs, services, units or divisions
14 under its purview, and the names of all board members of every board or
15 commission associated with or appurtenant thereto, and an organizational
16 chart demonstrating the relationships between all, as relevant.

17 4. A list of all fees charged for any services.

18 5. All rules and regulations in force as promulgated by the
19 department, agency, autonomous agency or public corporation, or links
20 thereto, as well as all proposed rules and regulations, or amendments
21 thereto, as are progressing through the administrative adjudication process
22 as detailed in the Administrative Adjudication Act.

23 6. The budget for the department, agency, autonomous agency or
24 public corporation as is in force and approved by *I Liheslaturan Guåhan* or
25 the governing board as appropriate, as well as the proposed budget for the
26 upcoming fiscal year, and in such form as is submitted to or approved by *I*
27 *Liheslaturan Guåhan* or the governing board as appropriate, and all

1 expenditures of the department, agency, autonomous agency or public
2 corporation, such entries to be updated on a quarterly basis.

3 7. The awardee, amount, duration and a general description of all
4 contracts of any nature as entered into by the department, agency,
5 autonomous agency or public corporation, such entries to be updated on a
6 quarterly basis.

7 8. The amount of and a general description of all grants received by
8 the department, agency, autonomous agency or public corporation.

9 9. The hours of operation of the department, agency, autonomous
10 agency or public corporation, and all programs, units or services under its
11 purview.

12 10. A general description of the areas of responsibility of the
13 department, agency, autonomous agency or public corporation, and all
14 offices, programs, services, units or divisions under its purview, as well as
15 any public reports, studies and publications as the public might expect
16 access to under Guam law.

17 11. The results of audits, or links thereto, of the department,
18 agency, autonomous agency or public corporation, or any component or
19 service of same.

20 12. In the case of a department, agency, autonomous agency or
21 public corporation that generates its own income through fees for services
22 or other fees, an annual statement detailing collection and income derived
23 from such fees.

24 13. All blank applications and other forms for services, licenses,
25 government benefits, etc., of all agencies, autonomous agencies, public
26 corporations and instrumentalities of the government of Guam. In the event
27 that the nature of a form or application prevents it from being posted (such

1 as carbon copy forms), the agency *shall* state on its website the reasons that
2 such form cannot be posted. To the extent possible and practical, the
3 agencies *shall* make the forms available in fill-able/savable/printable Adobe
4 portable document format (PDF). Notwithstanding the requirements, *supra*,
5 of this Subsection; the Unified Judiciary *shall* within its rule-making
6 authority determine which documents *shall* be posted on its website and the
7 form and manner in which such documents are to be posted.

8 Nothing in this Section shall be construed as limiting the information
9 that a department, agency, autonomous agency or public corporation may
10 provide to the general public via a homepage or website.”

COMMITTEE REPORT DIGEST

I. OVERVIEW

The Committee on Labor, the Public Structure, Public Libraries, and Technology convened the public hearing on May 20, 2010 at 9:10 a.m. in *I Liheslatura's* Public Hearing Room. Among the items on the agenda was the consideration of Bill 380-30 (LS) - "An act to amend §10306 of Chapter 10 of 5GCA relative to posting forms and applications of government of Guam agencies on the internet" sponsored by **T. Taitague, V.A. Ada, E.J.B. Calvo, and F.B. Aguon, Jr.**

Public Hearing Requirements

Notices of the hearing were disseminated via facsimile and email to all senators and all main media broadcasting outlets on May 16, 2010 (5-day Notice) and on May 18, 2010 (48-Hour notice) pursuant to meeting the requirements of the Open Government Law. Notice of the hearing was also posted on the Guam Legislature's website.

Senators Present

Senator Adolpho B. Palacios, Sr., Chairman

2. Andrew Quenga, Judiciary of Guam, Did not state Support or Oppose, Oral Testimony
3. Noel Lazaga, In Support of the Bill, Did not submit Oral or Written Testimony

II. SUMMARY OF TESTIMONIES

Chairman Adolpho B. Palacios, Sr. called the **Committee on Labor, the Public Structure, Libraries, and Technology** to order at 9:10 a.m., welcomed and introduced Senators present.

Chairman Adolpho B. Palacios, Sr.

Chairman Palacios read the title of Bill No. 380-30(LS). The author of the Bill, Senator Telo Taitague, was off-island at the time. The chairman explained that the bill would require all Government of Guam agencies to post forms online. He explained that placing all forms online would improve the convenience of accessing forms and would eliminate much of the costs associated with reproducing documents.

Maria Cenzon

Maria Cenzon stated that she and Andrew Quenga recognize the benefits of providing forms and information online, but are concerned that the language of the bill may be construed to include all kinds of pleadings that are filed with the courts.

Chairman Adolpho B. Palacios, Sr.

The Chairman suggested that the agencies may have more discretion as to which forms are available online and that it is appropriate to the needs of residents.

Maria Cenzon

Ms. Cenzon agreed that agencies should have some degree of discretion.

Chairman Adolpho B. Palacios, Sr.

The Chairman stated that the concern that the language of the bill is all-encompassing. He then requested that Ms. Cenzon and Andrew Quenga submit written testimony.

Maria Cenzon

Ms. Cenzon stated that they will provide written testimony.

Andrew Quenga

Mr. Quenga stated that the court does not wish to be out of compliance with any law. He believes the law should be clarified to give the court discretion to publish only certain pleading forms, and thus not be found in violation of the law. The court provides services and forms in support of litigants to allow greater access to justice.

Chairman Adolpho B. Palacios, Sr.

The Chairman asked that the language can be drafted to that effect. He suggested that a provision be made to ensure the public is informed if and when forms are not available online, that forms may be obtained at the agency. He asked that the Attorney General

could also be provided with the bill and asked for comment, especially if allowances must be made for the needs of that office, as well.

Chairman Palacios declared that Bill No. 380-30(LS) is duly heard.

Chairman Palacios concluded the hearing and requested that written testimony be submitted within the next ten (10) days. He adjourned the hearing at 9:55 a.m.

III. WRITTEN TESTIMONIES

No written testimony received within the ten (10) day period after the public hearing.

IV. FINDINGS AND RECOMMENDATIONS

The Committee on Labor, the Public Structure, Public Libraries, and Technology to which Bill No. 380-30 (LS) was referred does hereby submit its findings and recommendations to *I Mina'Trenta na Liheslaturan Guåhan* **TO PASS** Bill 380-30 (LS) - "An act to amend §10306 of Chapter 10 of 5GCA relative to posting forms and applications of government of Guam agencies on the internet." A substituted version has been submitted which adds that in the event that nature of a form or application prevents it from being posted (such as carbon copy forms), the agency shall state on its website that reasons that such form cannot be posted. To the extent possible and practical, the agencies shall make the forms available in fill-able/savable/printable Adobe portable document format (PDF) and that the Unified Judiciary shall within its rule-making authority determine which documents shall be posted on its website and the form and manner in which such documents are to be posted. BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF GUAM:

Section 1. Section 10306 of Chapter 10 of 5GCA is *amended* to read as follows:

§10306. Information Required.

The following information must be posted, at a minimum, on each official website or homepage required pursuant to Section 10305 above.

1. Notice of all meetings, hearings and public events as required by public law and for such duration as required by public law and containing such information as is required by public law.

2. The official name of the department, agency, autonomous agency or public corporation in both English and Chamorro, the email address, public phone numbers, mailing address and physical location of the department, agency, autonomous agency or public corporation.

3. The names and titles of the Director, Deputy Director or official in charge of the department, agency, autonomous agency or public corporation, as appropriate, as

1 well as the names and titles of the administrators of each and all offices, programs,
2 services, units or divisions under its purview, and the names of all board members of
3 every board or commission associated with or appurtenant thereto, and an
4 organizational chart demonstrating the relationships between all, as relevant.

5 4. A list of all fees charged for any services.

6 5. All rules and regulations in force as promulgated by the department, agency,
7 autonomous agency or public corporation, or links thereto, as well as all proposed rules
8 and regulations, or amendments thereto, as are progressing through the administrative
9 adjudication process as detailed in the Administrative Adjudication Act.

10 6. The budget for the department, agency, autonomous agency or public
11 corporation as is in force and approved by *I Liheslaturan Guåhan* or the governing

4 11. The results of audits, or links thereto, of the department, agency, autonomous

6 12. In the case of a department, agency, autonomous agency or public
7 corporation that generates its own income through fees for services or other fees, an
8 annual statement detailing collection and income derived from such fees.

9 13. All forms and applications for services, licenses, government benefits, etc of
10 all agencies, autonomous agencies, public corporations and instrumentalities of the
11 government of Guam. In the event that nature of a form or application prevents it from
12 being posted (such as carbon copy forms), the agency shall state on its website that
13 reasons that such form cannot be posted. To the extent possible and practical, the
14 agencies shall make the forms available in fill-able/savable/printable Adobe portable
15 document format (PDF). Notwithstanding the requirements, *supra*, of this paragraph;
16 the Unified Judiciary shall within its rule-making authority determine which documents
17 shall be posted on its website and the form and manner in which such documents are to
18 be posted.

19 Nothing in this Section shall be construed as limiting the information that a
20 department, agency, autonomous agency or public corporation may provide to the







AN ACT TO AMEND §10306 OF CHAPTER 10 OF 5GCA
RELATIVE TO POSTING FORMS AND APPLICATIONS OF
GOVERNMENT OF GUAM AGENCIES ON THE INTERNET.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF GUAM:

Section 1. Section 10306 of Chapter 10 of 5GCA is *amended* to read as follows:

§10306. Information Required.

The following information must be posted, at a minimum, on each official website or homepage required pursuant to Section 10305 above.

1. Notice of all meetings, hearings and public events as required by public law and for such duration as required by public law and containing such information as is required by public law.

2. The official name of the department, agency, autonomous agency or public corporation in both English and Chamorro, the email address, public phone numbers, mailing address and physical location of the department, agency, autonomous agency or public corporation.

3. The names and titles of the Director, Deputy Director or official in charge of the department, agency, autonomous agency or public corporation, as appropriate, as well as the names and titles of the administrators of each and all offices, programs, services, units or divisions under its purview, and the names of all board members of

1 every board or commission associated with or appurtenant thereto, and an
2 organizational chart demonstrating the relationships between all, as relevant.

3 4. A list of all fees charged for any services.

4 5. All rules and regulations in force as promulgated by the department, agency,
5 autonomous agency or public corporation, or links thereto, as well as all proposed rules
6 and regulations, or amendments thereto, as are progressing through the administrative
7 adjudication process as detailed in the Administrative Adjudication Act.

8 6. The budget for the department, agency, autonomous agency or public
9 corporation as is in force and approved by *I Liheslaturan Guåhan* or the governing
10 board as appropriate, as well as the proposed budget for the upcoming fiscal year, and
11 in such form as is submitted to or approved by *I Liheslaturan Guåhan* or the governing
12 board as appropriate, and all expenditures of the

13 department, agency, autonomous agency or public corporation, such entries to be
14 updated on a quarterly basis.

15 7. The awardee, amount, duration and a general description of all contracts of any
16 nature as entered into by the department, agency, autonomous agency or public
17 corporation, such entries to be updated on a quarterly basis.

18 8. The amount of and a general description of all grants received by the
19 department, agency, autonomous agency or public corporation.

20 9. The hours of operation of the department, agency, autonomous agency or
21 public corporation, and all programs, units or services under its purview.

22 10. A general description of the areas of responsibility of the department, agency,
23 autonomous agency or public corporation, and all offices, programs, services, units or
24 divisions under its purview, as well as any public reports, studies and publications as
25 the public might expect access to under Guam law, ~~or links thereto, and forms, notices~~
26 ~~or circulars required to be used by the public while interacting with the department,~~

1 ~~agency, autonomous agency or public corporation, and all offices, programs, services,~~
2 ~~units or divisions under its purview.~~

3 11. The results of audits, or links thereto, of the department, agency, autonomous
4 agency or public corporation, or any component or service of same.

5 12. In the case of a department, agency, autonomous agency or public
6 corporation that generates its own income through fees for services or other fees, an
7 annual statement detailing collection and income derived from such fees.

8 13. All forms and applications for services, licenses, government benefits, etc of
9 all agencies, autonomous agencies, public corporations and instrumentalities of the
10 government of Guam. In the event that nature of a form or application prevents it from
11 being posted (such as carbon copy forms), the agency shall state on its website that
12 reasons that such form cannot be posted. To the extent possible and practical, the
13 agencies shall make the forms available in fill-able/savable/printable Adobe portable
14 document format (PDF).

15 Nothing in this Section shall be construed as limiting the information that a
16 department, agency, autonomous agency or public corporation may provide to the
17 general public via a homepage or website.
