

**AN ACT TO *ADD* A NEW §4120 TO CHAPTER 4 OF
TITLE 5, GUAM CODE ANNOTATED, RELATIVE TO
REQUIRING GOVERNMENT AGENCIES TO POST
THEIR BUDGETS ON THEIR WEBSITES.**

1 **BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF GUAM:**

2 **Section 1. Legislative Findings and Intent.** *I Liheslaturan Guåhan* finds
3 that the posting of bills and resolutions on the website of *I Liheslaturan Guåhan*
4 provides much transparency on measures that Senators propose as new law.
5 Individuals who seek information on bills, or attend or watch the televised hearings
6 on legislation have easy access to these documents via the internet.

1 *I Liheslatura* further finds that although the government of Guam’s budget is
2 the single most important job of *I Liheslatura*, the individual budgets submitted to
3 *I Liheslatura* by the respective departments, agencies, boards, commissions and
4 programs are *not* customarily posted on the internet. Therefore, residents attending
5 or watching hearings on television are unable to follow the discussion on the
6 respective budgets’ details. *I Liheslatura* further finds that since paper copies of
7 budgets submitted to *I Liheslatura* originated from digitized word processing,
8 spreadsheet or PDF files that posting such information on an agency’s website will
9 require very little additional work.

10 It is the intent of *I Liheslatura* to require all agencies that submit budgets to *I*
11 *Liheslatura* for its approval and appropriation be posted on their respective
12 websites.

13 **Section 2.** A new §4120 is *added* to Chapter 4 of Title 5, Guam Code
14 Annotated, to read as follows:

15 **“§ 4120. Budgets To Be Posted On Agency’s Websites.** Any
16 branch, agency, instrumentality, public corporation, board or commission that
17 submits a budget request to *I Liheslaturan Guåhan* shall post its budget
18 request on its website within five (5) days following the submission to *I*
19 *Liheslatura*. The agency shall, to the extent possible and practical:

20 (a) post the budget in a format that is readily accessible such as
21 Portable Document Format (PDF);

22 (b) for voluminous budgets, post the document in multiple smaller-
23 sized files instead of a single large file;

24 (c) format the document(s) in a searchable format; and

25 (d) nothing herein shall be construed to prohibit an agency from
26 posting the budget’s financial information in spreadsheet format.”



Bill No. 445-30 (LS) – “An act to add a new §4120 to Chapter 4 of 5GCA relative to requiring government agencies to post their budgets on their websites.” – Senator Telo Taitague

I. OVERVIEW

The Committee on Labor, the Public Structure, Public Libraries, and Technology convened the public hearing on October 22, 2010 at 9:12 a.m. in *I Liheslatura's* Public Hearing Room. Among the items on the agenda was the consideration of Bill No. 445-30 (LS) – “An act to add a new §4120 to Chapter 4 of 5GCA relative to requiring government agencies to post their budgets on their websites” sponsored by Senator Telo Taitague.

Public Hearing Requirements

Notices of the hearing were disseminated via facsimile and email to all senators and all main media broadcasting outlets on October 15, 2010 (5-day Notice) and on October 19, 2010 (48-Hour notice) pursuant to meeting the requirements of the Open Government Law. Notice of the hearing was also posted on the Guam Legislature's website.

II. SUMMARY OF TESTIMONIES

Chairman Adolpho B. Palacios, Sr. called the Committee on Labor, the Public Structure, Libraries, and Technology to order at 9:12 a.m., welcomed and introduced

Senators present. He briefly summarized the bill and gave Senator Telo T. Taitague the opportunity to elaborate on the bill.

Senator Taitague thanked Chairman Palacios and stated that the bill would require agencies to post their budgets online. She said that the bill is about transparency and that the Guam Legislature posts bills online to allow the public to access them. She said it makes it easier for members of the community to follow budget discussions when they have access to what the agencies have submitted. She asked that her colleagues support Bill 445, which reflects an open government philosophy.

Chairman Palacios offered the audience and other senators present a chance to comment on the bill. He stated that the bill is a step toward increasing transparency in the budget process.

Chairman Palacios concluded the hearing of Bill 445 and stated that Bill 445-30(LS) is duly heard.

Chairman Palacios concluded the hearing and requested that written testimony be submitted within the next ten (10) days. He adjourned the hearing at 12:03 pm.

1 **BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF GUAM:**

3 **Section 1. Legislative Findings and Intent.** *I Liheslaturan Guåhan* finds that the
4 posting of bills and resolutions on the website of *I Liheslaturan Guåhan* provides
5 much transparency on measures that senators propose as new law. Individuals who
6 seek information on bills or attend or watch televised the hearings on legislation have
7 easy access to these documents via the internet.

8

9 *I Liheslatura* further finds that although the Government of Guam's budget is the
10 single most important job of the legislature, the individual budgets submitted to the
11 legislature by the respective departments, agencies, boards, commissions and programs
12 are not customarily posted on the internet. Therefore, residents attending or watching
13 hearings on television are unable to follow the discussion on the respective budgets'
14 details. *I Liheslatura* further finds that since paper copies of budgets submitted to the
15 legislature originated from digitized word processing, spreadsheet or PDF files that

1 posting such information on an agency’s website will require very little additional
2 work.

3
4 It is the intent of *I Liheslatura* to require all agencies that submit budgets to *I*
5 *Liheslatura* for its approval and appropriation be posted on their respective websites.

6
7 **Section 2.** A new Section 4120 is *added* to Chapter 4 of 5GCA to read as follows:

8
9 **§4120. Budgets To Be Posted On Agencies’ Websites.** Any branch, agency,
10 instrumentality, public corporation, board or commission that submits a budget request
11 to *I Liheslaturan Guåhan* shall post its budget request on its website within five (5)
12 days following the submission to *I Liheslatura*. The agency shall, to the extent
13 possible and practical:

- 15 (a) Post the budget in a format that is readily accessible such Portable Document
16 Format (PDF),
 - 17 (b) For voluminous budgets, post the document in multiple smaller-sized files
18 instead of a single large file.
 - 19 (c) Format the document(s) in a searchable format, and
 - 20 (d) Nothing herein shall be construed to prohibit an agency from posting the
21 budget’s financial information in on spreadsheet format.
