



1           **BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF GUAM:**

2           **Section 1. Legislative Findings and Intent.** *I Liheslaturan Guåhan* finds  
3 that in 2008 *I Mina'Bente Nuebi Na Liheslaturan Guåhan* took action to honor the  
4 memory and legacy of the late David Joseph Torres Limtiaco, who had served as  
5 Chief of Forestry within the Forestry and Soil Resources Division of the Guam  
6 Department of Agriculture.

7           *I Liheslaturan Guåhan* further finds that, unfortunately, †Mr. Limtiaco's date  
8 of death was incorrectly indicated and that his middle names were not abbreviated.

1           Therefore, it is the intent of *I Liheslaturan Guåhan* to correct his date of  
2 death, as it is indicated in Public Law 29-84, and to amend the current law to  
3 reflect an abbreviation of †Mr. Limtiaco’s middle names.

4           **Section 2.** Public Law 29-84, Section 1 is hereby *amended* to read:

5           “**Section 1.** In recognition of the significant contributions to the  
6 conservation, protection and enhancement of Guam’s vegetative environment  
7 and to the sustainability of its natural resources, specifically soil, water and  
8 air quality, it is the intent of *I Liheslaturan Guåhan* to name the new plant  
9 nursery building at the Guam Department of Agriculture the “David J. T.  
10 Limtiaco Plant Nursery Building” after Mr. David Joseph Torres Limtiaco  
11 who passed away on February 12, 2008, and who had served as Chief of  
12 Forestry within the Forestry and Soil Resources Division of the Guam  
13 Department of Agriculture.”

14           **Section 3.** Article 1 of Chapter 8 of Title 1 of the Guam Code Annotated  
15 §849.1 is hereby *amended* to read:

16           “**§849.1. David J. T. Limtiaco Plant Nursery Building.** The new  
17 plant nursery building at the Guam Department of Agriculture is named the  
18 “David J. T. Limtiaco Plant Nursery Building” in honor of David Joseph  
19 Torres Limtiaco, who served as the Chief of Forestry at the Forestry and Soil  
20 Resources Division of the Guam Department of Agriculture.”

**I. OVERVIEW**

The Public Hearing on Bill No. 88 (LS) was conducted by the Committee on Rules, Natural Resources, and Federal, Foreign & Micronesian Affairs on Thursday, April 16, 2009 at 1:00 PM.

**Public Notice Requirements**

Notices were disseminated via fax and/or e-mail to all senators and all main media broadcasting outlets on Thursday, April 9, 2009 (5-Day Notice), and again on Tuesday, April 14, 2009 (2-Day notice).

The Public Hearing was “Called-to-Order” at 3:00 P.M.

**II. SUMMARY OF TESTIMONY & DISCUSSION**

Senator Respicio announces title of Bill No. 88 (LS) and the sole testifier, Mr. Joseph Torres, Deputy Director of the Department of Agriculture. Senator Respicio then yields to the bill’s author, Speaker Won Pat.

**Speaker Won Pat:** Thank you, Mr. Chairman; and thank you, Mr. Torres, for coming this afternoon. This is actually to just make a correction. The family's been concerned that in our code, it's listed as February 8<sup>th</sup>, when his actual birth date on the 12<sup>th</sup>. We're making the correction here, but then also, my concern, I guess, will be addressed to the department – in the opening ceremony with the new building, is the correct date then reflected on the plaque?

**Mr. Joseph Torres:** First of all, thank you, Mr. Chairman and members of the Committee. I've been looking for this bill. I noticed when I did testify on the original Bill 299, I stressed the need for identifying David's true name. Although I am very privileged that we both share "Joseph Torres," I insisted that it be used "J.T." because my argument there was there's too many "David T. Limtiacos" out there and you may lose the identity down the generations.

Two, I did point out that the date of birth was wrong at that time also. But I'm glad to see this bill and I do support this bill. In addition to the Bill 88, Senator, can I make a recommendation also that you include subsection 849.1, because in the original law, it added a new section, and it says "David Joseph Torres Limtiaco," so that would correct that.

As far as the agriculture, to be honest with you, I have not looked at the plaque 'cos I've been off-island when it was dedicated; and I suspect that you are correct; but I will report back to you whether it does reflect February 8<sup>th</sup> or the 12<sup>th</sup>.

**Senator Respicio:** Would you be able to just make a phone call?

**Mr. Torres:** I can do that right now as we speak, if you don't mind.

**Senator Respicio calls for short recess; and a few minutes later he re-convenes.**

**Senator Respicio:** Before we took a brief recess, Speaker Won Pat asked you (Mr. Torres) to answer the question, "What does the dedication plaque say?"

**Speaker Won Pat:** Yes; and can you give us the section again, that you just mentioned?

**Mr. Torres:** 849.1 – Subsection. It's under Section 2 of the original law. Again, there it says, "David Joseph Torres" and I love the guy, but "David J.T. Limtiaco Plant Nursery Building" would be fine and was the suggested language then, and it still remains the same.

**Senator Respicio:** and that's also coming from the family?

**Mr. Torres:** I convinced the family then, because we may lose the “David Limtiaco” down the road, and they agreed then. I don’t think they’ve changed their minds since then; their main concern is that the name has not gone up on the building. To be frankly honest with you, Speaker, I was hoping to see Bill 88, or a form of Bill 88, to correct that because I didn’t want to put the sign up until that “J.T.” was there – that name’s too long.

**Senator Respicio:** If you don’t mind, because this is a very sensitive issue; I know the author, Speaker Won Pat, wants to preserve Mr. Limtiaco’s legacy and I know she’s working closely with the family to make sure that the legacy and his memory is properly honored. I’ll ask the Speaker if she could just confirm with the family if that’s the name they would prefer –

**Mr. Torres:** Ok. That’s good –

**Senator Respicio:** – because I don’t like the idea of “convincing” the family to do something. This should be their wishes and I’m sure the author wants to honor their family’s wishes.

**Mr. Torres:** ‘Cos we don’t really wanna lose the real, genuine “David Limtiaco” by just saying “David T. Limtiaco” and that’s how I explained it to them then and they agreed then. Also, you can advise the family that the sign will be on the road-side of the building, not on the front-side of the building; ‘cos the front side is facing parallel, it’s not facing the road.

**Senator Respicio:** Ok. Speaker Won Pat? Anything else?

**Speaker Won Pat:** No, that’s it. Thank you very much, Mr. Torres.

There being no further discussion, the hearing on Bill No. 88 (LS) was adjourned at 3:12 P.M.

### **III. FINDINGS & RECOMMENDATIONS**

After consideration of the input provided by both the Department of Agriculture and the family of the late David T. Limtiaco, this Committee has amended the introduced version of Bill No. 88 (LS), not only to correct Mr. Limtiaco’s date of death, but to shorten his full name by abbreviating his middle initials.






