



**AN ACT TO *ADD* A NEW §57105 TO CHAPTER 57 OF TITLE 10, GUAM CODE ANNOTATED, RELATIVE TO PROVIDING THE MEANS TO COVER THE COST OF ISSUING GUAM IDENTIFICATION CERTIFICATES.**

1       **BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF GUAM:**

2       **Section 1.** A new §57105 is *added* to Chapter 57 of Title 10, Guam Code  
3 Annotated, to read as follows:

4               **“§57105. Guam Identification Card Fees.** Beginning October 1,  
5 2009, a portion of the fees collected from each applicant for the issuance of  
6 a new, or renewal of, a *Guam Identification Card* under the provisions of

1           this Chapter *shall* be deposited in the Better Public Service Fund of the  
2           Department of Revenue and Taxation in an amount equal to the higher of  
3           one-third (1/3) of the amount of the fees collected from all applicants, *or*  
4           Ten Dollars (\$10.00) per applicant. The balance of the fees *shall* be  
5           deposited in the Police Services Fund.”

**PUBLIC HEARING**

**BILL NO. 210-30(LS) AN ACT TO ADD A NEW §57105 TO CHAPTER 57 OF 10 GCA RELATIVE TO PROVIDING THE MEANS TO COVER THE COST OF ISSUING GUAM IDENTIFICATION CERTIFICATES.**

**I. OVERVIEW**

The Committee on Public Safety, Law Enforcement, & Senior Citizens convened the public hearing on September 15, 2009. Hearing began at 10:17am on Bill No. 210-30 (LS). Notices of the hearing were disseminated to all local media outlets via facsimile on September 2 and on September 10, 2009, pursuant to meeting the requirements of the Open Government Law. Notice of the hearing was also posted on the Guam Legislature's website.

## II. SUMMARY OF TESTIMONIES

**Chairman Adolpho B. Palacios, Sr. called the Committee on Public Safety, Law Enforcement, and Senior Citizens to order at 10:17am,** welcomed and introduced Senators present.

Chairman Palacios recognized the author of the bill, Senator Telo Taitague, who gave a brief presentation of the bill. The bill transfers fees to the Department of Rev & Tax which is the current practice. About one year ago, the Police Department transferred the issuing to the Department of Revenue and Taxation. There has not been anyone from GPD to issue out the Guam ID Cards since the transfer as promised to the Department of Rev. & Tax from GPD. The Department of Revenue & Taxation is trying to retain employees as well as funding in order to administer these certificates and ID Cards. Currently, the money of the Guam ID Card is deposited into the Police Services Fund.

**Chairman Palacios** called those who are present to testify.

**Mr. Frank R. Blaz, Department of Revenue & Taxation, Written Testimony, Not In Favor** Mr. Blaz stated that he is the acting administrator for the Motor Vehicle Division. We saw the issuance of the Driver's Licenses to ensure identity. Rev & Tax wants accountability in the issuance of ID Cards. At the time, we got verbal agreements from GPD, but there were no personnel, equipment and supplies transferred to Rev & Tax. When none of this happened, Rev and Tax had to move forward. There was only one person there for 1-2 weeks from GPD, but non substantial. We are dealing with problems with equipment and are currently having problems in issuing the Guam ID Card. We want to make this a full time position, but they had to cut back services because of the lack of support for the issuance of the Guam ID Card. We anticipate this demand with the anticipated military build-up. We saw the numbers double in the summer and we are inundated with additional services. We will be submitting a written testimony at a later date. I support the bill, but the Department of Revenue and Taxation is in need of more funding.

**Dr. Ron McNinch, UOG Professor, Oral Testimony, In Favor**

I want to make a supplemental testimony. We have researched that the timeline of the deadlines for these ID's is costly because it is renewed almost every year. We would

like to make the recommendation to extend the renewal to 4-5 years to alleviate the lines for this and to reduce the costs.

**Cpt. Fred Bordallo, GPD Division Chief of the Support Division, Oral Testimony, In Favor** I have been informed that the acting bureau chief, Mark Charfarous is on his way down here. He supports any funding to help Rev & Tax that is empowered to issue the Guam ID Card which GPD gave over to Rev & Tax.

**Chairman Palacios** stated that the Guam ID is a valid document as proof of U.S. Citizenship. Is it only issued to US Citizens? Who then is given the Guam ID Card?

**Mr. Frank Blaz**

There is a requirement within the statute that states that any non-resident can apply for the Guam ID Card and not limited to U.S. Citizens. We also issue this to residents from other territories. We secure foreign passports. The goal is to determine who they are. The ID will not reflect their citizenship, but the internal records will show it.

**Chairman Palacios** allowed Senators to give comments and/or questions.

**Senator Pangelinan**

What has been the number of cards issued? Is there an age limit for the Guam ID Card? What is the current cost to produce an ID? Are these cards like a drivers license? What is the staff time to produce an ID? Will you integrate the two cards and would the Director's Signature be on both cards?

**Mr. Frank Blaz**

We have seen about 300-350 monthly cards produced which includes everyone. Last summer, we saw 4,500 in July. We have adopted the standing procedures from GPD and we can issue it to minors. The biggest change is major security features in the ID and the Driver's License as mandated within Federal Law. If anyone has an ID license issued prior to last year, there are major changes. Film for 200-300 printings cost about \$75.00, while \$180.00 goes towards lamination. Mr. Blaz stated that he did not know how much cards cost and stated that the Guam ID is the same as the Driver's license, with the exception of driving privileges. What is different is the formatting of it. We deal with 10 minutes in producing one ID Card, but the full process is about 20 minutes. This is subject to change and we have secured Federal Funds to renovate the front area in order to alleviate the lines as well as to expedite such applications. Each station will

have full service with a camera. The two cards will be integrated into one station instead of separating them. You will see the changes in the coming months because of the secured Federal funding. The Director's signature is on both cards.

**Cpt. Mark C. Charfarous, Division Chief for Records of GPD, Written Testimony, Not In favor.**

Since 1954, the issuance of the Guam ID Card has always been with the Guam Police Department and he fears that funding will be reduced from the Police Services Fund. If this bill shall pass, the Guam Police Services Fund will be reduced which is a critical operational need of GPD. The initial issuance of the Guam Identification Certificates or more commonly known as the Guam Identification Card has been with the Guam Police Department as stipulated in §8600. Title 9, Chapter 7 Guam Code Annotated. In it, the Department of Public Safety was designated by the Second Guam Legislature as the issuing authority for the Certification of Identification and not the Department of Revenue and Taxation. The two agencies did agree to help the community by allowing individuals to conduct a "one stop" process of obtaining a Guam Driver's License and Guam I.D. at the Division of Motor Vehicle, Department of Revenue and Taxation. If the previous arrangement with Revenue and Tax is not realistic and appropriate, then GPD would gladly take back the responsibility for issuing the Guam ID.

**Chairman Palacios**

He has the referenced statute such as Public law 8600. It appears to me that 57100 also authorize the Department of Revenue and Taxation to also issue some kind of ID. How then was it that in November 2008, GPD with the advice of I don't know who, found section 57100 and said that the Dept of Rev & Taxation must issue the ID Card? How did that happen and who was the source/authority for this transfer?

**Cpt. Mark Charfarous**

I ask Lorraine Alcantra, Records Clerk for GPD, to give us the history of what had transpired.

**Ms. Lorrain Alcantra, Records Clerk for GPD, Oral Testimony, Not in Favor**

She stated that this started back in 2007 when Ms. Karen who started the discussion with Rev & Tax. She was on her way outside and she stated "they still want to take the Guam ID and they better read up on the law because the law does not state that Rev & Tax. will issue the Guam ID. Cpt. Chargualaf and Major Fisher who authorized the transfer.

**Chairman Palacios**

Did GPD issue the transfer? How did this transpire and where was legal council? When was this transaction finally decided and where was Paul Suba?

**Ms. Lorraine Alcantra**

Major Chargualaf was the person who decided. I don't know who was the authority who gave this mandate in November 2008. There was no memo of understanding and no paperwork involved with the transaction. It seems that it was a verbal agreement.

**Senator Taitague**

Was there any Memo of Understanding? How did it transfer division heads?

**Mr. Frank Blaz**

I am only aware of the statute that Senator Palacios read. Everyone was in desperate straights in obtaining funding at the time in 2008. We want to also provide the service from both sides and I was hoping that we could do the transfer without major objections.

**Senator Pangelinan**

Was there a time that two different ID were being issued?

**Mr. Frank Blaz**

No. There has only been one since the transference.

**Cpt. Mark Charfarous**

In the coming months, we will have the capability of finger printing. We don't have a problem with the Department of Revenue & Taxation because they have been very helpful to GPD. However, we don't know if the Department of Revenue and Taxation system is AFFIS certified or capable. We do extensive checks on individuals and would recommend fingerprinting. What is so important is the reduction of funding and we may see a shortfall in our budget if the transfer goes through. If it is under GPD, it will be AFIS certified with finger print capability.

**Senator Taitague**

For a long time, the Department of Revenue & Taxation has shouldered the costs and they must be compensated for the work that they are doing. I appreciate your

comments and look forward to the time when this goes back to GPD, but until then, this bill would allow for the Department of Revenue and Taxation to collect their fees.

**Chairman Palacios**

It is clear that there is a statute for GPD and Rev& Tax to issue some kind of Identification card. It may not be the same, but what needs to be done is that there must be a mark up meeting between Rev & Tax and GPD to agree who collects the fees and has to be reconciled. We will have to work on a mark-up, perhaps next week and to resolve this.

**Senator Pangelinan**

There was a time when the ID was not being issued. Why weren't they issued? Your failure to issue the cards was to transition into buying new equipment. Were you informed of the Real ID Card law? Do you fingerprint everyone?

**Senator Taitague**

Do you have the capabilities to issue an ID Card and why didn't you check this out last year in November 2008?

**Ms. Lorraine Alcantra**

We were supposed to get the supplies for the ID card and there was an MIS who indicated that Rev & Tax might take over. In a week's time, we can go up to 100-150 per day. The average for the week is 400 to 500 ID Cards. GPD gets most of the fees from ID Cards. Two fingerprints are given, one to GPD and the Crime lab. We look for the date of birth and often times have difficulty in identifying people. We have a firearms ID card machine.

**Cpt. Mark Charfarous**

I can't speak for management of the Department. This discussion was in length between the two departments.

**Senator Taitague**

It is quite confusing at this point because you stated that there was a memo to transfer.

**Senator Ada**

I'm not sure what the Real ID Law states but does Rev & Tax have the capability at this point for the Real ID. What is not clear in my mind is who is capable at this point to

issue the Guam ID Card? Is there any particular disadvantage that GPD has at this point without having the funds transferred?

**Mr. Frank Blaz**

Rev & Tax has deadlines to verify records with other online databases. We have secured funding for this issue. When we took it over, we were concerned about some of the issue of identifying a person such as fingerprinting.

**Mr. Ben Camacho, Systems Person, Department of Revenue & Taxation, Oral Testimony, In Favor**

The entire system was done by hand at one time and in re-creating systems that work. There was a meeting between the Director and the Chief of Police. There are only 8 types of documents that one can submit. There are different phases in the issuance of the Guam ID Card. We haven't used the 2008 grant which creates a necessary computer system of the ID Card and we already did this when we updated our Driver's license system. When a person comes in and applies for an ID, we need to take his picture and we need to record their history. We will be redesigning the process flow. However, all documents must be scanned.

There are money for supplies and we must update the ID card. Lamination costs \$125 and can only be ordered through certain companies. They were mentioning about the law. It averages to about 70,000 per year.

**Chairman Palacios** stated, with regards to the implementation of the grant, is it exclusive of the Guam ID Card and the Driver's License?

**Chairman Palacios** concluded the hearing and requested that written testimony be submitted within the next ten (10) days. He adjourned the hearing at 11:15pm.

### III. WRITTEN TESTIMONIES

**1. Mr. Paul R. Suba, Chief of the Guam Police Department, Written Testimony, Not in Favor, received via hand-delivery on September 14, 2009.**

Chief Suba is concerned that the passage of Bill 210-30 (LS) would reduce funds to the Guam Police Department that has in the past and continues to provide critical operational needs of the Department. The initial issuance of the Guam Identification Certificates has been with the Department since 1954 as stipulated within §8600, Title 9, Chapter 7 Guam Code Annotated. Public law 9-228 enacted by the Ninth Guam

Legislature which created the Department of Revenue and Taxation does not reference any authority for the issuance of the Guam Identification Certificate. Other than §57100 of 10 GCA, there appears to be no other provisions in either the Government Code of Guam or the Guam Code Annotated that provides such authority to the Department of Revenue and Taxation let alone any provision transferring the issuance of the Guam Identification Certificate from the Guam Police Department to any other government entity. Public law 29-02 states that notwithstanding any other law, the Guam Police Department is authorized to collect a fee associated with the issuance of the Guam Identification Certificate along with other services that our Department administers. *(Please see written testimony attached.)*

**2. Mr. Paul J. Pablo, Acting Director, Department of Revenue & Taxation, Written Testimony, In Favor, received on September 15, 2009 via hand-delivery**

Mr. Pablo states that DRT has taken over the issuance of the Guam I.D. Certificates from the Guam Police Department since November 2008 without receiving any additional funding for computer/camera equipment and supplies, personnel or costs associated with the electronic maintenance of the Guam I.D. Certificates database. Because of the tedious and stringent requirements in issuing I.D.'s to conform with the Real I.D. Act, DRT is instead requesting that one hundred percent (100%) of all fees associated with the issuances be given back to DRT to ensure that a funding source is made available for DRT's use for the costs associated with such issuances and the increasing demands for services of this nature in anticipation of the military build-up. *(Please see written testimony attached.)*

#### **IV. FINDINGS AND RECOMMENDATIONS**

The Committee on Public Safety, Law Enforcement, & Senior Citizens finds that Bill No. 210-30 (LS) sets a portion of fees collected when applying for a Guam ID card to the appropriate agency issuing the Guam ID card. The amount of appropriation is equal to the higher of one third (1/3) of the amount of the fee collected or ten dollars (\$10) per applicant. Currently the Department of Revenue and Taxation issues the Guam ID Card while the fees collected are deposited into the Police Service Revolving funds account. Ultimately, two agencies will be affected by this law and fees collected will have to be placed under a separate fund which may or may not affect the agencies' respective budget.

Accordingly, the Committee on Public Safety, Law Enforcement, & Senior Citizens to which **Bill No. 210-30 (LS)** was referred, does hereby submit its findings and recommendations to *I Mina'Trenta na Liheslaturan Guåhan* **TO PASS Bill No. 210-30(LS)** **"An act to add a new §57105 to Chapter 57 of 10 GCA relative to providing the means to cover the cost of issuing Guam Identification Certificates."**

Dear Senator Palacios:

*Buenas yan Hafa Adai*, Mr. Chairman and Members of the Committee on Public Safety, Law Enforcement and Senior Citizens.

I am Paul R. Suba, Chief of Police of the Guam Police Department and I am providing testimony on Bill 210-30(LS) "An Act to Add a New § 57105 to Chapter 57 of 10 GCA Relative to Providing the Means to Cover the Cost of Issuing Guam Identification Certificates."

I am concerned that the passage of Bill 210-30 (LS) would reduce funds to the Guam Police Department that has in the past and continues to provide critical operational needs of our Department. The initial issuance of Guam Identification Certificates or more commonly known as the Guam Identification Card has been with the Guam Police Department since 1954 as stipulated within § 8600, Title 9, Chapter 7, Government Code of Guam.

Despite the fact that § 57100 of Chapter 57 10 GCA states that "Any person may obtain a certificate of identification from the Department of Revenue and Taxation," the source, referenced within this very section, is identified as Government Code § 8600. However, upon reviewing § 8600 of the Government

Code, it is the Department of Public Safety that was designated by the Second Guam Legislature as the issuing authority for the Certification of Identification and not the Department of Revenue and Taxation. However, the two agencies did agree to help the community by allowing individuals to conduct a "one-stop" process of obtaining a Guam driver's license and Guam I.D. at the Division of Motor Vehicle (DMV), Department of Revenue and Taxation. GPD would continue to receive the funds to support our mission. If the previous arrangement with Revenue and Tax is not realistic and appropriate, then GPD should take back the responsibility for issuing the Guam ID.

Public Law 9-228 enacted by the Ninth Guam Legislature which created the Department of Revenue and Taxation does not reference any authority for the issuance of the Guam Identification Certificate. Other than § 57100 of 10 GCA, there appears to be no other provisions in either the Government Code of Guam or the Guam Code Annotated that provides such authority to the Department of Revenue and Taxation let alone any provision transferring the issuance of the Guam Identification Certificate from the Guam Police Department to any other government entity.

The Guam Police Department, however, has been empowered through various legislative actions authorizing and endorsing our Department's responsibility to issue the Guam Identification Certificates. Public Law 29-02 states that ***notwithstanding any other law*** the Guam Police Department is authorized to collect a fee associated with the issuance of the Guam Identification Certificate along with other services that our Department administers.

The passage of Bill 210-30 (LS) would reduce the operational funding for the Guam Police Department which will in turn seriously affect our Department's public safety mission. I humbly request that this proposed Bill as written be reconsidered by the Guam Legislature. *Si Yu'os Ma'åse.*



Thank you for your introduction of the abovementioned legislation to allow the Department of Revenue & Taxation (DRT) to keep a portion of the fees generated for the issuances of the Guam Identification Certificates.

As you may know, DRT has taken over the issuance of the Guam I.D. Certificates from the Guam Police Department since November 2008 without receiving any additional funding for computer/camera equipment and supplies, personnel or costs associated with the electronic maintenance of the Guam I.D. Certificates data base. Also note that because of the Federal mandates under the Real I.D. Act, DRT has already implemented most of the requirements to conform with the Act when issuing Driver's Licenses and will mirror such requirements with the Guam I.D. certificates. Because of the tedious and stringent requirements in issuing I.D.s to conform with the Act, DRT is instead requesting that one hundred percent (100%) of all fees associated with the issuances be given back to DRT to insure that a funding source is made available for DRT's use for the costs associated with such issuances and the increasing demands for services of this nature in anticipation of the military build-up.

Currently, all local law enforcement agencies use information from DRT, especially Motor Vehicle and Driver's License information without any costs to the respective agencies or the local courts. DRT can no longer absorb new tasks with limited funding as the entire Government of Guam seems to always be financially challenged.

**AN ACT TO ADD A NEW §57105 TO CHAPTER 57 OF 10GCA

1        **BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF GUAM:**

2        **Section 1.** A new Section 57105 is *added* to Chapter 57 of 10GCA to read

5        **“§57105. Continuing Appropriation.**

6            Beginning October 1, 2009, a portion of the fees authorized by §57101 of  
7 this Chapter collected from each applicant for the issuance of a new or renewal of  
8 a Guam Identification Card under the provisions of this Chapter is automatically  
9 appropriated to the agency issuing the Guam Identification Card. The amount of  
10 the appropriation is equal to the higher of one-third (1/3) of the amount of the fee
