



1 **BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF GUAM:**

2 **Section 1. Legislative Findings and Intent.** *I Liheslaturan Guåhan* finds
3 it challenging in these economically trying times for farmers to continue their
4 desired livelihood within the global market. According to the United States
5 Department of Agriculture 2007 Census of Agriculture, Guam had a decrease of
6 forty-nine (49) farm operators from the previous census in 2002. Without the

1 proper tools to assist our local farmers within this competitive market, we risk a
2 vital opportunity to increase our island’s agricultural independence.

3 *I Liheslaturan Guåhan* intends to increase the flexibility of farmers to
4 market and sale their products.

5 **Section 2.** §75108.1 (a) of Chapter 75, Title 21, Guam Code Annotated, is
6 hereby *amended* to read:

7 “(a) In accordance with the laws of Guam, and subject to rules and
8 regulations promulgated by the *Chamorro* Land Trust Commission,
9 residential and agricultural leaseholders are authorized to conduct small-
10 scale cottage industry activities, in which goods and services are produced
11 primarily within their leased residential and agricultural lots and in which
12 the total net income earned on those lots *does not exceed* Fifty Thousand
13 Dollars (\$50,000) per annum. The following cottage industry activities are
14 authorized:

- 15 (1) Farm Produce & Light Agriculture.
- 16 (2) Baking & Producing Foodstuff.
- 17 (3) Arts & Crafts.
- 18 (4) Cultural Practitioning.
- 19 (5) Alternative Medicine (*Suruhanu/Suruhana*).
- 20 (6) Dress Making.
- 21 (7) Growing & Selling Plants and Flowers.
- 22 (8) Repair of Personal Effects.”

23 **Section 3. Severability.** *If* any of the provisions of this Act or the
24 application thereof to any person or circumstance is held invalid, such invalidity
25 shall *not* affect any other provision or application of this Act which can be given
26 effect without the invalid provision or application, and to this end the provisions of
27 this Act are severable.

Committee Chairman vicente c. pangelinan began public hearing on the matter of Bill No 30-246. Chairman Pangelinan stated the title of Bill No. 30-246 and its intent.

II. COMMITTEE PRECEEDINGS

Chairman Pangelinan: This is a bill, which is fairly simple. In the development of the rules and regulations and authorizations of the use of properties under the Chamorro Land Trust program, the allowed uses under a residential lease included the Cottage Industry Activities under residential lease, but did not allow any of the Cottage Industry Activities under agricultural lease. A farmer who is planting his crop could not sell those crops on the property that is under an agricultural lease. There is no kind of retail or commercial activity permitted under an agricultural lease.

This bill would allow..

Senator Tom Ada: Which bill?

Chairman Pangelinan: 246. So, the activities of the Cottage Industry was not allowed on agricultural leases and this bill would allow for those cottage industries to be permitted under an agricultural lease by the Chamorro Land Trust.

There are no sign up for this public testimony. For the record I want to state the committee sent letters to Governor, Lt Governor, the Attorney General, the Chamorro Land Trust and other departments and agencies that may have any interest in this bill, requesting and informing them of the committees meeting this morning and the committees acceptance of public testimony on this matter.

At this time, I would like to ask Senator Barnes my cosponsor on this bill to comment as well.

Senator Tina Muna Barnes: thank you Mr. Chair. Mr. Chair, I just want to thank you for giving me the opportunity for being a co-sponsor of this bill and to the listening audience out there just want to give a delineation of activities would be authorized and it is listed from one through eight, farm produce and light agriculture, banking and producing foodstuff, arts and craft, cultural partitioning, alternative medicine, dress making, growing and selling plants and flowers and repair of personal effects.

Mr. Chair, I know you say this is a simple bill as noted for the record, but Guam has had a decrease within its farm operators of the previous census in 2002. I just would like to share with you that the legislation that you have authored opens that avenue for small businesses and entrepreneurs being a part of wanting to work with this industry giving them the vehicle and the mechanism to facilitate forward.

I just would like to thank you for this opportunity, for giving me the opportunity to be a part of this legislation thank you.

Chairman Pangelinan: thank you very much Senator Barnes. Any other members of the panel any have comment on the bill. If not for the requirements of law, Bill No. 30-246 has received its public hearing.



Hong Kong apartment sells for a whopping \$57 million

HONG KONG (AP) — It's a price tag that would make even New Yorkers and Londoners gasp — an outsized luxury apartment sold for nearly \$57 million in Hong Kong yesterday amid growing fears of a real estate bubble.

The five-bedroom duplex suite with as much as 6,158 square feet was sold to an unidentified buyer from mainland China, said the developer, Henderson Land Development, a major Hong Kong property company.

It is believed to be Asia's most expensive property by square foot at nearly \$9,200.

Aside from an aroma spa center, fitness room, outdoor yoga gym and grand harbor views, the new homeowner will enjoy an exclusive address in the hills of Hong Kong's main island — "a majestic realm for the city who's who," according to a statement from the developer.

The deal comes at a time when ever-higher prices of Hong Kong real estate, benefiting from mainland China's booming market and easy

money sloshing through the world financial system, are inspiring worries of a bubble in the making.

Several blockbuster deals in the tens of millions of dollars have made headlines of late.

Hong Kong's leader, Donald Tsang, said Wednesday in his annual policy address that the government may free up more land for development to help add supply and bring down prices.

"The relatively small number of residential units completed and the record prices attained in certain transactions this year have caused concern about the supply of flats, difficulty in purchasing a home, and the possibility of a property bubble," Tsang told lawmakers.

The city has long had one of the world's most expensive property markets, with prices that many local residents are hard pressed to afford.

About 47 percent of Hong Kong lives in publicly subsidized housing, according to government data.

where the high-end apartment was purchased, another unit was snapped up for a mere \$51 million. The building "offers a chance to allow the elites in town to enjoy such prestigious property," said Thomas Lam, Henderson's sales general manager.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF GUAM:

1 **Section 1. Legislative Findings and Intent.** *I Liheslaturan Guåhan* finds it
2 challenging in these economically trying times for farmers to continue their desired
3 livelihood within the global market. According to United States Department of
4 Agriculture 2007 Census of Agriculture, Guam had a decrease of forty-nine (49) farm
5 operators from the previous census in 2002. Without the proper tools to assist our local
6 farmers within this competitive market we risk a vital opportunity to increase our islands
7 agricultural independence.

8 *I Liheslaturan Guåhan* intends to increase the flexibility of farmers to market and
9 sale their products.

10 **Section 2. §75108.1 (a) of Chapter 75, Title 21 Guam Code Annotated is**
11 **hereby amended to read:**

12 “(a) In accordance with the laws of Guam, and subject to rules and regulations
13 promulgated by the *Chamorro* Land Trust Commission, residential and agriculture
14 leaseholders are authorized to conduct small-scale cottage industry activities, in which
15 goods and services are produced primarily within their leased residential and agriculture

1 lots and in which the total net income earned on those lots *does not exceed* Fifty
2 Thousand Dollars (\$50,000.00) per annum. The following cottage industry activities are
3 authorized:

- 4 1) Farm Produce & Light Agriculture.
- 5 2) Baking & Producing Foodstuff.
- 6 3) Arts & Crafts.
- 7 4) Cultural Practitioning.
- 8 5) Alternative Medicine (*Suruhanu/Suruhana*).
- 9 6) Dress Making.
- 10 7) Growing & Selling Plants and Flowers.
- 11 8) Repair of Personal Effects.

12 **Section 4. Severability.** If any of the provisions of this Act or the application
13 thereof to any person or circumstance is held invalid, such invalidity shall not affect any
14 other provision or application of this Act which can be given effect without the invalid
15 provision or application, and to this end the provisions of this Act are severable.
