



**AN ACT TO AMEND §5007 OF ARTICLE 1 OF

1 **BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF GUAM:**

2 **Section 1. Legislative Findings and Intent.** *I Liheslaturan Guåhan* finds
3 that due to procurement code restrictions on the making of advance payments, the
4 overseas promotion activities of the Guam Visitors Bureau (GVB) is hampered by
5 the Bureau's inability to procure preferred floor space at tourism conventions and
6 expositions which require deposit payments. Further, GVB cannot realize the
7 savings potential of early payment discounts afforded those with the ability to pay

1 in advance. It is the intent of *I Liheslatura* that GVB be exempted from the
2 procurement code prohibition against advance payments in its overseas marketing
3 activities.

4 **Section 2.** §5007 of Article 1 of Chapter 5, Title 5, Guam Code
5 Annotated, is hereby *amended* to read:

6 **“§5007. Policy Against Advance Payments.**

7 With the exception of off-island orders of the Department of
8 Education and off-island purchases of goods and services of the Guam
9 Visitors Bureau directly related to its overseas promotions, *no* procurement
10 *shall* be made under this Chapter which *shall* require advance payment.
11 The Board of Directors of the Guam Visitors Bureau *shall*, pursuant to the
12 Administrative Adjudication Act, formulate rules and regulations for the
13 exercise of advanced payment authority.”

14 **Section 3. Effective Date.** This Act *shall* take effect upon adjudication of
15 the rules and regulations required under Section 2 of this Act.

COMMITTEE REPORT DIGEST

I. OVERVIEW

The Committee on Tourism, Cultural Affairs, Youth, and Public Broadcasting convened a public hearing on Wednesday December 23, 2009 at 2:00 p.m. in *I Liheslatura's* Public Hearing Room. The item on the agenda was the consideration of Bill No. 264 (COR) – “An act to amend §5007 of Chapter 5 of Title 5 of the Guam Code Annotated, relative to the procurement activities of the Guam Visitors Bureau,” sponsored by B.J.F. Cruz. Senator Tina Rose Muña Barnes presided over the public hearing as acting chair in Chairman B.J.F. Cruz’s absence.

Public Notice Requirements

All legal requirements for public notices were met. Notices were published in the Pacific Daily News on December 14, 2009 and December 21, 2009. Notices were disseminated via e-mail, facsimile and hand delivery to all senators and all local media outlets on December 11, 2009, and again on December 17, 2009, with requests for publication in the Marianas Variety and the Pacific Daily News. Notice of the hearing also was posted on the Guam Legislature’s website.

Senators Present

Acting Chairperson Tina Rose Muña Barnes

The public hearing was called to order at 2:00 PM.

II. SUMMARY OF TESTIMONY AND DISCUSSION

Acting Chairperson Tina Rose Muña Barnes read the title of Bill No. 264 (COR), “An act to amend §5007 of Chapter 5 of Title 5 of the Guam Code Annotated, relative to the procurement activities of the Guam Visitors Bureau,” and called for testimony.

Gerry Perez, General Manager, Guam Visitors Bureau, submitted written testimony (attached) in **support** of Bill No. 264.

Pete Tajalle, Guam Visitors Bureau, testified in **support** of the bill. He reiterated the nature of the industry as often requiring advance deposits for services needed to promote Guam’s tourism.

Chairwoman Muña Barnes requested examples of GVB being impeded by current procurement restrictions.

Perez stated that certain necessary promotions purchases require advance deposits, such as the JATA World Travel Fair in Japan, the production of materials for presentations and events, and advertising space in unique publications, such as The Stars and Stripes on Guam.

Chairwoman Barnes asked whether the local companies honor the government Purchase Orders.

Perez replied that though many local companies do honor the purchase orders, the procurement process that requires three quotes often hinders them from promoting Guam in the best light when GVB hosts off-island groups and would like to present the best experience rather than the most economical.

Tajalle stated some companies in Guam will not honor a purchase order regardless of GVB's good record of payment.

III. FINDINGS AND RECOMMENDATIONS

The Committee on Tourism, Cultural Affairs, Youth, and Public Broadcasting finds that in its duties to promote the island to new and varied tourist audiences, the Guam Visitors Bureau must be afforded a modicum of flexibility in its in-advance procurement activities.

To secure prime trade fair exposition floor space, to realize cost savings through certain "early-bird" discounts, and to make the in-advance deposits required to place advertisements, this Committee finds that GVB, like the Guam Department of Education, should be exempted from the procurement code policy against advance payments for off-island purchases.

The Committee on Tourism, Cultural Affairs, Youth, and Public Broadcasting, to which was referred Bill No. 264(COR), hereby submits these findings to *I Mina' Trenta na Liheslaturan Guåhan* and reports out Bill No. 264-30 (COR) with the recommendation **TO DO PASS**.

Section 2. §5007 of Chapter 5, Title 5, Guam Code Annotated is hereby amended to read:

“§5007 Policy Against Advance Payments.

1 With the exception of off-island orders of the Guam Public School System
2 and off-island purchases of goods and services of the Guam Visitors Bureau
3 directly related to its overseas promotions, no procurement shall be made under
4 this Chapter which shall require advance payment. The Board of Directors of the
5 Guam Visitor's Bureau shall, pursuant to the Administrative Adjudication Act,
6 formulate rules and regulations for the exercise of advanced payment authority."

7 **Section 3. Effective Date.**

8 This Act shall take effect upon adjudication of the rules and regulations required
9 under Section 2 of this Act.

Testimony on Bill Number 264-30
December 23, 2009

*"AN ACT TO AMEND § 5007 OF CHAPTER 5, TITLE 5, GUAM CODE ANNOTATED;
RELATIVE TO INCLUDING THE PROCUREMENT ACTIVITIES OF THE GUAM
VISITORS BUREAU".*

Introduction:

Hafa Adai Vice Speaker Cruz and members of the committee on Tourism, Cultural Affairs, Youth and Public Broadcasting. My name is Gerald S.A. Perez, General Manager, Guam Visitors Bureau. I am here to offer supporting testimony for Bill No. 264-30 and to encourage its enactment into law.

Supporting Testimony:

Guam 's procurement law prohibits the advanced payment for goods and services which have not yet been delivered.

In an increasingly competitive international travel environment, Guam has been consistently disadvantaged by this procurement policy. This is so because many of the trade promotion events, marketing tools and advertising opportunities of interest to Guam require either advanced deposits or prepaid commitments. These practices are normal in the tourism industry and often done to spur competitive event participation, offer savings on advanced commitments, or both. An exemption from this restriction will allow the Bureau to take advantage of timely purchasing opportunities and will enhance its ability to secure desired positioning in various marketing channels, "early bird" registration savings at trade events, and prime space for maximum exposure.



The state of Hawaii has recognized the need for flexibility and procurement agility in marketing their destination, and has provided an exemption accordingly. Hawaii's marketing efforts are currently exempted from the state's public procurement code, and their marketing vendors are even exempted from taxation.

GVB Enabling Legislation:

In its enabling legislation, the Guam Visitors Bureau (GVB) was created as a non-stock, non-profit membership corporation to be governed in accordance with the applicable general corporation laws of the Territory of Guam (P.L. 17-32 and P.L. 17-37). GVB is not a "public corporation", nor is it an entity of the government of Guam as ruled in the *Bordallo v. Reyes, et.al*, No-84-1665, 9th Circuit Court of Appeals (1985), affirming the District Court of Guam, CV83-95-CCD under the same name. Several other cases have reaffirmed "GVB as not an instrumentality of the government exercising governmental functions" e.g., *GEDA v. Island Equipment Co*, (1998).

However, in 5 GCA Government Operations, Ch. 5 Guam Procurement Law, the Guam Visitors Bureau is named as one of the Government of Guam agencies that shall be governed by Articles 1, 3, 6, 7, 10, 11, and 12 of Ch.5 Guam Procurement Law. This stipulation presents a conflict in law between GVB's enabling statute and its inclusion in the procurement law. GVB receives its funding from the Tourist Attraction Fund and from its membership dues and in-kind contributions.

Board of Directors procurement policy:

Since the main funding source of the Bureau comes from the Tourist Attraction Fund in the form of "grants-in-aid" appropriated by the legislature, we recommend the following:

1. In line 2 of the bill's second page insert "or on island" between the words off-island and purchases. The net effect would be to also allow local prepayment for advertising and other marketing related activities.
2. The board of directors adopt a procurement policy based on two purchasing categories:

- a. Local Purchasing: For all purchases of goods and services on island, follow the Title 5, Ch. 5 Guam Procurement Law.
- b. Off island and local marketing related: For all purchases of goods and services off island, or those of a destination hosting and marketing nature, adopt a GVB board-approved procurement policy.

Goods & Services procured under GovGuam Procurement Law

The following support services are necessary and proper for mission of the Guam Visitors Bureau.

- A. Contractual Services
 - a. Janitorial
 - b. Maintenance
 - c. Security
 - d. Copier/Facsimile
- B. Professional Services
 - a. Banking
 - b. Legal
 - c. Audit
 - d. Advertising/Public Relations
- C. Special Projects
 - a. Landscaping
 - b. Beach Cleaning
 - c. Highway Maintenance
 - d. Bathroom Maintenance
 - e. Holiday Illumination
- D. Purchases
 - a. Office Supplies
 - b. Copier Paper
 - c. Refreshments (coffee, creamer, water, paper products)
 - d. Promotional items (shell leis, fans, lanyards, etc.)

Examples of Goods & Services under GVB Board Policy

Services specific to the mission of the Guam Visitors Bureau

- A. Advertising in Visitor Source Markets
 - a. Broadcast Media (local and off-island)
 - b. Newspaper advertising, co-op, etc.
 - c. Magazine advertising, co-op, etc.
 - d. Web site advertising, co-op, etc.
 - e. Directories, catalogues, co-op, etc.
 - f. Guam videos, film, prints, e-media
- B. Conferences, Trade Shows, Travel Exhibitions

Dear Mr. Vice Speaker:

We are submitting written testimony regarding Bill No. 264-30(COR) for which a public hearing was held on December 23, 2009.

We wish to call to your attention that the Guam Visitors Bureau's issue with the procurement policy against advance payments when acquiring floor space at off-island tourism conventions is not unique to the Guam Visitors Bureau.

All government of Guam agencies that rent office space or some other space, whether locally or off-island, share a similar predicament when renting the space because landlords and lessors require payment of monthly rent on or about the first day of the month in advance, as well as a security deposit in advance before occupation. These are standard practices in the industry of space rental, whether for office, home or storage.

Although the existing exception to the policy against advance payments and the exception proposed by Bill No. 264-30(COR) are both fashioned as exceptions concerning off-island vendors, the proposed exception in Bill No. 264-30(COR) might be better suited if expressed as an exception concerning space rental regardless of whether it is off-island or on-island. Doing so would remove an obstacle faced by government agencies each time they need to rent space.
