

1       **BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF GUAM:**

2       **Section 1.** A new §10314 is hereby *added* to Article 3, Chapter 10, Title  
3 5 of the Guam Code Annotated to read:

4               **“§ 10314. Acceptance of Applications, Filings and Forms for**  
5       **Services Via the Internet.** Notwithstanding any other provision of law, all

1 entities of the government of Guam, inclusive of autonomous agencies,  
2 *shall* provide for the acceptance of applications, filings and forms for  
3 services through their official website. If the nature of an application, a  
4 filing or a form *does not* allow for it to be accepted via the internet, the  
5 respective government entity *shall* explicitly state the reason on its  
6 website.”

7 **Section 2. Enactment.** The provisions of this Act *shall* become effective  
8 one hundred eighty (180) days upon enactment.

9 **Section 3. Severability.** *If* any provision of this Law or its application to  
10 any person or circumstance is found to be invalid or contrary to law, such  
11 invalidity shall *not* affect other provisions or applications of this Law which can  
12 be given effect without the invalid provisions or application, and to this end the  
13 provisions of this Law are severable.



## **Committee Report Digest**

### **I. OVERVIEW**

The Committee on Youth, Cultural Affairs, Procurement, General Government Operations and Public Broadcasting convened a public hearing on Tuesday, December 27<sup>th</sup>, 2011 at 9:00 a.m. and an additional hearing on January 5, 2012 at 9:00 A.M. in the Public Hearing Room of *I Liheslatura*. Among the items on the agenda was the consideration of Bill No. 326-31 (COR) - M.S. Taijeron- "An act to add a new Section 10313 to Article 3, Chapter 10, Title 5 of the Guam Code Annotated relative to requiring all Government of Guam Departments and Agencies to accept applications, filings and forms for services via the internet."

**Bill 326-31(COR)** would require all government entities to provide applications, filings, and forms for service via the internet.

### **Public Notice Requirements**

All legal requirements for public notices were met, with requests for publication sent to all media and all senators on December 28<sup>th</sup>, 2011 and January 3<sup>rd</sup>, 2012 via email. Copies of the hearing notices are appended to the report.

The public hearing was called to order at 9:06 a.m.

### **II. SUMMARY OF TESTIMONY AND DISCUSSION**

**Vice Speaker Benjamin J.F. Cruz** called the public hearing to order at 9:06 a.m. and announced the morning's agenda. Vice Speaker Cruz recognized the primary sponsor of Bill 326(COR) Senator Mana Silva Taijeron.

**Senator Mana Silva Taijeron** noted that the intent of bill 321(COR) is to require all entities of



the Government of Guam to provide all applications, forms and filings for services via the internet. Senator Taijeron added that this measure would allow Guam's citizens the convenience of interacting with government from their homes given increased traffic delays and the rising cost of gasoline. The Senator closed by acknowledging that the measure would require that any agency who cannot comply with the provisions of this act must specifically state the reason for that noncompliance on its website. She also thanked the administration for its cooperation in drafting the measure.

**Vice Speaker Cruz** invited Mr. Ed Cruz to provide testimony before the Committee.

**Ed Cruz**, appearing in his capacity as Director of the Bureau of Information Technology provided written testimony, attached hereto, in **support** of bill 326 which he read into the record.

**Senator Tom Ada** noted that while he supports the intended end state of the bill 326, the measure should be expanded to allow individuals to download a form or application via the internet and transmit it back to the relevant agency via fax. He said that he would work with the author to broaden the scope of the measure.

**Senator Silvia Taijeron** said that while she would support the amendment as proposed by Senator Ada, the original intent of the bill was to provide for a greener alternative.

**Senator Judith P. Guthertz, DPA** said that she appreciated knowing that BIT existed and was making progress in its endeavors. However, she expressed concern that individuals seeking driver's licenses, vehicle registrations, and transfers still had to wait in long lines while alternatives like the Post Office continue to exist.

She also noted that while the Legislature has the authority to create mandates, it should not create false hopes when the money required for implementation does not exist. In addition Senator Guthertz also asked Mr. Cruz and the Committee to consider decentralization of services or privatization of such services where appropriate.

**Senator Guthertz** concluded that given the low cost options she proposed, the government cannot continue to wait for a solution.

**Senator V. Anthony Ada**, acknowledged that Senator Guthertz had a good point and asked Mr. Cruz why online renewals for registration were no longer being accepted by DRT.

**Ed Cruz** responded by saying that while the government has the necessary merchant services, it



was still in an ongoing RFP process for the Point of Sale system required for the transaction. He noted that barring no unforeseen delays, the RFP process would be complete in three weeks. The online payment system has been offline since November 30<sup>th</sup> of 2011.

**Vice Speaker Cruz** thanked Mr. Cruz for his testimony.

### **III. FINDINGS AND RECOMMENDATION**

The Committee on Youth, Cultural Affairs, Procurement, General Government Operations and Public Broadcasting to which was referred Bill No. 326-31(COR) “An act to add a new Section 10313 to Article 3, Chapter 10, Title 5 of the Guam Code Annotated relative to requiring all Government of Guam Departments and Agencies to accept applications, filings and forms for services via the internet.” hereby submits these findings to *I Mina' Trentai Unu na Liheslaturan Guahan* and reports out Bill No. 326-31 (COR) with a recommendation **TO REPORT OUT ONLY.**

Thank you Honorable Vice-Speaker Benjamin J.F. Cruz, Committee Chair on Youth, Cultural Affairs, Procurement, General Government Operations and Public Broadcasting and Honorable Senators for the opportunity to comment on Bill 326-31 (COR), "An act to add a new section 10313 to Article 3, Chapter 10, Title 5 of the Guam Code Annotated relative to requiring all Government of Guam Departments and Agencies to accept applications, filings and forms for services via the internet."

Agencies, departments, offices and boards make up the 64 Government of Guam websites online today. Most websites are hosted at the Government of Guam Data Center and are gradually undergoing updates that will enable real-time editing and management at the agency level with minimal effort and experience. This shift from a "static" website to a "dynamic" one, will improve our efficiency as a Government in providing current, transparent data and information. This upgrade will also allow for the programming of forms to be able to be submitted online.

The gradual updates to all Government websites require web-proficient staff and/or private sector contracts to accomplish. At present, I have only two (2) web-proficient staff capable of accomplishing this Government-wide upgrade. Agencies with funding are able to contract such services that improve the speed of completion.

An example of the success we have had with a private sector contractor is the latest Department of Public Health and Social Services website ([dphss.guam.gov](http://dphss.guam.gov)), which boasts a new look, improved layout, and allows for real-time posting of data and information by the DPHSS staff.

Contracting costs associated with converting current Government of Guam websites to a dynamic platform range from \$500 to \$12,000 depending on the websites complexity and overall need. Additional programming of online forms to cost about \$100/hour, with a simple form needing a minimum of 4 hours of development time. Timeframe for completion would be roughly 3 weeks per website.

With the Governments minimal web-proficient staff and lack of Government-wide funding for private sector contracting, our pace has been slow.

As upgrades to websites are completed, the Bureau of Information Technology will work to provide more submittable forms online with our current capacity and future contractors. I also support the "stating of reason" requirement if an agency's form is not capable of online submission

This bill is consumer-centric and has my full support. I understand the improved outcomes providing this service and convenience, to all consumers of our Government Agencies, will yield.

**BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF GUAM:**

**Section 1.** A new §10313 is hereby *added* to Article 3, Chapter 10, Title 5 of the Guam Code Annotated to read:

**“§ 10313. Acceptance of Applications, Filings and Forms for Services via the Internet.** Notwithstanding any other provision of law, all entities of the government of Guam, inclusive of autonomous agencies, shall provide for the acceptance of applications, filing and forms for services through their official website. If the nature of an application, a filing or a form does not allow for it to be accepted via the internet, the respective government entity shall explicitly state the reason on its website.”

**Section 2. Enactment.** The provisions of this Act shall become effective one-hundred eighty (180) days upon enactment.

1           **Section 3. Severability.** *If* any provision of this Law or its application to any  
2 person or circumstance is found to be invalid or contrary to law, such invalidity shall  
3 *not* affect other provisions or applications of this Law which can be given effect  
4 without the invalid provisions or application, and to this end the provisions of this  
5 Law are severable.
