### COMMITTEE REPORT DIGEST

#### **I. OVERVIEW**

The Committee on Education and Public Libraries convened a public hearing on March 17, 2011 at 2:00 p.m. in *I Liheslatura's* Public Hearing Room. Among the items on the agenda was the consideration of Bill No. 42-31 (LS) "An act to repeal §3123 of Title 17 Guam Code Annotated relative to the Superintendent and Deputy Superintendent not part of *I Maga'lahaen Guahan's* (Governor's) Cabinet," sponsored by Speaker Judith T. Won Pat, Ed.D.

#### Public Notice Requirements

Notices were disseminated via fax or email to all senators and all main media broadcasting outlets on March 10, 2011 (5-Day Notice), and again on March 15, 2011 (48-Hour Notice).

#### **II. SUMMARY OF TESTIMONY & DISCUSSION**

Committee Chairperson Speaker Judith T. Won Pat, Ed.D. called the public hearing to order at 2:00 p.m. and announced the afternoon's agenda. **No public testimony** was submitted on Bill No. 42-31 (LS) "An act to repeal §3123 of Title 17 Guam Code Annotated relative to the Superintendent and Deputy Superintendent not part of *I Maga'lahaen Guahan's* (Governor's) Cabinet,"

Senator pangelinan asked who would supervise the Superintendent the Governor or the Board.

Speaker Won Pat replied that it is the Board and the Board delineates who hires and fires.

Senator pangelinan asked so what is the confusion about being part of the cabinet.

Speaker Won Pat replied that Superintendent does not sit or participate in any discussion that takes place on the executive side. She further stated that the Superintendent is not answerable to the Governor; it just means the Superintendent may sit in the meetings and participate.

Senator pangelinan asked if the Superintendent is excluded.

Speaker Won Pat replied that the Superintendent has not been included

Senator pangelinan asked if the Superintendent was excluded before.

Speaker Won Pat replied that the Superintendent has not been included before.

Senator pangelinan asked that the Superintendent does not want to attend because of the law.

Speaker Won Pat replied that the former Governor said that the Superintendent is not a member of the cabinet.

Senator pangelinan asked if the Superintendent has not been coming to the meetings.

Speaker Won Pat replied yes and we should be reminded that we are one government.

### **III. FINDINGS & RECOMMENDATIONS**

The Committee on Education and Public Libraries finds that the Organic Act assigns the responsibility of providing an adequate educational system to the entire Government of Guam. The repealing of §3123 of Title 17 Guam Code Annotated will allow the Governor to invite the Superintendent of the Department of Education to cabinet level meetings. The participation of the Superintendent in cabinet level meetings will allow agencies directly or indirectly in providing public education to children, to hear directly from the Superintendent the state of public education and to address issues affecting public education.

The Committee on Education and Public Libraries hereby reports out Bill No. 42-31 (COR) with the recommendation **TO REPORT OUT ONLY.**
