

Among the items on the agenda was the consideration of BILL NO. 402-31(LS)- An act to amend § 58119 (G) Title 12 Guam Code Annotated, Chapter 58, relative to requiring locally-based, locally-owned businesses and services for qualifying certificates; Sponsored by Senator Sam Mabini, Ph.D.

II. SUMMARY OF TESTIMONY & DISCUSSION.

Chairman Dennis G. Rodriguez, Jr., convened the Public Hearing on Bill 402-31(LS). Chairman Rodriguez invited Sen. Mabini, as the author of Bill 402-31 (LS), to explain the intent of the bill.

Senator Mabini: Thank you, Mr. Chair. As Bill 402 states, this basically enhances the existing legislation that sits under GCA Ch 58 relative to requiring locally based, locally businesses and services who are applying for QCs. As we know we have a lot of highly qualified local training institutions on island and currently a lot of initiatives about purchasing locally and what this does is enhances the training components as a locally purchased item that we would like those who avail of the qualifying certificates. So when an entity who applies for a QC applies that they understand that one of their requirements should they need any training that they buy locally first and look at our local institutions which are highly qualified and local experts as well and we would like them to avail of that. Should neither of those be required then to make contributions to locally independent scholarships and institutions to

On behalf of the Guam Economic Development Authority I am submitting written testimony in favor of Bill 402-31. The passage into law of this bill would do much to support the growth of the "Buy Local" initiative on our island, create additional business, and increase our local tax base. We ask that you look favorably on Bill 402-31 with minor changes as follows:

- Remove "or" at the end of (i) as this will negate the intent stated in (i).
- Add "as needed" after locally based experts in (i)
- Replace "and" with "or" at the end of (ii) so as not to make (iii) an additional requirement

Therefore Section 2. §58110(g) of Chapter 58, Title 12 of the Guam Code Annotated would be amended to read as follows:

"(g) Training. Requiring the Beneficiary to (i) utilize locally based and locally owned training services as needed (ii) establish an in house training program that consults with locally based experts as needed or (iii) make contributions to an independent training or scholarship fund. Initial consideration for locally based and locally owned businesses or services shall be granted before considering and soliciting businesses or services outside of Guam.

In closing, I further would like to clarify that so long as the tax rebate and abatement does not apply to BPT taxes collected by the Government this bill will not have an impact on the current 2011 Business Privilege Tax (BPT) Bond.




