AN ACT TO AMEND §8103 OF CHAPTER 8, TITLE 5, GUAM CODE ANNOTATED, RELATIVE TO ALLOWING THE RECORDING OF OPEN MEETINGS.

#### BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF GUAM:

- Section 1. §8103 of Chapter 8, Title 5, Guam Code Annotated, is *amended* to read as follows:
- 4 "§8103. Open Meetings.
  - (a) Every meeting of a public agency *shall* be open and public, and any person *shall* be permitted to attend any public agency meeting, *except* as otherwise provided in this Chapter. A member of the public *shall not* be

required, as a condition to attendance at a meeting of a public agency, to register his name and other information, to complete a questionnaire or otherwise to fulfill any condition precedent to his attendance.

- (b) This Chapter does *not* require that a person who is admitted to a meeting of a public agency shall, because of his mere presence, be accorded an opportunity to participate in such a meeting. Each public agency retains the right to reserve areas for the public, and to exclude the public from any area necessary for the orderly conduct of its business.
- (c) *Except* for executive sessions and other meetings expressly authorized by public law to be closed, *no* board, commission or public officer of the government of Guam may prevent or deny the recording (audio and/or video) of any public meeting."

The Committee on Youth, Cultural Affairs, Procurement, General Government Operations and Public Broadcasting convened a public hearing on Monday April 18, 2011, 2011 at 10:0 a.m. in the Public Hearing Room of *I Liheslatura*. Among the items on the agenda was the consideration of **Bill No. 126-31** (COR) —"An act to amend §8103 of 5GCA relative to allowing the recording of open meetings."

Bill 126-31 would enhance the Open Government Law. To be in compliance, all agencies, boards or commissions, law would have to record all open government meetings using either audio or video recording devices.

# 2011 HIM AR PM 4: 10

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF GUAM:

**Section 1.** Section 8103 of 5GCA is *amended* to read as follows:

#### § 8103. Open Meetings.

- (a) Every meeting of a public agency shall be open and public, and any person shall be permitted to attend any public agency meeting except as otherwise provided in this Chapter. A member of the public shall not be required, as a condition to attendance at a meeting of public agency, to register his name and other information, to complete a questionnaire or otherwise to fulfill any condition precedent to his attendance.
- (b) This Chapter does not require that a person who is admitted to a meeting of a public agency shall, because of his mere presence, be accorded an opportunity to participate in such a meeting. Each public agency retains the right to reserve areas for the public and to exclude the public from any area necessary for the orderly conduct of its business.
- (c) Except for executive sessions and other meetings expressly authorized by Public Law to be closed; no board, commission or public officer of the government of Guam may prevent, deny or impede the recording (audio and/or video) of any public meeting.
