

**AN ACT TO AMEND §19117 OF CHAPTER 19 OF TITLE
3, GUAM CODE ANNOTATED, RELATIVE TO
CAMPAIGN ADVERTISING; AND TO PROVIDE FOR
PENALTIES FOR VIOLATIONS OF THIS CHAPTER.**

1 **BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF GUAM:**

2 **Section 1. Legislative Findings and Intent.** *I Liheslaturan Guåhan* finds
3 that Guam is one of many jurisdictions across the United States that has been
4 plagued by outmoded laws and inadequate or antiquated administrative procedures
5 relative to the conduct of elections, bringing into question the integrity of election
6 processes.

1 Among the various amendments needed to be made to Guam’s election laws
2 are those required to address the challenges of modern advertising and the rapid
3 spread of information through mass mailing and via the internet. The speed at
4 which accurate, inaccurate and fabricated information can be dispensed, especially
5 on the internet, requires that additional safeguards be placed on campaign
6 advertising and messaging.

7 More often than not, misleading information about candidates and their
8 platforms is as plentiful and easy to access during election season as is the factual
9 information produced by the candidates themselves. Voters seeking to learn more
10 about candidates should know if the information they are receiving is actually
11 approved by the candidates themselves, or if it has been fabricated by a candidate’s
12 opponent, or a third party, in order to mislead and confuse.

13 It is the intent of *I Liheslatura* to amend existing sections of the election
14 code to ensure that voters seeking information on candidates know the source of
15 the information and whether the candidate or candidates in question have approved
16 the message, and to provide penalties for those who violate the code.

17 **Section 2.** §19117 of Chapter 19 of Title 3, Guam Code Annotated, is
18 *amended* to read:

19 **“§19117. Advertising.**

20 (a) *No person shall* cause or submit any advertisement in support
21 of a candidate to be published, broadcasted, televised, posted on-line, mass-
22 mailed, canvassed, or otherwise circulated and distributed, *except* under the
23 following conditions:

24 (1) the advertisement *shall* contain a notice in a prominent
25 location that the literature or advertisement for any medium is
26 published, broadcasted, televised, posted on-line, mass-mailed,
27 canvassed, or otherwise circulated with the approval and authority of

1 the candidate; *provided*, that in the event that the literature or
2 advertisement is paid for by a candidate or committee directly
3 associated with a candidate, the notice of approval and authority need
4 *not* be included; or

5 (2) the advertisement *shall* contain a notice in a prominent
6 location that the literature or advertisement for any medium is
7 published, broadcasted, televised, posted on-line, or otherwise
8 circulated without the approval and authority of the candidate.

9 (b) All advertisements mentioned in Subsection (a) above, and all
10 other advertisements of a political nature, *shall* contain the true name and
11 address of the candidate, committee, person or political party paying for
12 same.

13 (c) In the case of video advertisements of a political nature for any
14 medium, the advertisement *shall* contain an audio statement that identifies
15 the candidate and states that the candidate either has approved the
16 communication, or the communication is being circulated without the
17 approval and authority of the candidate. Such statement *shall* be conveyed
18 by the following:

19 (1) for approved communications, an unobscured, full-screen
20 view of the candidate making the statement, or the candidate in voice-
21 over, accompanied by a clearly identifiable photographic or similar
22 image of the candidate; or

23 (2) for *non*-approved communications, a statement in voice-
24 over that the communication is being circulated *without* the approval
25 and authority of the candidate.

26 (d) In advertisements of a political nature, such approval or non-
27 approval statement *shall* also appear in writing at the end of the

1 communication in a clearly readable typeface, with a reasonable degree of
2 color contrast between the background and the printed statement, for a
3 period of *at least* four (4) seconds.

4 (e) Every person who willfully causes, produces, provides funding
5 for, or assists in the production of a message of a political nature which the
6 person knows to be incorrect or purposefully misleading and in which a
7 candidate, rather than an issue, is the target; *or which is in violation of this*
8 *§19117, shall* be subject to a civil penalty of *not more than* Five Thousand
9 Dollars (\$5,000) per each separately produced message.

10 (f) The fines herein *shall* be deposited in the General Fund for the
11 use of the Guam Election Commission, subject to appropriation by *I*
12 *Liheslaturan Guåhan*. A report of all fines *shall* be submitted quarterly to *I*
13 *Maga'lahi and I Liheslatura.*”

I. OVERVIEW: The Committee on Health & Human Services, Economic Development, Senior Citizens, and Election Reform conducted a public hearing on January 28, 2011. The Hearing convened at 09:00 A.M. in *I Liheslatura's* Public Hearing Room. Among the items on the agenda was the consideration of **BILL NO. 27-31 (COR)** – AN ACT TO REPEAL AND REENACT TITLE 3, GUAM CODE ANNOTATED CHAPTER 19 §19117 RELATIVE TO CAMPAIGN ADVERTISING, AND TO PROVIDE PENALTIES FOR THOSE IN VIOLATION OF THIS CHAPTER.; Sponsored by Rory J. Respicio.

Public Notice Requirements

Notices were disseminated via hand-delivery/fax and/or e-mail to all senators and all main media broadcasting outlets on January 20, 2011 (5-Day Notice), and again on January 25, 2011 (48-Hour Notice). Notice was published *on-line* in the Pacific Daily News on January 21, 2011.

II. SUMMARY OF TESTIMONY & DISCUSSION.

CHAIRMAN DENNIS G. RODRIGUEZ, JR., convened the Public Hearing on Bill No. 27-31 (COR). Invited Senator Rory J. Respicio, author of Bill No. 27-31 (COR), to explain the intent of the Bill.

Senator Respicio: Thank you very much Mr. Chairman, thank you also for hearing this bill this morning. I think this bill, in my opinion, has been a long time coming and there is no particular general election in the past that has spurred me to move in this particular direction, but this mirrors what is already required in federal elections.

You see our President or even our Congresswoman Bordallo, every time there is a political advertisement she would say, "I'm Madeline Bordallo and I approve this ad." Same with Barak Obama and national leaders when he here those televised commercials. But Mr. Chairman and members of the audience, this bill goes a bit further to require those video advertisements of any medium that the advertisements contain an oral statement that identifies the candidate and state that the candidate either approves the communication or the communication is being circulated without the approval and authority of the candidate. Now what this means is that we know that in this day and age it's very easy as we've seen in the past for people to put together 30 second commercials and immediately upload to social mediums and these could be political ads that represent a certain political campaign degrading that their opponents message or just trying to capitalize in a very negative fashion. So I would like your committee and the legislature to really recognize that this bill is needed in this day and age. Particularly, because of the technology available to all of us and the most important thing, this bill, Mr. Chairman, it would be a felony for anyone who does not comply with this particular bill should it become law. So, I ask for your consideration and once again thank you for having this bill heard this morning.

Chairman: Called the first panel to testify – No one was signed up to testify, nor came forward at the invitation of the Chairman.

There being no other testimony, or comments by Senators, Chairman Rodriguez declared the bill as having been heard, and concluded the public hearing on Bill No. 27-31 (COR). The Committee would continue to accept written testimony for a period of ten (10) subsequent to the public hearing.

Fiscal Note: Requested January 10, 2011 (attached). As of this date, February 14, 2011, a Fiscal Note has not been received.

III. FINDINGS & RECOMMENDATIONS

The Committee finds that the proliferation of unclaimed or anonymous disparaging ads against candidates is reaching unacceptable, epidemic proportions. This is a new deplorable phenomenon not previously seen in Guam's political campaigns. Regardless of political affiliation or position on issues before our electorate, it is appropriate that we as a people who appreciate and demand accurate and accountable campaigning, take affirmative steps to insure

that any statement(s) and/or claim(s) being made about a candidate(s) be accurate and factual, and that someone publicly takes ownership and responsibility for making them.



The Committee on Health and Human Services, Economic Development, Senior Citizens and Election Reform will be conducting a public hearing on Friday, Jan. 28.

The hearing will take place at 9 a.m. in the Legislature public hearing room.

The public will be able to submit testimony on the following bills:

Bill 24-31 which would change the guidelines by which the Guam Economic Development Authority makes loans. (Introduced by T.R. Muña Barnes).

Bill 27-31 would require the disclosure of the names of candidates or groups paying for political advertisements. (Introduced by R.J. Respicio).

Bill 31-31 would require that at the time of filing for candidacy with the Guam Election Commission, a candidate shall submit a clearance from the Department of Revenue and Taxation's collections branch, on a form provided by the commission, showing there is no past-due tax obligation owed by the candidate to the government of Guam. Bill 36-31 would establish a Government of Guam Mitigation Program for Business Interruption. (Introduced by Sen. Ben Pangelinan).

Resolution No.008-31 would express the objection of the Legislature to the 112th United States Congress for restricting the voting rights of Territorial and District Congressional Delegates. (Introduced by Sens. Rodriguez, Pangelinan and Respicio.)

1 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF GUAM:

2 Section 1. Legislative findings and intent. *I Liheslaturan Guåhan*
3 finds that Guam is one of many jurisdictions across the United States that
4 has been plagued by outmoded laws and inadequate or antiquated
5 administrative procedures relative to the conduct of elections, bringing into
6 question the integrity of election processes.

7 Among the various amendments needed to be made to Guam's
8 election laws are those required to address the challenges of modern
9 advertising and the rapid spread of information through mass mailing and
10 via the internet. The speed at which accurate, inaccurate and fabricated
11 information can be dispensed, especially on the internet, requires that
12 additional safeguards be placed on campaign advertising and messaging.

13 As often as not, misleading information about candidates and their
14 platforms is as plentiful and easy to access during election season as is the

1 factual information produced by the candidates themselves. Voters seeking
2 to learn more about candidates should know if the information they are
3 receiving is actually approved by the candidates themselves, or if it has
4 been fabricated by a candidate's opponent, or a third party, in order to
5 mislead and confuse.

6 It is the intent of *I Liheslatura* to amend existing sections of the
7 election code to ensure that voters seeking information on candidates know
8 the source of the information and whether the candidate or candidates in
9 question have approved the message, and to provide penalties for those
10 who violate the code.

11 **Section 2. § 19117 of Title 3 Guam Code Annotated Chapter 19 is**
12 **amended to read:**

13 **“§ 19117. Advertising.**

14 (a) No person shall cause or submit any advertisement in
15 support of a candidate to be published, broadcast, televised, posted
16 on-line, mass-mailed, canvassed, or otherwise circulated and
17 distributed except under the following conditions:

18 (l) The advertisement shall contain a notice in a
19 prominent location that the literature or advertisement for any
20 medium is published, broadcast, televised, posted on-line,
21 mass-mailed, canvassed, or otherwise circulated with the

1 approval and authority of the candidate, provided that in the
2 event that the literature or advertisement is paid for by a
3 candidate or committee directly associated with a candidate,
4 the notice of approval and authority need not be included; or

5 (2) The advertisement shall contain a notice in a
6 prominent location that the literature or advertisement for any
7 medium is published, broadcast, televised, posted on-line, or
8 otherwise circulated without the approval and authority of the
9 candidate.

10 (b) All advertisements mentioned in Subsection (a) above and
11 all other advertisements of a political nature shall contain the true
12 name and address of the candidate, committee, person or political
13 party paying for same.

14 (c) In the case of video advertisements for any medium, the
15 advertisement shall contain an oral statement that identifies the
16 candidate and states that the candidate either has approved the
17 communication, or the communication is being circulated without
18 the approval and authority of the candidate. Such statement shall be
19 conveyed by the following:

20 (1) for approved communications, an unobscured, full-
21 screen view of the candidate making the statement, or the

1 candidate in voice-over, accompanied by a clearly identifiable
2 photographic or similar image of the candidate; or

3 (2) for non-approved communications, a statement in
4 voice-over, that the communication is being circulated without
5 the approval and authority of the candidate.

6 (d) Such statement shall also appear in writing at the end of the
7 communication in a clearly readable typeface with a reasonable
8 degree of color contrast between the background and the printed
9 statement, for a period of at least 4 seconds.

10 (e) Every person who willfully causes, produces, provides
11 funding for, or assists in the production of advertising which the
12 person knows to be incorrect or purposefully misleading; or for
13 which no statement is included regarding the candidate's approval or
14 disapproval of the message, is guilty of a felony of the third degree.
15 Each and every separately produced message constitutes a separate
16 offense."
