
**CERTIFICATION OF PASSAGE OF AN ACT TO *I MAGA'LÅHEN GUÅHAN***

**AN ACT TO ADD A NEW § 79601.3. TO ARTICLE 6,  
CHAPTER 79, TITLE 21, GUAM CODE ANNOTATED,  
RELATIVE TO AUTHORIZING THE ERECTION OF A  
PACIFIC RADIATION SURVIVORS MONUMENT.**

1 **BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF GUAM:**

2 **Section 1.** A new § 79601.3 of Article 6, Chapter 79, Title 21, Guam Code  
3 Annotated, is hereby *added* to read as follows:

1                   **“§ 79601.3. Pacific Radiation Survivors Monument.**

2           Notwithstanding any other provision of law, the Pacific Association of  
3           Radiation Survivors (PARS) is hereby authorized to erect a “Guam Nuclear  
4           Down-winders Memorial Monument” in the municipality of *Hagåtña*, in  
5           honor of the ultimate sacrifices of the men and women of Guam who,  
6           according to the U.S. National of Academy of Science, were unknowingly  
7           exposed to nuclear radiation fallout that travelled downwind from the U.S.  
8           nuclear weapons testing and detonation of sixty-two (62) nuclear bombs in  
9           the Marshall Islands from 1946 to 1962, and who suffered from cancer and  
10          other illnesses associated with radiation exposure. As part of the *Hagåtña*  
11          Master Plan, the *Hagåtña* Restoration and Redevelopment Authority Board  
12          of Commissioners *shall* provide a monument and parks component that  
13          includes the Pacific Association of Radiation Survivors Monument. The  
14          Pacific Association of Radiation Survivors in the preparation and  
15          construction of the Monument *shall* comply with the following provisions:

16                   (a)   occupy a minimum of four hundred (400) square feet of  
17                   land area within the municipality of *Hagåtña*;

18                   (b)   submit to the *Hagåtña* Restoration and Redevelopment  
19                   Authority the plan and design of the Monument. The Monument *shall*  
20                   include, at a minimum and as provided for in this Chapter, the names  
21                   of Guam’s men and women who were exposed to the downwind  
22                   nuclear fallout and who subsequently were diagnosed with cancer or  
23                   other nuclear radiation related illness; and

24                   (c)   *shall not* hold the government of Guam liable or  
25                   responsible for any expenses related to the construction and  
26                   maintenance for the monument authorized herein.”
