

**AN ACT TO *AMEND* § 5204(d) OF ARTICLE 2,  
CHAPTER 5, TITLE 11, GUAM CODE ANNOTATED,  
RELATIVE TO SUPPORTING THE DEVELOPMENT  
OF SAFE AND HEALTHY YOUTH AND COMMUNITY  
ACTIVITIES BY APPROPRIATING FUNDS FROM THE  
LIMITED GAMING FUND FOR FISCAL YEAR 2015  
AND ANNUALLY THEREAFTER TO THE MAYORS  
COUNCIL OF GUAM, THE DEPARTMENT OF  
EDUCATION, AND THE DEPARTMENT OF PARKS  
AND RECREATION.**

1 **BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF GUAM:**

1           **Section 1.** § 5204(d) of Article 2, Chapter 5, Title 11, Guam Code  
2 Annotated, is hereby *amended* to read:

3           “(d) Moneys remaining in the Fund, after maintaining the stated  
4 reserves for administrative expenses of this Act, are hereby appropriated,  
5 and for the purposes of the repair and construction of sports facilities *shall*  
6 continue to be deemed appropriated, annually, in the following manner in  
7 each fiscal year:

8                   (1) up to one third (1/3) of the available balance to the  
9 Mayors Council of Guam for the repair and construction of village  
10 recreational facilities, including community centers, and for the  
11 procurement of sports equipment and supplies, including, but not  
12 limited to, team sponsorships and uniforms. Funds may also be used  
13 to purchase equipment required to support community programs  
14 administered by village Mayors;

15                   (2) up to one third (1/3) of the available balance to the  
16 Department of Parks and Recreation for the repair and construction of  
17 its facilities, and for the procurement of sports equipment and  
18 supplies;

19                   (3) up to one third (1/3) of the available balance to the  
20 Department of Education for the repair and construction of its sports  
21 facilities, and for the procurement of sports equipment and supplies;  
22 and

23                   (4) No more than fifty percent (50%) of the amount  
24 authorized in Item (1), twenty percent (20%) of the amount authorized  
25 in Item (2), and twenty percent (20%) of the amount authorized in  
26 Item (3) of this Subsection, for the repair and construction of village

recreational facilities and for the procurement of sports equipment and supplies, *may* be used for team sponsorships and uniforms.”

**Section 2. Fiscal Year 2015 Appropriation.** Funds collected and available in Fiscal Year 2015 in accordance with § 5204(d) of Article 2, Chapter 5, Title 11, Guam Code Annotated, are hereby appropriated from the Limited Gaming Fund as enacted by P.L. 32-060 to the Mayors Council of Guam, the Department of Education, and the Department of Parks and Recreation as set forth in § 5204(d). The Department of Administration *shall* release said appropriated funds to each entity as identified herein.
