AN ACT TO ADD SECTION 223 TO CHAPTER 3, TITLE I, GOVERNMENT CODE OF GUAM, RELATIVE TO ESTABLISHING A STANDARD TIME FOR GUAM AND PROVIDING FOR DAYLIGHT SAVING TIME FOR GUAM.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAM:

Section 1. A new Section 223 is hereby added to Chapter 3.

Title I, Government Code of Guam, to read as follows:

"Section 223. Standard Time.

- (a) The standard time throughout this territory is that of the one hundred fiftieth (150th) meridian of longitude east from Greenwich. Such time shall be known as Guam Standard Time.
- that at two (2) e'clock ante meridian of a day fixed therein standard time, as provided in subsection (a) hereof, shall be advanced not more than one hour from the time of the one hundred fiftieth meridian of longitude east from Greenwich, and may further provide by Executive Order that at two (2) o'clock ante meridian of a day fixed therein the standard time as so advanced shall be retarded to the standard time of the one hundred fiftieth meridian of longitude east from Greenwich. When the time is advanced pursuant to this subsection it shall be known as Guam Daylight Saving Time."
