AN ACT TO EXEMPT GUAM FROM THE PROVISIONS
OF SECTION 3(a) OF THE UNIFORM TIME ACT
OF 1966.

1 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAM:

2 Section 1. The territory of Guam is hereby exempted from
3 the provisions of subsection (a) of Section 3 of the Uniform Time
4 Act of 1966 (Public Law 89-387).

5 Section 2. During the period beginning at 2:00 o'clock
6 antemeridian on the last Sunday of April of each year and ending at
7 2:00 o'clock antemeridian on the last Sunday of October of each
8 year, the entire territory of Guam, including all divisions thereof
9 however denominated, shall observe the standard time otherwise applic-
10 able under the Act of Congress approved March 19, 1918 (40 Stat. 450;
11 15 U.S.C. 261-264).

12 Section 3. This Act is an urgency measure.
