AN ACT TO EXEMPT SUAN FROM THE PROVISIONS OF SECTION 3(a) OF THE UNIFORM TIME ACT OF 1966.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAN:

Section 1. The territory of Guam is hereby exempted from the provisions of subsection (a) of Section 3 of the Uniform Time Act of 1966 (Public Law 89-387).

Section 2. During the period beginning at 2:00 e'clock antemeridian on the last Sunday of April of each year and ending at 2:00 e'clock antemeridian on the last Sunday of October of each year, the entire territory of Guam, including all divisions thereof however denominated, shall observe the standard time otherwise applicable under the Act of Congress approved March 19, 1918 (40 Stat. 450; 15 U.S.C. 261-264).

Section 3. This Act is an argency measure.
