Vetoed Bill No. 155-31(COR) - to de-appropriate the sums appropriated and transferred by *I Maga'lahen Guåhan* during Fiscal Years 2004 through 2009 for expenditures related to the Municipal Solid Waste Landfill Facility and the closure of the *Ordot* Dump, and re-appropriate said sum amount for the payment of emergency income tax refunds for tax year 2009 and prior, and appropriate Five Hundred Thousand Dollars

- (\$500,000) to the Department of Public Works for the *Umatac* and *Merizo* Cemeteries; and to *amend* §§58b102 and 58b106 of Chapter 56b, Title 5, Guam Code Annotated, relative to pledge of Section 30 Revenues for the expansion of *Okkodo* High School.
2. Vetoed Bill No. 145-31 (COR) - An act making appropriations for the operations of the Executive, Legislative, and Judicial Branches of the government of Guam for Fiscal Year ending September 30, 2012, making other appropriations, and establishing miscellaneous and administrative provisions.
 3. Vetoed Bill No. 241-31(COR) - An act to exempt maps of the Chamorro Land Trust lease sites previously approved by the Chamorro Land Trust Commission from the requirements of Article 2, Chapter 62 of the Guam Code Annotated, relative to subdivision and recordation procedures.
 4. Vetoed Bill No. 406-31(COR) - An act to *repeal* and *reenact* Section 21 of Chapter XII of Public Law 31-77, relative to providing for assignability of offsets against Business Privilege Taxes for the outstanding debt balance owed for the completion of the Guam Public Market Redevelopment Project, Phase II-Department of Commerce Project No. 320-5-1008-1-AGN, including Change Orders No. 1 and No. 2.
 5. Vetoed Bill No. 431-31(COR) – An act to provide for a limited extension of the contract between the Department of Public Health and Social Services (DPHSS) and the GovGuam Association of Retired Persons/*Servicio Para I Manamko* (GGARP/SPIMA) to provide *Senior Center Services for the Comprehensive Management, Operations, and Maintenance of the Senior Center Operations Program* for the Division of Senior Citizens, DPHSS.
 6. Vetoed Bill No. 319-31(COR), An act to amend §72105 of Chapter 72, Title 10, Guam Code Annotated, relative to authorizing private ambulance service providers to provide emergency medical services; and to amend §§3202(b), 3301(e), 3334(d) and 3339(d) of Chapter 3, Title 16, Guam Code Annotated, relative to emergency vehicles operating on Guam’s roadways.
 7. Vetoed Bill No. 306-31(LS), An act to *add* a new §90.48 to 9 Guam Code Annotated, Chapter 90, relative to establishing and administering an international prisoner transfer program.
 8. Vetoed Bill No. 516-31(COR), An act to *amend* Section 3 of Public Law 31-40, relative to extending The Obligation Deadline Of The ARRA Trust Fund; and to *amend* Section 2(i) and Section 2(iv) of Chapter I; to *add* a new Section 14 to Chapter XI; to *amend* Section 13 of Chapter XII and to *amend* Section 6 of Part III of Chapter III, all of Public Law 31-233.

9. Vetoed Bill No. 513-31(COR), An act to provide health insurance to government of Guam employees and retirees for Fiscal Year 2013.
10. Vetoed Bill No. 263-31(COR), An act to *amend* Subsection (D) of § 61103 of Article 1; and to *amend* Subsections (D), (E), (F), and (G) of 61531, to *repeal* § 61531.1, and to *amend* Subsection (D)(1) of § 61532 of Part 4 of Article 5, all of Chapter 61, Title 21, Guam Code Annotated, relative to parking regulations.
11. Vetoed Bill No. 445-31(COR), An act to *repeal and reenact* Chapter 12 of Title 5, Guam Code Annotated, relative to the Modernization and Rightsizing Commission of the government of Guam, and *repealing* antiquated, unfunded and/or underutilized statues or administrative rules.
12. Bill No. 514-31(COR), An act to *amend* item (ii) and *repeal* Item (iii) of §1512.3(a)(2)(b) of Article 5, Chapter 1, Title 5, Guam Code Annotated, relative to prioritizing the payment of income tax refunds with the remaining Eighteen Million Dollars of Series B Bond proceeds.
13. Bill No. 529-31(COR), An act to *amend* §66104.2 of Chapter 66, Title 10, Guam Code Annotated, relative to the employment of Civilian Volunteer Police Reserve Officers.
14. Bill No. 511-31 – line item veto of §2960(a) of P.L. 31-278; An act to *amend* § 2950, *repeal* and *reenact* § 2951, *amend* §§ 2952 through 2954, *add* a new § 2954(a), and *amend* §§ 2955 through 2960 all of chapter 2, Article 10, Title 10 Guam Code Annotated, relative to updating the Adult Protective Services’ mandates.
