ACCOMPLISHMENTS AND DEDICATION OF THE LATE HONORABLE JOHN CAMACHO SALAS PHD FORMER SENATOR WHO IS ALSO THE FOUNDING PRESIDENT OF THE GUAM COMMUNITY COLLEGE A FORMER PRESIDENT OF THE UNIVERSITY OF GUAM AND LIFELONG EDUCATOR AN OUTSTANDING PUBLIC FIGURE WHOSE ACTIONS WORDS AND WISDOM WERE AN INSPIRATION TO ALL AND TO FURTHER EXPRESSING THE SINCERE CONDOLENCES OF THE PEOPLE OF GUAM AND LIHESLATURAN GUÅHAN TO THE SALAS FAMILY UPON HIS PASSING BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SPEAKER AND THE CHAIRPERSON COMMITTEE ON RULES CERTIFIES WHEREAS THE LATE HONORABLE DR. JOHN CAMACHO SALAS WAS BORN ON JANUARY 21ST 1948 AND WAS THE ELDEST OF NINE CHILDREN OF THE RETIRED US NAVY CHIEF PETTY OFFICER STEWART JUAN CHARGULAF SALAS AN OPRAH CRISOSTOMO CAMACHO SALAS IN HIS YOUNGER YEARS HE TRAVELED THE WORLD WITH HIS PARENTS AND SIBLINGS TO HIS FATHER'S VARIOUS MILITARY DUTY STATIONS BEFORE RETURNING TO GUAM IN 1958 AND UPON GRADUATING FROM FATHER DUENAS MEMORIAL SCHOOL IN 1965 SENATOR SALAS ATTENDED NORTHERN COLORADO STATE COLLEGE WHERE HE EARNED HIS BACHELOR'S DEGREE IN INDUSTRIAL EDUCATION IN 1969 AND SENATOR SALAS THEN SUCCESSFULLY ATTAINED A MASTER OF ARTS DEGREE IN EDUCATIONAL SUPERVISION AND DOCTORATE IN PHILOSOPHY AND TECHNICAL AND INDUSTRIAL EDUCATION FROM THE UNIVERSITY OF CONNECTICUT IN 1974 AND SENATOR SALAS WENT ON TO BECOME A CURRICULUM SPECIALIST OF THE CONNECTICUT STATE DEPARTMENT OF EDUCATION DEPUTY SUPERINTENDENT OF PUBLIC INSTRUCTION FOR THE GUAM DEPARTMENT OF EDUCATION PUBLIC SCHOOLS CONSULTANT TO THE U.S. NAVY RECRUITING COMMAND EASTERN REGION AND ADJUNCT PROFESSOR AT THE UNIVERSITY OF CONNECTICUT AND THE UNIVERSITY OF BRIDGEPORT CONNECTICUT AND SENATOR SALAS WAS THE FOUNDING PRESIDENT OF THE GUAM COMMUNITY COLLEGE AND WAS THE SEVENTH PRESIDENT OF THE UNIVERSITY OF GUAM HE CONCLUDED HIS CAREER IN EDUCATION SERVING AS A TENURED ASSOCIATE PROFESSOR OF INTERNATIONAL TOURISM AT THE UNIVERSITY OF GUAM AND SENATOR SALAS WAS ALSO ACTIVE IN AREAS OUTSIDE OF THE EDUCATIONAL ARENA HE SERVED AS A TALK SHOW HOST FOR K57 AM RADIO HE WAS THE FIRST EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR OF THE GUAM HOTEL AND RESTAURANT ASSOCIATION HE WAS THE VICE PRESIDENT OF HUMAN RESOURCES AND COMMUNITY RELATIONS FOR THE MID PACIFIC DIVISION OF THE DUTY-FREE SHOPPERS LIMITED PARTNERSHIP AND HE WAS THE OWNER OF HIS OWN CONSULTING FIRM SPECIALIZING IN TOURISM DEVELOPMENT AND HUMAN RESOURCES AND SENATORS SALAS HAD ADMIRABLY SERVED THE PEOPLE OF GUAM AS A SENATOR OF THE 24TH AND 25TH GUAM LEGISLATURES AND SENATOR SALAS WAS ADDITIONALLY HEAVILY INVOLVED IN CIVIC ORGANIZATIONS SUCH AS THE GUAM CHAPTER OF THE AMERICAN RED CROSS THE GUAM SPECIAL OLYMPICS AND THE CHAMORRO DISTRICT OF THE BOY SCOUTS OF AMERICA AND HE HAD SERVED AS A MEMBER OF THE COLLEGE OF MICRONESIA BOARD OF TRUSTEES AND AS CHAIRMAN OF THE GUAM COMMUNITY COLLEGE BOARD OF TRUSTEES HE WAS ALSO A PAST DISTRICT GOVERNOR OF THE LIONS CLUB INTERNATIONAL STRICT 204 AND SENATOR SALAS WAS MARRIED TO LESLIE GOODSON SALAS OF WATER B CONNECTICUT FOR 46 YEARS AND THEY ARE THE PARENTS OF TWO CHILDREN JASON ARTHUR SALAS OF YIGO AND STACY SALAS DETRY WHO IS MARRIED TO MARCUS DETRY OF LOS ANGELES CALIFORNIA NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED THAT THE COMMITTEE ON RULES OF I MINA'TRENTAI KUÅTTRO NA LIHESLATURAN GUÅHAN AND JOAQUIN AND THE PEOPLE OF GUAM RECOGNIZED COMMEND AND ACKNOWLEDGE THE DISTINGUISHED ACCOMPLISHMENTS AND DEDICATION OF THE LATE HONORABLE JOHN CAMACHO SALAS PHD FORMER SENATOR WHO IS ALSO THE FOUNDING PRESIDENT OF THE GUAM COMMUNITY COLLEGE A FORMER PRESIDENT OF THE UNIVERSITY OF GUAM AND A LIFELONG EDUCATOR AN OUTSTANDING PUBLIC FIGURE WHOSE ACTIONS WORDS AND WISDOM WERE AN INSPIRATION TO ALL AND HAS FURTHER EXPRESSED THE SINCERE CONDOLENCES OF THE PEOPLE OF GUAM AND LIHESLATURAN GUÅHAN TO THE SALAS FAMILY UPON HIS PASSING AND BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED THAT THE SPEAKER AND THE CHAIRPERSON OF THE COMMITTEE ON RULES CERTIFY IN THE LEGISLATIVE SECRETARY ATTEST TO THE ADOPTION HERE OF AND THAT COPIES OF THE SAME BE THEREAFTER TRANSMITTED TO THE FAMILY OF THE LATE HONORABLE JOHN CAMACHO SALAS PHD FORMER SENATOR AND TO THE HONORABLE EDWARD J B CALVO I MAGALÅHEN GUÅHAN DULY AND REGULARLY ADOPTED BY THE COMMITTEE ON RULES OF I MINA'TRENTAI KUÅTTRO NA LIHESLATURAN GUÅHAN ON THE FIRST DAY OF FEBRUARY 2018

GERALD PEREZ: THE DAWN OF A MAN COMES BUT ONCE AND SO DOES HIS WINTER BUT THE SPRING OF HIS LIFE ETERNAL COMES BUT ONCE FOREVER NOW MANY OF YOU KNOW THAT JOHN AND I HAVE KNOWN EACH OTHER MANY MANY YEARS WHAT STARTED AS A PROFESSIONAL AND BUSINESS RELATIONSHIP BLOSSOMED INTO THE ONLY KIND OF ENDURING FRIENDSHIP THEY CAN WITHSTAND THE COUNTLESS JOKES AND PRANKS THAT HE AND I PULL ON EACH OTHER EVERY SINGLE TIME TAKE THIS MORNING FOR INSTANCE LESLEY JOHN KNOWS DARN WELL THAT I WANTED TO WATCH THE SUPER BOWL BUT THERE WAS A SERIOUS SIDE TO JOHN ONE THAT HAS ENRICHED THE PEOPLE OF GUAM ONE THAT IS IN REACH THE PEOPLE OF UM IN MANY DIFFERENT WAYS AS A FORMER SENATOR VISIONARY EDUCATOR AND PUBLIC SERVANT JOHN BROUGHT THE GIFT OF POSSIBILITY TO GENERATIONS OF GUAM STUDENTS AND WHILE HIS PASSING GIVES US CAUSE TO GRIEVE THE IMPACT OF HIS LIFE AND WORK WILL SURVIVE IN OTHERS MR. SPEAKER THESE WERE YOUR WORST OF THE ISLAND MEDIA LAST WEEK AND I REPEAT THEM HERE BECAUSE YOU COULDN'T HAVE CAPTURED THE ESSENCE OF WHO JOHN WAS AND THE LEGACY THAT LEAVES BEHIND AS AN EDUCATOR SENATOR AND PUBLIC SERVANT IN THE WORDS OF ABRAHAM LINCOLN IN THE END IT'S NOT THE YEARS IN YOUR LIFE THAT ACCOUNT IT'S THE LIFE IN YOUR YEARS THAT MATTER AS SOMEONE WHO HAS KNOWN JOHN WELL I WILL TELL YOU THAT LIFE IN HIS MANY MANY YEARS MATTERED GREATLY AS AN EDUCATOR JOHN IMPACTED MANY WHO NOW LEAD PRODUCTIVE LIVES IN GUAM AS A CHAMORRO AND SON OF GUAM HE WAS THE CULTURAL CHAUVINIST WHO CATALOGUED AN INVENTORY OF TOMORROW'S VERSES AND LEGENDS ALL THE WHILE ARTICULATING THE ISLANDS SENSE OF PLACE WHEREVER HE WENT YEARS AGO IN WASHINGTON DC FOR EXAMPLE WHEN JOHN INTERVIEWED SCAM B FOR A JOB AT GCC THE JOHN ADVISED THE GOOD RETIRING COLONEL TO THINK AND ACT LIKE A CHAMORRO WHEN SCAM BE TOLD JOHN THAT HE GREW UP IN AGANA HEIGHTS JOHN ASKED HIM TO SAY SOMETHING IN THE VERNACULAR WELL SCAM B WHO IS KNOWN TO BE EASILY IRRITATED UTTERED LACUS HAO DIABLO IN PERFECT CHAMORRO TO WHICH JOHN REPLIED THAT WILL DO THE UNIVERSITY OF GUAM PRESIDENT ROBERT UNDERWOOD REMEMBERS JOHN CARRYING HIS GUITAR AROUND THE CAMPUS AND SEEING GREAT SONGS JOHN'S EXTENDED CAMPUS INCLUDED THE MARSHALL ISLANDS PALAU THE FSM THE CNMI WERE HIS FRIENDLY AND CONTAGIOUS ALACRITY MORE THAN MADE UP FOR WHATEVER VOCAL CHALLENGES HE MIGHT HAVE HAD I WAS ALWAYS AMAZED AT HOW WELL HE CAN SING IN CHAMORRO PONEPAN CHUCKEES PALAUAN AND OTHER CAROLINE CAROLINIAN DIALECTS EVEN YAP AFRAID ROBERT HERE WHO WOULD REMEMBER AS A MATTER OF FACT JOHN WAS MUCH AT HOME IN MICRONESIA I REMEMBER A TRIP TO YAP YEARS AGO FOR A PACIFIC ASIA TRAVEL ASSOCIATION MEETING JOHN AGAINST MY ADVICE WANTED TO GO NATIVE AND HE WANTED TO WEAR A YEAH PEACE FOOD IF YOU CAN IMAGINE THAT WELL AFTER SPENDING A FEW HOURS SOURCING MATERIAL TO COVER HIS CONSIDERABLE GIRTH AT THE TIME JOHN PROCEEDED TO WRAP HIMSELF IN THIS FLEW HOWEVER BEFORE OUR MEETING
