AN ACT TO ADD A NEW CHAPTER 9.7 TO DIVISION 1 TITLE 7 OF THE GUAM CODE ANNOTATED RELATIVE TO THE PARALEGAL PROFESSION.

1 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF GUAM:

Section 1. Legislative Findings and Intent. I Liheslaturan Guåhan finds that a 2 3 paralegal is a legal professional that works under the supervision of a licensed attorney or a governmental practice attorney and performs tasks such as legal 4 research, drafting legal documents, and assisting with client/constituent 5 communication. Paralegals typically have a certificate or degree in paralegal 6 7 studies and may specialize in a particular area of law, such as corporate law, intellectual property law, or family law. Paralegals generally cannot provide legal 8 advice or represent clients in court. They do, however, play an important role in 9 the legal profession by providing support to attorneys and helping to ensure that 10 legal matters are handled efficiently and effectively. I Liheslaturan Guåhan finds 11 that, in contemplation of a nationwide shortage of attorneys, the supreme courts in 12 several state are adopting training and licensing programs that allow qualified 13 paralegals to perform duties that are traditionally reserved for practicing attorneys 14 or law clerks. These certified, registered, or advance practice paralegals allow 15 attorneys to handle larger case loads and avoid delays in court proceedings. 16

- 1 It is the intent of *I Liheslaturan Guåhan* to allow the Supreme Court of Guam the
- 2 authority to license and regulate the paralegal profession and determine the
- 3 qualifications for advanced paralegal practice.
- 4 Section 2. A new Chapter 9.7 is added Division 1, Title 7, Guam Code Annotated
- 5 to read as follows:

6 <u>Chapter 9.7</u>

7 <u>Paralegals</u>

8 **§ 9701. Paralegals.**

- 9 A paralegal is a legal professional who works under the supervision of a lawyer
- and performs tasks such as legal research, drafting legal documents, and assisting
- 11 with client communication. Paralegals typically have a certificate or degree in
- 12 paralegal studies and may specialize in a particular area of law, such as corporate
- 13 <u>law, intellectual property law, or family law. While paralegals cannot provide legal</u>
- 14 advice or represent clients in court, they play an important role in the legal
- profession by providing support to lawyers and helping to ensure that legal matters
- are handled efficiently and effectively.

17 § 9702. Paralegals: Qualifications and Licensing

- 18 The Supreme Court of Guam may adopt paralegal rules for the qualifications,
- 19 licensing requirements and scope of practice. In the absence of such rules, the
- 20 <u>following restrictions apply:</u>
- 21 (a) The use of any professional designations such as Certified Paralegal (CP)
- or Registered Paralegal shall not be used by any person who has not met the
- requirements to attain and maintain such designations,

- 1 (b) Advanced Practice Paralegals shall be licensed only upon approval by the
- 2 Supreme Court of Guam pursuant to §§ 9703, 9704 and 9705 of this
- 3 <u>Chapter.</u>

4 § 9703. Advanced Practice Paralegals

- 5 Advance Practice Paralegals are licensed paralegals who are permitted to practice,
- 6 by authorization of the Supreme Court of Guam, beyond the scope of what is
- 7 commonly and traditionally expected of the paralegal profession.

8 § 9704. Advanced Practice Paralegals: Qualifications and Licensing

- 9 The Supreme Court of Guam shall determine the qualification and licensing
- 10 requirements for Advanced Practice Paralegals.

11 § 9705. Advanced Practice Paralegals: Scope of Practice

- 12 The Supreme Court of Guam shall determine the scope and limitations of practice
- 13 <u>for Advanced Practice Paralegals.</u>

14 § 9706. Adoption and Maintenance of Rules

- 15 The Supreme Court of Guam shall create and publish rules for the this Chapter
- 16 consistent with its Organic authority under 48 U.S.C.: §1424-1(a)(6)."
