AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION 8108(A)(7) OF DIVISION 1, CHAPTER 8, Title 11, GUAM CODE ANNOTATED RELATIVE TO THE LAWFUL OPERATION OF CANNABIS-RELATED FACILITIES.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF GUAM:

- Section 1. Section 8108(a)(7) is hereby added to Chapter 8, Division 1,
- 3 Title 11, Guam Code Annotated, to read:
- § 8108. Lawful Operation of Cannabis-Related Facilities. (7) Delivering,
- 5 distributing, or selling cannabis. To consumers or other Cannabis testing facility on
- 6 Guam, that it is ISO 17025 accredited or certified by the Americans for Safe
- 7 Access Patient Focused Certification Program. So long as the Prior to the licensure
- 8 of a Cannabis Testing Facility by the Cannabis Control Board, the delivery,
- 9 distribution, or sale of cannabis flowers or buds is permitted, provided the cannabis
- 10 flowers or buds are marked with a label indicating the amount, strain, batch

number, and date of harvest, name and address of licensed cultivation company and manufacturing company as applicable, there shall be a disclaimer stating, (A) "the marijuana contained within this package has not been tested for contaminants" and (B) "Marijuana use can be addictive and can impair an individual's ability to drive a motor vehicle or operate heavy machinery. Marijuana smoke contains carcinogens and can lead to an increased risk for cancer, tachycardia, hypertension, heart attack, and lung infection. KEEP OUT OF REACH OF CHILDREN"

(A) Upon the licensure and opening of a cannabis testing facility by
Guam Cannabis Control Board. All cannabis and products containing cannabis byproducts mustshall be tested as required by the applicable rules and regulations.
The Guam Cannabis Control Board shall notify everyeach licensee that it has ten
(10) days to demonstrate that it is compliant with the relevant testing requirements.
The company's Responsible Official is responsible for demonstrating, certifying,

and ensuring compliance.
