AN ACT TO *REPEAL* CHAPTER 41 OF TITLE 22, GUAM CODE ANNOTATED, RELATIVE TO THE GUAM BOXING AND WRESTLING COMMISSION; TO *ADD* A NEW CHAPTER 7 TO TITLE 11, GUAM CODE ANNOTATED, RELATIVE TO "UNARMED COMBAT" AND ESTABLISHING THE GUAM UNARMED COMBAT COMMISSION; AND TO CITE THIS ACT AS THE "GUAM UNARMED COMBAT COMMISSION ACT OF 2009".

AN ACT TO *REPEAL* CHAPTER 41 OF TITLE 22, GUAM CODE ANNOTATED, RELATIVE TO THE GUAM BOXING AND WRESTLING COMMISSION; TO *ADD* A NEW CHAPTER 17 TO TITLE 11, GUAM CODE ANNOTATED, RELATIVE TO "UNARMED COMBAT" AND ESTABLISHING THE GUAM [ATHLETIC] UNARMED COMBAT COMMISSION; AND, CITING THIS ACT AS THE "GUAM [ATHLETIC] UNARMED COMBAT COMMISSION ACT OF 2009".

03/31/09 - Failed placement into the Third Reading File; placed in the Inactive File.
04/03/09 - Through motion, pulled out of Inactive File and re-referred back to the Committee on Municipal Affairs, Aviation, Housing and Recreation.
02q/11/09- From the Committee on Municipal Affairs, Aviation, Housing and Recreation to substitute and to do pass as substituted.
06/29/09 - Placed on Second Reading File.
06/29/09 - Discussed; amended; through motion placed on the Third Reading File.
07/02/09 - Read Third ...PASSED.
07/02/09 - Transmitted to the Governor.
