AN ACT TO ADD NEW §§30119 AND 30120 TO CHAPTER 30, TITLE 5, GUAM CODE ANNOTATED, RELATIVE TO AUTHORIZING THE OFFICE OF THE ATTORNEY GENERAL TO COLLECT A FEE FOR ITS ATTORNEY GENERAL CLEARANCES, AND TO ESTABLISHING A SEPARATE FUND FOR THE DEPOSIT OF THOSE FEES, ENTITLED THE "VICTIM OR WITNESS TRAVEL-HOUSING FUND", FOR USE BY THE OFFICE OF THE ATTORNEY GENERAL.

AN ACT TO ADD A NEW SECTION 30119 AND 30120, CHAPTER 30, TITLE 5 GUAM CODE ANNOTATED, RELATIVE TO AUTHORIZING THE OFFICE OF THE ATTORNEY GENERAL TO COLLECT A FEE FOR ITS ATTORNEY GENERAL CLEARANCES, AND TO ESTABLISH A SEPARATE FUND FOR THE DEPOSIT OF THOSE FEES ENTITLED THE "VICTIM OR WITNESS TRAVEL-HOUSING FUND" FOR USE BY THE OFFICE OF THE ATTORNEY GENERAL.
