AN ACT TO ESTABLISH THE ADMINISTRATIVE RULES AND REGULATIONS OF THE DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC HEALTH & SOCIAL SERVICES RELATIVE TO CHILD CARE FACILITIES AND GROUP CHILD CARE HOMES, UNDER ARTICLE 1 OF CHAPTER 1, DIVISION 1, TITLE 26, GUAM ADMINISTRATIVE RULES AND REGULATIONS, AND IN CONFORMANCE WITH ARTICLE 4, CHILD WELFARE SERVICES ACT, CHAPTER 2, DIVISION 1, TITLE 10, GUAM CODE ANNOTATED.

*AN ACT TO ESTABLISH THE ADMINISTRATIVE RULES AND REGULATIONS OF THE DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC HEALTH & SOCIAL SERVICES RELATIVE TO CHILD CARE CENTERS AND GROUP CHILD CARE HOMES, UNDER ARTICLE 1 OF CHAPTER 1, DIVISION 1, TITLE 26, GUAM ADMINISTRATIVE RULES AND REGULATIONS, AND IN CONFORMANCE WITH ARTICLE 4 – CHILD WELFARE SERVICES ACT, CHAPTER 4, TITLE 10, GUAM CODE ANNOTATED.*

- 05/02/11(04/21/11)\* - From the Committee on Health and Human Services, Senior Citizens, Economic Development, and Election Reform with the recommendation to substitute and report out only as substituted.
- 05/02/11 - Placed on Second Reading File.
- 05/04-05/11- Through motion, resolved into a Committee of the Whole and amended.
- 05/05/11 - Through motion, Committee of the Whole arose with the recommendation to place on the Third Reading File.
- 05/05/11 - Through motion placed on the Third Reading File.
- 05/10/11 - Read Third ...PASSED.
- 05/23/11 - Transmitted to the Governor.
- 05/24/11 - Signed into law by the Governor. P.L. 31-73.
