AN ACT TO ADD A NEW §30.200 TO CHAPTER 30, TITLE 9, GUAM CODE ANNOTATED, RELATIVE TO CREATING A CENTRAL DATABASE CONTAINING INFORMATION ABOUT REPEAT OFFENDERS WHO HAVE COMMITTED MULTIPLE OFFENSES INVOLVING DOMESTIC/FAMILY VIOLENCE; AND TO BE KNOWN AS THE "FAMILY VIOLENCE REGISTRY ACT".

*AN ACT RELATIVE TO CREATING A CENTRAL DATABASE CONTAINING INFORMATION ABOUT OFFENDERS WHO HAVE COMMITTED OFFENSES INVOLVING DOMESTIC/FAMILY VIOLENCE BY ADDING A NEW §30.200 CHAPTER 30, TITLE 9 GUAM CODE ANNOTATED, TO BE KNOWN AS THE "FAMILY VIOLENCE REGISTRY ACT".*

- 05/27/11 - Public hearing scheduled by the Committee on Public Safety, Law Enforcement and Judiciary.
- (08/01/11)\* - From the Committee on Public Safety, Law Enforcement and Judiciary with the recommendation to amend and to do pass as amended.
- 08/29/11 - Placed on Second Reading File.
- 08/31/11 - Discussed; amended; through motion placed on the Third Reading File.
- 09/19/11 - Read Third ...PASSED.
- 09/20/11 - Transmitted to the Governor.
- 09/30/11 - Signed into law by the Governor. P.L. 31-103.
