The purpose of this legislation 2 Section 1. Purpose and Legislative Intent. is to update the language of the existing law to accurately reflect the changes in the 3 membership of I Liheslaturan Guåhan. The existing law reflects a requirement of 14 4 affirmative votes for legislative submissions. The 14 affirmative vote requirement was 5 based on a legislative membership of 21 senators which represent two-thirds of the 6 membership at that time. Since that time the membership of the legislature has changed to 7 15 members. Hence, the number of affirmative votes needed for legislative submissions is 8 9 less than 14. This amendment intends to make it easier to determine what number of affirmative votes is necessary regardless of future changes in I Liheslaturan Guåhan 10 membership. 11

Section Subsection §17401 of Title 3 Guam Code Annotated is hereby amended to read:

"§17401. Number of Legislative Votes Necessary for Legislature's Submission. No measure shall be submitted to the voters by the Legislature unless it shall have been adopted by fourteen (14) two-thirds affirmative votes."
