AN ACT TO REASSIGN **RULEMAKING AUTHORITY**, AND CONTRACTING **AUTHORITY** AND **CHANGE CERTAIN** TO DEADLINES REGARDING THE COLLECTIONS OF RECYCLING FEES AND TO REQUIRE GEPA TO PERFORM AN ECONOMIC IMPACT ASSESSMENT BY AMENDING TITLE 5 G.C.A. SECTIONS 51505 AND 51507

TO BE ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF GUAM:

- Section One. Title 5 G.C.A. Section 51505 is amended to read:
- § 51505. Collection of Recycling Fees. The Guam Customs and Quarantine
- 3 Agency shall collect the Recycling Fees mandated by this Article on:
- 4 (a) recyclable materials imported for resale, which come in at the Jose
- 5 D. Leon Guerrero Commercial Port of Guam, or any other seaport in Guam, to be
- 6 collected *prior* to release, *except* as otherwise provided by this Act.
- 7 (b) recyclable materials imported for resale which come in as freight or
- 8 unaccompanied baggage at the Antonio B. Won Pat International Airport, Guam,
- 9 or any other airport in Guam, to be collected *prior* to release, *except* as otherwise
- 10 provided by this Act; and

- 1 (c) recyclable materials imported for resale which come in as freight or
- 2 accompanied baggage at the A.B. Won Pat International Airport, or any other
- airport in Guam, to be collected *prior* to release, *except* as otherwise provided by
- 4 this Act.
- 5 The Guam Economic Development and Commerce Authority Guam
- 6 Environmental Protection Agency is authorized to promulgate rules and
- 7 regulations in accordance with the Administrative Adjudication Law to enforce
- 8 the intent of this Law, within ninety (90) days of enactment of this Section. In
- 9 enacting the rules and regulations required by this section, GEPA shall comply
- with Title 5 G.C.A. Section 9301 regarding an economic impact statement.
- 11 **Section Two**. Title 5 G.C.A. Section 51507 is amended to read:
- 12 §51507. Authorization for GEPA DPW to contract with recycling
- 13 companies.
- 14 (a) GEPA The Department of Public Works is authorized, in
- 15 accordance with the applicable procurement laws, to enter into contracts with
- 16 recycling companies for the collection, recycling, and disposal of automobiles,
- 17 buses, heavy equipment, trucks, batteries, tires, white goods, and other
- 18 recyclable materials. GEPA The Department of Public Works shall submit any
- 19 proposed Requests for Proposals to I Liheslatura Guahan within three (3) months
- 20 of the enactment of this Article.
- 21 (b) Successful offerors for contracts authorized under this Section shall
- 22 perform all work under this Article in compliance with all applicable laws,

- 1 including those of this Chapter, and Rules and Regulations of GEPA and the
- 2 <u>Department of Public Works</u> as may be established. At a minimum, GEPA The
- 3 <u>Department of Public Works</u> shall ensure that all offerors include, as part of their
- 4 processing, a plan to remove collected recyclable materials, including abandoned
- 5 vehicles, from Guam's waste stream.
- 6 (c) GEPA The Department of Public Works shall promulgate the
- 7 necessary Rules and Regulations, in accordance with the Administrative
- 8 Adjudication Law, to properly implement this Article.
- 9 Section Three. Effective Dates. (a) This act shall become effective
- immediately. (b) The fees authorized by Title 5 G.C.A. Section 51506 shall not be
- 11 collected until the GEPA rules and regulations enacted pursuant to Title 5 G.C.A. Section
- 12 51505 become effective.
