## MINA'BENTE OCHO NA LIHESLATURAN GUÅHAN 2005 (FIRST) Regular Session

AN ACT TO REPEAL AND RE-ENACT SECTIONS 10305. AND 10306 OF CHAPTER 10, 5GCA TO REQUIRE EACH GOVERNMENT DEPARTMENT OR AGENCY TO POST AND MAINTAIN AN INTERNET HOME PAGE OR WEBSITE AND PROVIDE INFORMATION TO THE GENERAL PUBLIC, OTHERWISE TO BE KNOWN AS THE TRANSPARENCY ACT OF 2005.

## BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF GUAM:

Section 1. Legislative Intent. I Liheslaturan Guåhan finds that many 2 departments and agencies of the government of Guam do not maintain homepages 3 or websites on the world-wide web for the purpose of providing necessary 4 information to the public. In other cases, the web pages are out of date or contain 5 such a paucity of information as to be useless. I Liheslaturan Guåhan intends to 6 mandate that each department or agency of the government of Guam shall maintain 7 an updated web site or home page openly accessible to the general public, and to 8 describe such information as must be available through such web sites or home 9 10 pages.

**Section 2.** Section 10305. of Chapter 10, 5GCA is repealed and reenacted to read:

9	section, as well as section	10306. of this chapter, shall apply to the I Liheslaturan Guahan, as a	
10	single agency, and the Ur	nified Judiciary, as a single agency."	
11	Section 3.	Section 10306. of Chapter 10, 5GCA is repealed and re-	
12	enacted to read:		
13	"§10306. Ir	formation Required. The following information must be posted,	
14	at a minimum, on each of	ficial web site or home page required pursuant to section 10305.	
15	1.	Notice of all meetings, hearings and public events as required	
16		by public law and for such duration as required by public law	
17		and containing such information as is required by public law.	
18	2.	The e-mail address, public phone numbers, mailing address and	
19		physical location of the department, agency, autonomous	
20		agency or public corporation.	
21	3.	The names and titles of the Director, Deputy Director or official	
22		in charge of the department, agency, autonomous agency or	
23		public corporation, as appropriate, as well as the names and	
24		titles of the administrators of each and all offices, programs,	
25		services, units or divisions under its purview, and the names of	

all board members of each board or commission associated or 1 appurtenant thereto, and an organizational chart demonstrating 2 the relationships between all, as relevant. 3 4. A list of all fees charged for any services. 4 5. All rules and regulations in force, or links thereto, as 5 promulgated by the department, agency, autonomous agency or 6 public corporation, or links thereto, as well as all proposed rules 7 and regulations, or amendments thereto, as are progressing 8 through the administrative adjudication process as detailed in 9 the Administrative Adjudication Act. 10 6. The budget for the department, agency, autonomous agency or 11 12 public corporation, as is in force and approved by I Liheslaturan Guahan or the governing board as appropriate, as well as the 13 proposed budget for the upcoming fiscal year, and in such form 14 as is submitted to or approved by I Liheslaturan Guahan or the 15 governing board as appropriate. 16 7. The awardee, amount, duration and a general description of all 17 contracts of any nature as entered into by the department, 18 19 agency, autonomous agency or public corporation. 8. The amount and a general description of all grants received by 20 the department, agency, autonomous agency or public 21 22 corporation. 9. The hours of operation of the department, agency, autonomous 23 agency or public corporation, and all programs, units or 24 services under its purview. 25

1	10.	A general description of the areas of responsibility of the
2		department, agency, autonomous agency or public corporation,
3		and all offices, programs, services, units or divisions under its
4		purview, as well as any public reports, studies and publications
5		as the public might expect access to under Guam law, or links
6		thereto, or forms, notices or circulars required by the public
7		while interacting with the department, agency, autonomous
8		agency or public corporation, and all offices, programs, services,
9		units or divisions under its purview.
10	11.	The results of audits, or links thereto, of the department,
11		agency, autonomous agency or public corporation, or any
12		component or service of same.
13	12.	In the case of a department, agency, autonomous agency or
14		public corporation that generates its own income through fees
15		for service or other fees, an annual statement detailing collection

and income derived from such fees.

Nothing in this section shall be construed as limiting the information that a department, agency, autonomous agency or public corporation may provide to the general public via a home page or web site."
