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## MINA BENTE OCHO NA LIHESLATURAN GUÅHAN 2005 (FIRST) REGULAR SESSION

BILL NO. 180(EE) INTRODUCED BY:

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AN ACT RELATIVE TO THE IMMEDIATE RESTORATION PAY DIFFERENTIAL **FOR GUAM'S** FIREFIGHTERS PERFORMING EMERGENCY MEDICAL **TECHNICIAN-AMBULANCE** DUTIES, AND SHALL REMAIN IN EFFECT UNTIL SUCH TIME THAT THE CIVIL SERVICE COMMISSION COMPLETES ITS OF FIREFIGHTERS COMPREHENSIVE REVIEW **EMT** COMPENSATION.

## 1 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF GUAM:

Section 1. Legislative Findings and Intent.

The Liheslaturan Guahan finds that through the recent passage of 3 legislation the Civil Service Commission has determined that the incentive 4 pay for firefighters performing EMT duties was to be suspended. It is the 5 intention of the Liheslaturan Guahan that a comprehensive review of the 6 salary structure of Guam's firefighters be conducted by the Civil Service 7 Commission because of the additional requirement that each firefighter 8 acquire a minimum of EMT-B certification, and that no reduction of 9 firefighter compensation take place. 10 Therefore, this provision would restore the firefighter's incentive pay for those performing EMT duties, and 11

- allow for the Civil Service Commission to conduct its overall review and
- 2 assessment of the firefighter's pay structure considering the added
- 3 certification training requirement.

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## 4 Section 2. Restoration of Firefighters Incentive Compensation.

The Guam Fire Department shall cause the immediate restoration of 5 6 the incentive compensation in effect for all applicable firefighters performing EMT duties; such incentive pay shall further be retroactive to 7 8 June 30, 2005, and shall apply to those receiving such pay prior to said date. The implementation of this provision shall be in accordance with the 9 following: A firefighter in the Guam Fire Department who performs work 10 as an Emergency Medical Technician-Ambulance (EMT-A) and is a 11 12 certified EMT-A shall be entitled to differential pay calculated at the rate of his or her regular wage plus fifteen percent (15%) for all periods he or she 13 is assigned as an EMT-A and is a certified EMT-A. 14

The Civil Service Commission shall immediately conduct its review of the firefighter salary structure in accordance with the provisions set forth through Public Law 28-62.
