AN ACT RELATIVE TO APPROPRIATING THE SUM OF FIVE HUNDRED THOUSAND DOLLARS (\$500,000.00) FROM THE UNRESERVED BALANCE OF THE CAPITAL PROJECTS FUND OF THE TERRITORIAL HIGHWAY FUND TO THE DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC WORKS FOR THE REPAIR AND UPGRADE OF THE ACCESS ROAD TO THE IJA SUBDIVISION IN INARAJAN, AND REQUIRING THAT SUCH WORK REPAIR COMMENCE IMMEDAITELY. THUS ALLOWING THE **OVER** 300 IN WITH PROPERTY THE AREA **FAMILIES** TO CONSTRUCT THEIR HOMES.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF GUAM:

Section 1. Legislative Intent and Findings.

The Liheslaturan Guahan finds that over three hundred (300) families 4 were given property located within the Ija Subdivision, Inarajan, many 5 years ago by the government of Guam. To date, the government of Guam 6 has yet to invest sufficient resources and finances into the proper 7 construction of the roadway and to construct the infrastructure necessary 8 for the numerous families to build their own homes. It is therefore 9 necessary for the government of Guam to complete the construction and 10 repair of the access road to the Ija Subdivision. This would enable the 11

- 1 families to actively pursue the realization of their dreams of constructing
- 2 their homes on their property. This provision would appropriate limited
- 3 funds from the unreserved and unexpended funds from the Territorial
- 4 Highway Fund for the specific requirement of repairing the access road to
- 5 the Ija Subdivision, Inarajan, thus benefiting the many families who have
- 6 property within the area.

Section 2. Appropriation to the Department of Public Works for the repair and upgrade of the access roadway to Ija Subdivision.

- The sum of Five Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$500,000.00) is hereby appropriated from the unreserved and unexpended balance of the Capital Projects Fund of the Territorial Highway Fund (aka Guam Highway Fund) to the Department of Public Works for the purpose of funding the road construction and repair for the Ija Subdivision in Inarajan.
- 14 a.) The Department of Public Works shall initiate the repair
 15 and construction of the primary road for the Ija
 16 Subdivision within forty-five (45) days from the
 17 enactment of this Act.
 - b.) The sums appropriated herein shall not be subject to the transfer authority of I Maga'Lahen Guahan, and shall be used solely for the repair and construction of the primary road for the Ija Subdivision. Any unexpended sums appropriated herein following the completion of the project shall revert back to the Territorial Highway Fund.

1 c.) The Department of Public Works shall provide the
2 Speaker of I Liheslaturan Guahan a written report on the
3 progress and activities of the expenditure of said funds
4 every ninety (90) days upon the effective date of this Act,
5 and until such time that the project is completed.

Section 3. Severability Clause.

If any provision of this Act or its application to any person or circumstances is held invalid, the invalidity shall not affect other provisions or applications of this Act which can be given effect without the invalid provision or application, and to this end the provisions of this Act are severable.
