

AN ACT TO REPEAL AND REENACT SECTIONS 3115, 3117 AND 3120 OF ARTICLE 1, CHAPTER 3, DIVISION 2, TITLE 17 OF THE GUAM CODE ANNOTATED RELATIVE TO THE GUAM EDUCATION POLICY BOARD.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF GUAM:

Section 1. Section 3115, Article 1, Chapter 3, Division 2, Title 17 of the

Guam Code Annotated is hereby repealed and reenacted to read as follows:

4 "§ 3115. Same: Term of Office. The term of the elected board members

shall commence on the first Monday of January following the date of

Section 2. Section 3117, Article 1, Chapter 3, Division 2, Title 17 of the

Guam Code Annotated is hereby repealed and reenacted to read as follows:

"§ 3117. Same: Vacancies. If a vacancy occurs less than ninety (90) days

before the end of an elected board member's term, I Maga'lahen Guåhan shall

take no action. If a vacancy occurs ninety (90) days or more months before the

end of an elected board member's term, I Maga'lahen Guåhan within thirty (30)

days of the date of the vacancy shall make an appointment, subject to the

- advice and consent of I Liheslaturan Guåhan. Such vacancies shall be filled by
- 2 appointment of a member from the same district represented by the vacating
- 3 member."
- Section 3. Section 3120, Article 1, Chapter 3, Division 2, Title 17 of the Guam Code Annotated is hereby repealed and reenacted to read as follows:
- 6 "§3120. Same: Stipend. Each elected board member shall receive the
- yeur of Seventy-Five Dollars (\$75.00) for his/her attendance at any meeting of
- 8 the Board, but such compensation shall not apply to more than four (4)
- 9 meetings or exceed Three hundred Dollars (\$300) in any one calendar month.
- No elected board member shall receive any other compensation, but shall be
- reimbursed for actual travel, subsistence and out-of-pocket."
