

AN ACT TO ADD A NEW SECTION 6223 TO CHAPTER 6, ARTICLE 2 OF TITLE 4 RELATIVE TO AUTHORIZING DIFFERENTIAL PAY TO GUAM FIRE DEPARTMENT PERSONNEL ASSIGNED TO THE ADVANCED LIFE SUPPORT UNIT, THE AMBULANCE UNIT, THE SEARCH AND RESCUE UNIT, AND THE FIRE SUPPRESION UNIT; AND TO THE GUAM INTERNATIONAL AIRPORT AUTHORITY FIRE PERSONNEL ASSIGNED TO THE FIRE AND RESCUE UNIT

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF GUAM:

Section 1. A new Section 6223 is added to Chapter 6, Article 2 of Title 4 of the Guam Code Annotated as follows:

"Section 6223. Firefighters. (a) Advanced Life Support Unit of the Guam Fire Department. The fire personnel of the Advanced Life Support Unit (EMT-Intermediate) of the Guam Fire Department shall be paid their regular wage and differential pay calculated at the rate of their regular wage and differential pay calculated at the rate of their regular wage plus Eighteen Percent (18%), and in addition, One Hundred Dollars (\$100) per pay period for maintenance of their certification.

(b) Ambulance Unit of the Guam Fire Department. The fire personnel of the Ambulance Unit (EMT-Basic) of the Guam Fire Department shall be paid their regular wage and differential pay calculated at the rate of their regular wage plus Fifteen Percent (15%).

- (c) Search and Rescue Unit of the Guam Fire Department. The fire personnel of the Search and Rescue Unit of the Guam Fire Department shall be paid their regular wage and differential pay calculated at the rate of their regular wage plus Fifteen Percent (15%).
- (d) Fire Suppression Unit of the Guam Fire Department. The fire personnel of the Fire Suppression Unit of the Guam Fire Department shall be paid their regular wage and differential pay calculated at the rate of their regular wage plus Ten Percent (10%).
- (e) Guam International Airport Authority Fire and Rescue Unit. The fire personnel of the Guam International Airport Authority Fire and Rescue Unit shall be paid their regular wage and differential pay calculated at the rate of their regular wage plus Ten Percent (10%)."
