AN ACT TO RESTORE THE AUTHORIZED POWERS AND PERSONNEL OF THE CIVIL SERVICE COMMISSION, BY REPEALING CERTAIN MISCELLANEOUS PROVISIONS OF THE GENERAL APPROPRIATIONS ACT OF FISCAL YEAR 2006

## BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF GUAM:

Section 1. During late September working meetings to finalize the fiscal 2 year 2006 budget, sections were added as miscellaneous provisions to transfer non-3 adjudicatory functions and duties from the Civil Service Commission to the 4 Department of Administration. This transfer of powers and full time employees 5 from the independent commission to a line agency had not been previously 6 7 announced or otherwise made available for public comment. Regardless of the Commission's shortcomings over the years, or the merits of these or any other 8 possible measures to address historical problems, the process limited public 9 discussion by which lawmakers could become fully informed on the proposal prior 10 to a vote. Government personnel administration experts were not summoned to 11 assist the Committee of the Whole, although they were available. Sweeping public 12 13 policy changes were accomplished without a public hearing by attaching them in working meetings to a time-sensitive bill. 14

Therefore, in order to facilitate orderly public discussions of the proposed transfer of duties and functions from the Civil Service Commission to the Department of Administration with sufficient legal notice to the public, and within the timeframe prior to the effective date of implementation, the substantive sections 2 and 3 of this Act are herewith formally filed within a legislative Bill in order to be duly considered by Mina'Bente Ocho na Liheslaturan Guåhan.

- Section 2. Subsection 2(c) of Chapter II, Public Law 28-68, is repealed.
- Section 3. Sections 31 through 48, inclusive, of Chapter IV of Public Law 28-68, are repealed.
