AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION 47, CHAPTER IV, PUBLIC LAW 28-68, RELATIVE TO CHANGING THE EFFECTIVE DATE TO JUNE 30, 2006.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF GUAM:

- Section 1. Legislative Findings and Intent. I Liheslaturan Guåhan finds
- 2 that Section 31 thru 48 of Public Law 28-68 reference to changes in the Civil Service
- 3 Commission raise sufficient public concerns, that two separate and bi-partisan Bills
- 4 have already been introduced that would repeal those Sections. The main concern of
- 5 the public is the inadequate public hearing on those changes, prior to their adoption.
- 6 The two Bills introduced would provide for a public hearing before those Sections
- 7 become effective on January 01, 2006.
- 8 I Liheslaturan Guåhan further finds Bills 203 & 204 that propose to repeal
- 9 Sections 31 to 48 of Public Law 28-68 may not be heard and voted on in time before
- the effective date of January 1, 2006, thus rendering the Bills almost moot.

- It is therefore the intent of *I Liheslaturan Guåhan* to amend and extend the
- effective date of Sections 31 to 48 of Public Law 28-68, to allow reasonable sufficient
- 3 time for Bills 203 & 204 to be heard and voted on, not withstanding the outcome of
- 4 the voting process. If both Bills 203 and 204 fail to pass legislative support, then
- 5 Section 31 to 48 of Public Law 28-68 would become law.
- 6 Section 2. Section 47, Chapter IV, Public Law 28-68 is amended to read as
- 7 follows:
- 8 "Section 47. Effective Date Assuming the Non-adjudicatory Functions of Civil
- 9 Service Commission by the Department of Administration. Sections 31, 32, 33, 34,
- 35, 36, 37, 38, 39, 40, 41, 42, 43, 44, 45 and 46 shall become effective on January 1,
- 11 2006 June 30, 2006."
