AN ACT TO ADD A NEW SECTION 3101.2 OF ARTICLE 1,
CHAPTER 3, TITLE 16 OF THE GUAM CODE
ANNOTATED, RELATIVE TO DRIVER LICENSE
RENEWAL EXTENSION FOR ACTIVE DUTY MILITARY
PERSONNEL.

1 **BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF GUAM:**

2 **Section 1.** A new Section 3101.2 of Article 1, Chapter 3, Title 16 of the
3 Guam Code Annotated is hereby added to read as follows:

4 “§3101.2. 2 **Driver License Renewal Extension for Active Duty Military**
5 **Personnel.** A valid Guam driver’s license issued to any person does not expire
6 on the expiration date on the license if, on that expiration date, the licensee is
7 on active duty in the U.S. armed forces and is absent from Guam. Any license
8 extended under this section expires thirty (30) days after the licensee returns
9 to Guam or ninety (90) days after the licensee is discharged from active duty,
10 whichever occurs first, unless the license is suspended, canceled, or revoked
11 for cause as provided by law. Any person whose license is extended under

1 this section shall have documentary or other proof, when operating any motor
2 vehicle, that he is entitled to the benefits of this section.”
