AN ACT TO ADD NEW SECTIONS 4202.1, 4202.2 TO TITLE 4 G.C.A. TO REQUIRE GOVERNMENT EMPLOYEES WHO ARE CHARGED WITH OR CONVICTED OF A CRIME TO PROVIDE IMMEDIATE NOTICE OF THE CHARGES OR CONVICTION TO THE HEAD OF THE EMPLOYEE'S DEPARTMENT OR AGENCY AND TO PROVIDE SANCTIONS FOR FAILURE TO PROVIDE NOTICE

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF GUAM:

Section 1. A new Section 4202.1 is added to Title 4 G.C.A. to read:

“§ 4202.1. Duty to Report Criminal Charges or Conviction. An employee in the classified service who is charged by indictment, information or magistrate’s complaint with any crime in any court or who is convicted of a crime in any court shall immediately provide the head of the department or agency employing the employee with notice of the charges or the conviction.”

Section 2. A new Section 4202.2 is added to Title 4 G.C.A. to read:

“§ 4202.2. Failure to report Criminal Charges or Conviction.(a) Failure to provide the notice required by Title 4 G.C.A. § 4202.1 is grounds for a separate Adverse Action.
(b) The sixty day limitation imposed by Title 4 G.C.A. §4406 commences when the employee gives notice of the charges or conviction of a crime to the head of the department or agency as required by Title 4 G.C.A. §4202.1.”
